Rider Changes: Race 1 T Comignaghi replaced J Lowry (RAISE YA CARDS) – overweight.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 PARKSIDE PANELS / TITIROA TRANSPORT (2000m)

RENOUNCE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly.

DOONA'S SISTER (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Over-raced near the 1600 metres, becoming awkwardly positioned close to the heels of SOUTHERN GENT, having to shift ground outwards and when doing so dictated SENOR MOSS wider on the track.

MY CASHIER (K Williams) – Slow to begin. Raced wide when improving to a forward position near the 1200 metres.

SENOR MOSS (B Murray) – Dictated wider on the track near the 1600 metres. Raced wide from the 800 metres when

improving forward.

PICTURE THIS (J Laking) – Had to be steadied near the 650 metres when RAISE YA CARDS (T Comignaghi) shifted ground outwards. T Comignaghi was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

BENLACHIE (K Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied near the 400 metres when awkwardly placed close to the heels of PICTURE THIS, when that runner lay inwards.

RAISE YA CARDS (T Comignaghi) – T Comignaghi replaced J Lowry who was unable to make the contract weight. Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 150 metres.

J Lowry admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight. After hearing penalty submissions from all parties the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Lowry's riding licence from the 11th March up to and including 18th March (6 days.)

R Mudhoo (DOONA'S SISTER) was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) when using his whip on a runner out of contention.

Following the running of this race the official track conditions were downgraded to Slow 7 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200m)

MIRADELLO (S Wynne) – Fractious in the gates prior to the start.

VERDIGRIS (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly.

ICANTTELLYA (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Raced wide in the early stages.

EAVESDROP (C Campbell) – Raced wide in the early stages.

FAIRWAY FLIGHT (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

JUST A GIRL (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

LLOVIZNA (T Comignaghi) – Had to be steadied near the 700 metres when there was a slight easing of the pace. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the mare was not entirely comfortable in today's Slow 7 track conditions.

Race 3 AB LIME / RODGERS GARAGE (1200m)

The start time of this race was delayed 1 minute at the request of TAB Control.

THE FABULOUS PEARL (T Comignaghi) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Unable to gain clear racing room throughout the home straight, going to the line untested by its rider.

OUR KELDON (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

SWAMPMAN (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

EXCHANGE (J Lowry) – Raced wide throughout and made the bend by the 700 metres awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had raced above itself in a fresh state.

SUGAR FOR MY HONEY (A Bohorun) – Hung inwards throughout, with apprentice rider A Bohorun advising he would be recommending gear changes in an effort to rectify this tendency.

UP MY SLEEVE (T Moseley) – Lay inwards over the concluding stages and could not be ridden to full advantage.

Rider J Laking (BEESLASTSTING) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 MLT / CALDWELL CONTRACTING FIRESIDE CUP (1200m)

PIPPI REA (T Comignaghi) – Slipped badly leaving the barriers almost dislodging the rider and then tailed the field

throughout, finishing in a distant last placing. When questioned regarding this, rider advised that after slipping at the start the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stewards will follow up with connections in the coming days.

Race 5 AUTO WINDSCREEN REPLACEMENTS / VETCO EDENDALE (1335m)

RETALIATE (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

NO QUANTUM (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly crowding HOMBRE.

HOMBRE (C Johnson) – Crowded at the start.

LUGANO'S ACE (K Chowdhoory) – Hampered shortly after the start when an inside runner shifted ground.

MARMADUKE (K Selvan) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

MY SOVA (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide in the early stages. Inconvenienced near the 1000 metres.

BLAIR FLIGHT (J Laking) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages and when shifted outwards to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres, inconvenienced MY SOVA.

TRIP IN TIME (K Kwo) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of ROX near the 150 metres, having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.

MOUNT HERCULES (K Asano) – Lay inwards near the 200 metres placing SHAKER in restricted room momentarily.

SHAKER (C Campbell) – Raced in restricted room momentarily near the 200 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding would appreciate further distance and more cut in the ground.

