TAKE THAT (J Parkes) – Trainer F Auret advised Stewards that the colt has pulled up well after his race. F Auret further advised that TAKE THAT will now be gelded and sent for a brief spell.

Race 1	VDS FARRIERS/CAMBRIDGE EQUINE DENTAL SERVICES 2000
HATTIE BEE (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	
MIGHTY CONNOR (C Grylls) – Slow away.	
GORGEOUS IN GOLD (E McCall) - Raced three wide, until improving forward passing the 1400 metres.	
RIP EM UP (J Waddell) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight making contact on a number occasions with ANNA CECELIA which was inclined to lay out.	
TE WAEWAE BAY (S Collett) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Connection were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.	
E McCall - Issued with a warning for her whip use on a runner out of contention.	
Race 2	KB BLOODSTOCK 1100
PERFECTIONIST (T Yanagida) - Steadied when in restricted room near the 1000 metres.	
Race 3	TREVOR DA CRUZ RACING 1200
LADY DE VERE (R Jones) - Began awkwardly losing ground.	
VICENZA (R Elliot) – Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start when PHANTOM WITNESS (O Bosson) shifted in when not fully clear. O Bosson was advised to exercise care.	
PETITE ROSE (T Yanagida) - Raced keenly in the early stages.	
MIDNIGHT MAGIC (S Collett) - Inconvenienced inside the final 50 metres by PHANTOM WITNESS which shifted out when racing greenly.	
PHANTOM WITNESS (O Bosson) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

KYLIE BAX (J Waddell) – Slow away.	
KAINUI ROSE (C Burdan) - Raced wide without cover.	
SIMONA (R Elliot) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.	

LADY LIRA (C Grylls) – Held up until shifting out passing the 300 metres.

COMBAT QUEEN (O Bosson) – Held up rounding the bend then had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

NO FINER PINS (C Lammas) - Held up until near the 300 metres.

BRAVISSIMO (J Fawcett) - Held up for a distance passing the 250 metres.

INTELLIGENT PATCH (M McNab) – Connections elected to replace O Bosson with M McNab as he was 0.5kg overweight. Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

IF AT FIRST (C Lammas) – Slow away.

CASTLE BLACK (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LAPAGLIA (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly shifting in making contact with SPACEK, then continued to lay in for a distance.

SPACEK (C Burdan) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

GRAND SPIRIT (R Oliver) - Began awkwardly.

GRACIES GOLD (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ROLL THE GOLD (J Fawcett) - Stumbled shortly after leaving the barrier.

KHORABELLA (D Danis) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the mare had never travelled comfortably throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

SAGUNTO (S McKay) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

STARRYBEEL (T Yanagida) – Held up until shifting out across heels passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

CAPTAIN NEWZEALAND (J Waddell) – Slow away. Improved onto heels passing the 1500 metres having to be firmly restrained then shifted out abruptly to avoid heels hampering SOUTHERN VOGUE, ANNALONE and PARKVIEW.

STRATIUS (R Oliver) - Began awkwardly and when being corrected made contact with PARKVIEW which became unbalanced. Crowded passing the 1650 metres. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PARKVIEW (J Fawcett) - Unbalanced shortly after the start. Hampered passing the 1500 metres.

PIGGY MALONE (V Colgan) – Crowded passing the 1700 metres when MEGHAN (L Innes) lay out contributing was inward movement from HENLEY ROAD which crowded ANNALONE, STRATIUS and HEZA BIG HOPE inwards. L Innes was advised to exercise care.

ANNALONE (T Yanagida) - Crowded and steadied passing the 1650 metres to the inside of HENLEY ROAD (S McKay) which shifted in when not fully clear contributing was outward movement from MEGHAN. S McKay was advised to exercise care. Hampered passing the 1500 metres. Steadied after improving onto heels over the concluding stages.

HEZA BIG HOPE (S Collett) - Crowded passing the 1650 metres.

KIPCHOGE (C Grylls) - Commenced to over race when being restrained passing the 1600 metres then had to be firmly restrained passing the 1500 metres after improving onto the heels of MEGHAN dropping back onto CAPTAIN NEWZEALAND.

SOUTHERN VOGUE (D Danis) - Hampered passing the 1500 metres.

HENLEY ROAD (S McKay) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres after improving onto the heels of the weakening STRATIUS.
