SKAABOOM (S Wynne) – Held up momentarily prior to entering the home straight, had to be straightened for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

TUILANA (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider stated in his opinion the horse is better suited to a more rain affected track.

VARDON ROAD was a late scratching at 12.29 pm on veterinary advice after being kicked behind the barriers.

MY EXCUSE (R Mudhoo) – Slow away.

DANCING CHOUX (T Comignaghi) – Jumped away awkwardly and had to be straightened, had to be steadied after being crowded passing the 50 metres after MADAM SEQUOIA shifted ground inwards.

CHITTER CHAT (G Jogoo) – Raced three wide without cover.

EASY ON THE EYE (D Prastiyou) – Raced wide entering the home straight.

D Prastiyou (EASY ON THE EYE) was spoken to regarding his whip use.

PIPIANA (K Chowdhoory) – Jumped in the air at the start losing ground, held up approaching the 200 metres and shifted out to obtain a clear run.

FLYTIME (S Wynne) – Restrained to shift inwards and obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier and tailed the field throughout. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

BARABAS (W Papier) – Jumped awkwardly and got its head up.

VASILIKI (Y Chew) – Caught wide passing the 800 metres and remained wide for the rest of the race.

CLOONEY (J Laking) – Held up approaching the 300 metres and shifted out to obtain a clear run.

THE EMPORESS (L Allpress) – Slow away.

ANDALE ANDALE (T Moseley) – Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

RESUSCITATE (R Beeharry) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced very wide without cover throughout. Apprentice rider Beeharry was questioned regarding his riding tactics and in particular why he did not attempt to obtain cover early in the race, being advised he is expected to show much better judgement in future.

DR PEPPER (W Papier) – Slow away.

BUTTON (J Fawcett) – Raced three wide without cover.

YOUNEVERKNOW (K Williams) – Raced wide throughout.

KHITAN WARRIOR (C Campbell) – Got its head up after having to be steadied passing the 900 metres.

ITSONLYMONEY (K Kwo) – Held up approaching the 450 metres.

CAITLYN JAY (K Asano) – Bumped short of the finishing line when GRAND EXPRESS shifted outwards under pressure.

Race 5	BETTY WADLEY MEMORIAL R82 2200M

PRODUCER (S Wynne) – Slow away, made contact with a section of the running rail which had become dislodged near the 1600 metres, held up between runners passing the 500 metres. Required post race veterinary treatment for superficial abrasions to the left stifle.

NATHAN DETROIT (C Barnes) – Slow away, made contact with a section of the running rail which had become dislodged near the 1600 metres. Required post race veterinary treatment to a deep laceration to the left hind leg with a veterinary clearance now required prior to racing next.

SHOWPIN (BB Hong) – When questioned regarding performance the rider was unable to offer any excuse, with co-trainer T Prendergast advising that the gelding will now be retired from racing. A post race veterinary inspection found the gelding to have a poor recovery rate.

BABAN (A Balloo) – Made contact with the running rail when negotiating the crossing near the 1600 metres, PRODUCER and NATHAN DETROIT which were following both then made contact with a portion of the running rail which had become dislodged.

SHAZ THE BANK (D Prastiyou) – Lay inwards when entering the home straight with the rider having to straighten, lay outwards in the final 300 metres and had to be straightened again.

RED RIVER ROCK (K Asano) – Held up entering the 350 metres and had to change ground to obtain clear running.

A Balloo (BABAN) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres (11 strikes) with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing today up to and including 23 March.

S Wynne (PRODUCER) was issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres (7 strikes).

Race 6	MORRISON'S SADDLERY & FEED MDN 2200M

BOGATYR (J Laking) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced three wide without cover until near the 1400 metres.

JUNE ROSE (K Williams) – Slow away.

FIVE PRINCES (C Johnson) – Obligated to race wide approaching the 1800 metres.

VIVACE LADY (T Comignaghi) – Raced in restricted room near the 350 metres.

ROCKWITHME (K Asano) – Shifted wide to obtain a clear run passing the 250 metres.

LAST LETTER (A Balloo) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres when struck with the whip.

Race 7	PENDENE FARM LTD R65 1200M

MIDSUMMER MAGIC (K Asano) – Restrained on jumping away to shift to a position closer to the running rail from a wide barrier.

DUTCH COURAGE (J Laking) – Crowded for a distance leaving the barriers when runners either side shifted ground.

TAP 'N' GO (R Mudhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly being unbalanced for a distance when making contact, held up early in the straight then having to be checked when disappointed for a run between MONTREUX MISS and DUTCH COURAGE approaching the 200 metres.

MONTREUX MISS (S Wynne) – Jumped away awkwardly being unbalanced for a distance when making contact, raced wide without cover.

PARK RANGER (G Jogoo) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide barrier, had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of TAP 'N' GO near the 200 metres.

CAMPO (A Balloo) – Raced three wide without cover outside the leaders.

VIVA LA BLUES (J Fawcett) – Held up entering the straight and did not obtain clear running until shifting across heels approaching the 200 metres.

Race 8	ECOLAB R82 1400M

QUINTUPLE TWINS (C Johnson) – Bounded leaving the barriers and was slow away as a result, hampered near the 1000 metres, had some difficulty obtaining clear running for a distance passing the 200 metres.

EL BEE DARCI (R Mudhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly, got its head up when having to be firmly restrained after improving onto the heels of JUST PUSH PLAY when the pace steadied approaching the 1000 metres.

R Beeharry (TICKET TO RIDE) admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards approaching the 1000 metres when not sufficiently clear of SHARP 'N' SILVER which was dictated inwards crowding HE'S GOLD which was severely checked. Hampered as a result were MONRECOUR and QUINTUPLE TWINS. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended R Beeharry's licence to ride at national race meetings for 9 days effective from the conclusion of racing today up to and including 28 March.

HE'S GOLD (Y Chew) – Severely checked near the 1000 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and was confirmed as a bleeder following an endoscopic examination. HE'S GOLD is now subject to the mandatory stand down periods, with trainer D Champion indicating that the gelding is likely to be retired from racing.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (K Asano) – Crowded and dictated inwards near the 1000 metres.

MONRECOUR (K Williams) – Hampered near the 1000 metres.

DREAMING EASY (L Allpress) – Raced three wide without cover.

KARIMA was a late scratching at 3.25 pm on veterinary advice after being injured when being transported to the course.

GOLDEN VALKYRIE (K Mudhoo) – Slow away (4L).

COUP DREAMWOOD (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin.

LINCOLN ZEPHYR (C Campbell) – Jumped away awkwardly.

HILLERSDEN (J Laking) – Held up momentarily when entering the home straight.
