CHEWY was declared a late scratching at 1.25 pm on veterinary advice after found to be lame in the right foreleg soon after arriving at the course.

HIBERNIA SEA was declared a late scratching at 2.00 pm on veterinary advice after injuring itself in the tie-up stall.

MINNALLINES (R Elliot) – Co-trainer R Wellwood reported the stable is satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly, however, MINNALLINES will undergo a dynamic upper airway endoscopy this week with the possibility of the filly going to trials in the coming weeks.

DRAGON LEAP – Co-trainer A Scott reported to Stewards, after having to scratch DRAGON LEAP from the Waikato Guineas, the gelding underwent an endoscopic examination and blood tests which could find no abnormalities and it is now the stables intention to carry on with his current preparation.

ENDLESS DRAMA (L Innes) – Stable representative D Williams advised Stewards the stable is satisfied with the post-race condition of the entire.

VOLPE VELOCE (M McNab) – Trainer G Richardson advised Stewards he is satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare.

RACE COMMENTS:**Race 1 SUNLINE LODGE 1400**

MONBEAU (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.

ROYAL CHARM (S Collett) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 900 metres when in restricted room to the inside of VIKING (R Oliver). Rider R Oliver was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance. When questioned regarding the improved performance, Trainer M Brooks advised that the gelding had received an interrupted run when last racing at Te Teko 27 January and was expecting an improved performance today.

LA VELOCITA (M Coleman) – Crowded start.

WELL CHOSEN (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously when awkwardly placed for a distance passing the 900 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until inside the final 200 metres.

TARWYN (S Goindasamy) – Raced wide without cover.

GOLDEN SEED (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages and was steadied to the inside of ROYAL CHARM (S Collett) which shifted in. Rider S Collett was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance.

Race 2 STEPHEN RALPH RACING STABLES 1400

DEFERMENT (A Calder) – Slow away.

GITCHE GUMEE (D Johnson) – Slow away. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

JAKAMA KRYSTAL (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover.	
ITS SO EASY (S Collett) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.	
RIPPEDEEDOODAH (J Waddell) – When questioned regarding performance rider J Waddell advised the mare may prefer easing of the ground.	
Race 3	BALLYMORE STABLES 1000
NONAAME (S Spratt) – Slow away.	
HIGHBORN (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover. Layout under pressure in the final straight.	
CLIQUE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres by ONLY WORDS which shifted out to obtain clear running.	
ONLY WORDS (A Goindasamy) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres inconveniencing CLIQUE . Apprentice rider A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Continued to shift out under pressure finishing wide on the track.	
LORD ARDMORE (S Collett) – Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.	
Race 4	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 metres)
TRUTH BEKNOWN (L Satherley) – Slow away. Held up until approaching the 250 metres.	
SHAMPAGNE DANCER (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer M Da Cruz advised the filly had benefited from being ridden more quietly today.	
PETITE ROSE (C Lammas) – Raced wide without cover. Crowded and checked 150 metres when weakening.	
MIDSUMMER (R Elliot) – Crowded and hampered 150 metres.	
A Goindasamy (CRIMSON STAR) – Issued with a warning after permitting CRIMSON STAR to shift in under pressure passing the 150 metres crowding MIDSUMMER onto PETITE ROSE which was checked. Footage of this incident proved inconclusive due to their being no head-on film available.	
Race 5	STEPHEN MARSH RACING STABLES 1600
EN SOIE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
QUANTUM (A Goindasamy) – Slow away.	
LAGERTHA (T Yanagida) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	
Race 6	WEXFORD STABLES 2200
CHARRED (A Calder) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
OAK (C Lammas) – Slow away. Race wide from near the 900 metres. Forced wide 450 metres.	
COMMANDING ANNIE (D Danis) – Slow way. Forced wide 450 metres.	
IZZY GEE (D Johnson) – Raced wide in the early stages.	

SAVEZAR (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. Held up for a distance passing the 600 metres then held up early in the final straight before attempting to improve into a marginal run approaching the 250 metres and was then held up for the remainder of the race.

ELLE D'BERRY (A Goindasamy) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 450 meters shifting out forcing OAK and COMMANDING ANNIE wider on the track. Apprentice A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance.

TERRACOTTA (M McNab) – Held up for clear running until shifting out approaching the 200 metres then inconvenienced near the 175 metres by DRAGON RUN which had shifted out after making brief contact.
