RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BAYLEYS COUNTRY HANDICAP (1600 metres)
<p>ROYAL CHARM (M Coleman) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious dislodging its rider in the barrier and was cleared to start. Trainer M Brooks was advised that a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>TRIOMPHE (R Elliot) – Slow away.</p> <p>ENDEAN LASS (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Could not obtain clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>BAD 'N' BOUJ (S McKay) – Over-raced for a distance approaching the 1000 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p>SUNBURST (D Danis) – Over-raced for a distance approaching the 1000 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p>SPONDULIX (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>KIWIANNA (D Johnson) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>LOOKS LIKE (V Colgan) – Could not obtain clear running in the final straight until passing the 50 metres.</p>	
Race 2	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1300 metres)
<p>WALKIN' BY (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly and steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>VEINE D'OR (S Spratt) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw.</p> <p>TUTTA LA CLASSE (S Collett) – Steadied approaching the 350 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>HONNEUR NOIR (M Cameron) – Steadied over the concluding stages when laying out across the heels of WALKIN' BY which shifted in. D Johnson was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Lost the near fore plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	TRITON PACIFIC OWENS PLATE (1200 metres)
<p>FLORENCE JEAN (S Collett) – Slow away.</p> <p>VIRTUOSO LAD (S Weatherley) – Slow away.</p> <p>BEVAN STREET (M Hashizume) – Slow away then had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels. Hampered when improving on to heels near the 850 metres.</p> <p>BLOOD WARRIOR (S McKay) – Commenced to lay in soon after leaving the barrier. Hampered 850 metres by PIMMS 'N' PEARLS which shifted out to avoid the heels of REGENT STREET which shifted out when steadying.</p> <p>SAIGNON (R Elliot) – Steadied when in restricted room near the 1100 metres. Not persevered with in the home straight and underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be lame in the right foreleg. Co-trainer G Rogerson was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to SAIGNON racing next.</p> <p>THE DOM (D Johnson) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>PIMMS 'N' PEARLS (L Innes) – Received veterinary attention for a minor laceration to the left hind leg following the race.</p>	

Race 4	BAYLEYS RESIDENTIAL HANDICAP (2100 metres)
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OHTHOSERUSSIANS (A Goindasamy) – Underwent a veterinary examination upon arrival at the barrier at the request of apprentice jockey A Goindasamy and was cleared fit to start.

AVOCA WILLOW (D Danis) – Hampered shortly after leaving the barriers.

DANGERMAN (T Newman) – Commenced to over-race near the 1700 metres shifting out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels running wide, then raced wide without cover. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after becoming tailed off which did not reveal any abnormality.

MY ZULU WARRIOR (S Collett) – Crowded and checked 300 metres by AVOCA WILLOW which shifted out under pressure with MY ZULU WARRIOR then making contact with the hind quarters of VEDO ROSSO which became unbalanced.

VEDO ROSSO (M Hashizume) – Hampered leaving the barriers. Contacted and unbalanced 300 metres.

D Danis (AVOCA WILLOW) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted AVOCA WILLOW to shift out near the 300 metres when insufficiently clear of MY ZULU WARRIOR which was checked. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended D Danis' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, 21 March, up to and including racing on 2 April, 6 national riding days.

PETRABELLA (L Innes) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had been disappointing and may now benefit from the removal of visor blinkers.

OUR WONDERLAND (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding the improved performance co-trainer G Rogerson advised the gelding had been schooling leading into today's race.

DAWNLIGHT (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance rider M Cameron could offer no excuse.

Race 5	J SWAP CONTRACTORS BAY OF PLENTY CUP (2100 metres)
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SWORDS DRAWN (D Johnson) – Slow away and had to be restrained when awkwardly placed on heels losing ground.

MONGOLIANCONQUEROR (C Grylls) – Hampered 1500 metres when becoming awkwardly placed near heels.

SWING NOTE (R Kozaki) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance Rider R Kozaki advised that after settling further back than intended the mare had failed to quicken when placed under pressure passing the 500 metres and in his opinion may be better suited to be ridden further forward in its races. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

LADY SHABEEL (S Weatherley) – Raced wide until near the 1400 metres. Checked 300 metres losing ground.

LONDON BANKER (M Coleman) – Contacted 300 metres and continued to make contact on several occasions.

BULLY BOY (M Hashizume) – Hung out making the final turn and shifted outwards when struck with the whip near the 300 metres crowding LADY SHABEEL which was checked. Continued to shift out under pressure making contact with LONDON BANKER which then lay in with both runners making contact on several occasions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after rider M Hashizume reported the gelding had shown signs of lameness returning to scale. BULLY BOY was found to have grade 4/5 lameness in the right foreleg. Co-trainer S Clotworthy was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to the gelding racing next.

M Hashizume (BULLY BOY) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted BULLY BOY to shift out near the 300 metres when insufficiently clear of LADY SHABEEL which was checked. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Hashizume’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 28 March up to and including racing on 5 April, 6 national riding days.

Following the race the connections of the 2nd placed horse **BULLY BOY** requested to view Stewards footage electing not to proceed with a protest.

JUSTA BOY BULLSEYE (S Spratt) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after becoming tailed off – no abnormality was found.

Race 6	ULTIMATE MAZDA JAPAN TROPHY (1600 metres)
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GO NICHOLAS (M Coleman) – Made contact with the front gate as the start was effected forcing the gate open slightly early and was hampered as a result losing ground. Following the race rider M Coleman viewed Stewards footage of the start and was satisfied there was no mechanical malfunction and the poor start was the result of the gelding’s own manners. Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1300 metres shifting out and making contact with OCEAN BILLY which then over-raced.

NASHA RIVA (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

OCEAN BILLY (J Fawcett) – Slow away. Over-raced when contacted 1300 metres.

J Fawcett OCEAN BILLY – Issued with a warning for using her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

D Johnson SCOTT BASE – Reminded of her obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 7	BAYLEYS COMMERCIAL HANDICAP (1600 metres)
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FABULOUS FLIGHT (R Kozaki) – Stumbled leaving the barrier.

KINSHASA (M Coleman) – Very slow to begin (10L). Trainer C Cole was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare’s barrier manners.

BIRDSONG (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

MAZZURO (D Johnson) – Slow away. Held up for a distance entering the final straight and early in the final straight before shifting out to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres. Crowded over the concluding stages when improving into restricted between INCANTESIMO (C Grylls) which shifted out under pressure and KATIE PERRIE which was dictated in by KINSHASA. C Grylls was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

KATIE PERRIE (B R Jones) – Crowded over the concluding stages by KINSHASA which shifted in under pressure.

M Coleman (KINSHASA) – Issued with a warning after permitting KINSHASA to shift in over the concluding stages crowding KATIE PERRIE on to MAZZURO which had improved on to heels.
