## SUPPLEMENTARY:

B Lammas had transport difficulties and was unable to fulfil his engagement on BATTLE ROYAL so was replaced by R Elliott in race 1.
R Hannam advised stewards that he had transport difficulties and was unable to fulfil his engagement on TAKE A GAMBLE in race 4 so was replaced by R Elliott.

## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>STABLE BOOKS PIKE RACING 1800 HIGHWEIGHT</b>
<b>BATTLE ROYAL</b> (R Elliott) – Shifted out abruptly at the start dictating FRATELLO outwards into the line of PASSWORD.	
<b>FRATELLO</b> (M Gillies) – Dictated outwards at start. Made the first corner awkwardly hampering BEAU GESTE then raced in	

restricted room rounding the first turn.

**REMARX** (M Cropp) – Had to steady and got its head in the air near the 300 metres when BEAU GESTE shifted in marginally, simultaneously as BATTLE ROYAL shifted out. When questioned M Cropp advised that although in restricted room his mount had over reacted when being steadied.

**WONDER LASS** (S O'Malley) – Had to steady near the 1500 metres when BULLITT shifted in when not the required distance clear. S Fannin was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).

**BEAU GESTE** (M Roustoby) – Hampered at start. Raced three wide in the early and middle stages.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>STABLE BOOKS BROOKS BAKER RACING MAIDEN 2000M</b>

**NOWANAGEN** (M Gillies) – Bounded at the start began awkwardly and lost ground. Shifted out to improve near the 350 metres and in doing so dictated BORDER LEICESTER over extra ground M Gillies was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**BORDER LEICESTER** (S Fannin) – Dictated over extra ground.

**MONEY SHOT** (S O'Malley) – Slow away. S O'Malley was issued with a warning with regard to his whip use in succession when well back and out of contention.

**CURIOUS GEORGE** (N Downs) – Began awkwardly and shifted out. N Downs was issued with a warning with regard to his whip use in succession near the 700 metres.

**OPAL CRUSHER** (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Went amiss shortly after entering the back straight and was attended to by veterinary staff before being humanely euthanized after sustaining a right front pastern fracture. The horse ambulance was deployed.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>STABLE BOOKS BAKER RACING MAIDEN 1200M</b>

**BOSTON STRONG BOY** (J Parkes) – Bounded at the start and lost ground.

**BLAZE SEVEN** (S Collett) – Got back at the start after beginning awkwardly. Hung outwards rounding the turn when racing greenly and ran wide on the corner near the 400 metres.

**PIRIWAI** (S Macnab) – Was held up for some distance in the early part of the home straight. When questioned S Macnab advised that despite being held up early in the home straight the mare finished the race off only fairly when in clear running.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>STABLE BOOKS KINGSCLERE STABLES MAIDEN 1600</b>

**NOGOLF ETIKIT** (C Grylls) – was restrained from a wide draw.

**SORRY I'M LATE** (L Allpress) – Reported that the mare had hung throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a cut to the inside cheek caused by a sharp molar.

When questioned into the disappointing run of SWISS AVENUE R Myers had no tangible excuse and said the mare was disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

**BEAUDZ WELL** (C Grylls) – Shied at the crossing shortly after the start resulting in the rider becoming unbalanced.

**SOUTHROAD** (D Turner) – Had to steady passing the 850 metres after PEERLESS WARRIOR after shifting in when not fully clear. L Allpress was advised to exercise care.

**NEVERSTOPLAUGHING** (H Andrew) – Was slow into stride and got back. (4L) Had to make its run four wide rounding the turn.

**CAPELYN (S Collett)** – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**WILLY AWAY** (L Allpress) – Was held up throughout the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested.

**VENT** (J Fawcett) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>REMEMBERING HAROLD TUSON MAIDEN 1400M</b>

**ROSE OF DELGATIE** (L Hemi) – Hampered at the start when GALLARDO shifted out. Over raced in the back straight.

**GOLDCHI** (J Fawcett) – Shifted out approaching the crossing in the back straight dictating MARY SCHIK outwards into the line of PARKA'S LADY which had to take evasive action.

**JAXX BE NIMBLE** (L Allpress) – Over raced in the back straight. When questioned into the run L Allpress had no excuse other than over racing in early and middle stages.

**MARY SCHIK** (C Grylls) – Dictated outwards approaching the crossing on to the course proper. Held up for some distance around the turn.
