THOUSANDKISSESDEEP (T Taiaroa) – Tightened and checked at the start when LOTA HOOHA began awkwardly.

LOTA HOOHA (D Turner) - Began awkwardly.

GUNDAHAR (L Hemi) - Had a tendency to get its head in the air when being restrained in the early stages.

WILD WEST (J Parkes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Track upgraded to Dead(4) retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 HR JONES MAIDEN 1400 (1400 Metres)

HERMES (K Asano) – Slow away.

R Bishop (TAVIRA) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift in near the 200 metres when not fully clear of ANOTHER SECRET which was hampered.

ANOTHER SECRET (H Andrew) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.

MR PICKLES (J Parkes) – Was not persevered with over the final stages when out of contention. Rider was of the opinion MR PICKLES was sore on pulling up. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

RED RED ROBIN (L Hemi) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

SEMPER MAGICO (H Andrew) - Held up near the 400 metres having to be restrained off the heels of HAPPY TAV entering the home straight, then continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running. Shifted out to improve approaching the 100 metres and in doing so hampered MISS THE MESS. When questioned, H Andrew advised that when being angled outwards the gelding shifted out further than she intended. H Andrew was issued with warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised that she expected to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

MISS THE MESS (R Myers) - Hampered 100 metres.

R Hannam (HAPPY TAV) - Was spoken to with regards striking his mount on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4

POWER FARMING MAIDEN 1200 (1200 Metres)

SHEZ GONNA GETCHA (H Andrew) - Held up rounding the turn, disappointed for a run to the inside of JANE O' approaching the 200 metres before being angled outwards across heels to improve inside the final 200 metres.

AMAZING TEAM (D Bradley) - Had some difficulty gaining clear running early in the run home.

GOCARA (M Hudson) – Lay inwards becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of AMAZING TEAM near the 800 metres. Raced greenly throughout.

Race 5 RICHARD SIMPSON CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1550 (1550 Metres)

BEAUDZ WELL (J Riddell) – Late scratching at 4.35pm on veterinary advice after injuring itself in the tie ups.

DANZ I AM (K Asano) – Slow away.

TAKE A GAMBLE (T Allan) - Tightened at the start when JESSIE'S ROCK began awkwardly.

JESSIE'S ROCK (R Hannam) - Began awkwardly.

PRINCESS PRISCILLA (T Taiaroa) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NEXT HOOK (D Turner) - Lay out near the 400 metres.

CHANCEUX (J Parkes) – Tightened shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground, settling back. Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres. Returned to the enclosure showing signs of lameness. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be mildly lame in the near foreleg.

PEERLESS WARRIOR (R Myers) - Disappointed for a run to the inside of CHANCEUX which shifted in near the 250 metres, before being angled outwards to improve approaching the 100 metres.

Race 6 NEW WORLD MARTON 1550 (1550 Metres)

ARIDITY (L Hemi) – Slow away. When questioned into performance rider could offer no tangible excuse other than the mare may appreciate some easing of the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

BRONSTEEL (T Taiaroa) - Held up entering the home straight then disappointed for a marginal run to the outside of LADY RUDOLPH having to be steadied passing 200 metres, gaining clear running briefly inside the final 100 metres prior to running up on to heels over the final stages.

Race 7 CENTRAL ITM 2100 (2100 Metres)

FRANKLIN (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

BELINDABELLA (R Bishop) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

KIT KAT (T Allan) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HYPATIA (L Hemi) – Ran up on to the heels of FRANKLIN near the 400 metres and checked.

OVERTHETOP (D Turner) - Commenced to give ground rounding the turn and was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 400 metres, going back on to PONDERING, which was inconvenienced. When questioned, rider had no excuse for the disappointing run. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

PONDERING (C O'Beirne) - Inconvenienced 400 metres.