Race 6 ADVANCE AGRICULTURE / HERBERTS TRANSPORT (1335m)

GELIBOLU (T Moseley) – Very reluctant to load with the connections being advised the gelding was on a barrier manner warning and will now be loaded early for future starts.

AULYN STAR (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

CABERNET (C Johnson) – Slow to begin.

RINGBOLT (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding would benefit from further distance.

HAZELNUT (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that being trapped wide throughout had taken its toll on the mare when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 7 MACAULAY MOTORS / LES FRISBY CONTRACTING (1335m)

MOLLY POLLY (R Beeharry) – Got back shortly after the start.

RUBY MARIE (K Mudhoo) – Got back shortly after the start. Held up briefly over the concluding stages.

FIRE KATYUSHA (K Kwo) – Raced keenly when leading through the early and middle stages.

PROMISING (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout.

MALAWI (A Mudhoo) – Lost the off-front racing plate during the running.

MARQUITA MISS (C Johnson) – Underwent a post-race Veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be a bleeder and as such is stood down for the mandatory period of 3 months prior to returning to the trials or racing.

Race 8 AON INSURANCE / PGG WRIGHTSON WYNDHAM CUP (2000m)

SHAKTI (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

NOMEN LUDI (T Moseley) – Lost its footing in behind as the start was made, losing ground. Over-raced near the 1200 metres. Raced wide from the 900 metres.

RIVIERA ROCK (S Wynne) – Over-raced through the early stages. Raced wide through the middle stages.

PICTURE ME ROLLIN (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages. Made the crossing near the 1500 metres awkwardly when dictated wider on the track by BEAM ME UP SCOTTY briefly losing its footing. Raced wide from the 1000 metres and very wide rounding the final bend. Shifted in passing the 175 metres, then when struck with the whip again shifted in abruptly. R Mudhoo was issued with a warning for allowing his runner to shift ground inwards passing the 175 metres resulting in FINBARR being crowded and checked. In assessing this penalty Stewards took into account the simultaneous movement from BEAM ME UP SCOTTY.

THE GORDONIAN (K Chowdhoory) – Rider dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

WILD JACK (A Bohorun) – Held up passing the 200 metres and went to the line untested by its rider.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (K Williams) – Shifted ground outwards when negotiating the crossing near the 1500 metres. Shifted out marginally passing the 175 metres crowding FINBARR. K Williams was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

FINBARR (K Kwo) - Crowded and checked at the 175 metres.

KILOWATT (K Asano) – Held up briefly over the concluding stages.

Race 9 HILLSIDE METALS PINEBUSH CUP (2000m)

ADDITUP (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly.

LEULUAI (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and shifted out at the start hampering an outside runner. Held up near the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

FINE BOUQUET (K Kwo) – Slow to begin then hampered shortly after the start when an inside runner shifted ground.

STELLACANTO (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages.

DRUMGOLD (C Barnes) – Raced wide and keenly in the middle stages.

RAINMAN (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the middle stages and was held up rounding the final bend by tiring runners. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that after being held up rounding the final bend the gelding had only battled fairly over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.

Race 10 ROBERT DENNIS RACING STABLES (2000m)

SUPERSTITION (S Wynne) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after being fractious in the barriers and was cleared to start. Slow to begin. Hampered shortly after the start when PERFECTO shifted ground outwards. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the mare had become worked up in the barriers prior to the start however added SUPERSTITION had not handled the prevailing Slow 7 track conditions. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (A Bohorun) - Slow to begin.

CHOOKIE'S GIRL (C Campbell) – Very slow to begin. Raced wide through the middle stages.

NEVER QUITZ (C Johnson) – Over-raced through the early stages.

PERFECTO (J Lowry) – Raced wide through the middle stages.

J Lowry was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for allowing his runner to shift ground inwards near the 550 metres when not fully clear of TAI HO which was checked.

COCEE (B Murray) – Raced wide from the 1200 metres.

ODYSSEUS (T Moseley) – Rider was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground near the 550 metres.

TAI HO (K Kwo) – Had to be steadied when racing between ODYSSEUS (T Moseley) and PERFECTO (J Lowry) near the 550 metres. Rider briefly unbalanced near the 400 metres.
