RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ELECTRONET SERVICES LTD MAIDEN 2000m
OCEANS AWAY (K Chowdoory) – Jumped away awkwardly hampering WALK WITH KINGS and JUNE ROSE.	
WALK WITH KINGS (A Balloo) – Hampered start.	
JUNE ROSE (K Mudhoo) – Hampered start.	
EAGLE FIFTY (D Hirini) - Slow to begin. Caught wide passing the 1000 metres.	
HOUBOUCHOUX (S Toolooa) – Made the first turn awkwardly and ran wide.	

SECRET RUNNER (S Macnab) – Caught wide early stages.

RELIABLY PERKY (K Williams) – Steadied to avoid heels near the 800 metres. Held up behind the weakening **CRIKEY ITS GEORGE** from the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

BLUE DANN (L Callaway) – Gave ground from the 600 metres finishing a distant last. The rider was unable to offer any excuse and a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormalities.

DANNY GREEN (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after being taken on in front once headed the gelding had been quickly beaten and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

Race 2 | **TASMAN AGRICULTURE 2000m**

KATIEM MARIE (S Macnab) – Slow away.

EM KAY POPS (S Toolooa) – Steadied when awkwardly placed when inside the heels of **THUNDER BAY** near the 1700 metres.

LOCALLY SAUCED (C Johnson) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

THUNDER BAY (K Chowdhoo) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that after having a good trip the mare had failed to see out the distance of today's race.

Race 3 | **VERNON & VAZEY MAIDEN 1020m**

ARE YOU CEREAL (L Callaway) – Slow away.

FIRMAMENT (K Chowdhoo) – Slow away. K Chowdhoo was spoken to regarding his whip action in the final straight.

ATAAHUALUVTHEDREAM (T Moseley) – Raced four wide without cover.

SHANLANE (D Hirini) – Raced three wide without cover.

Race 4 | **GREG DALY REAL ESTATE 1020m**

DIVA EXPRESS (R Mudhoo) – Became fractious in the barriers prior to the start with the rider being unseated. R Mudhoo and **DIVA EXPRESS** were removed from the barriers with both horse and rider being cleared to start and being reloaded. Jumped away awkwardly.

KATE THE GREAT (T Comignaghi) – Slow away. Held up for a distance rounding the bend near the 300 metres.

PROMISING (K Kwo) – Raced three wide without cover. Eased down over the concluding stages with the rider advising, that after travelling wide, that the mare had made the bend awkwardly and been quickly beaten. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection but as the mare had already left the course this was unable to be carried out. Stewards will follow up with co-trainer, Mr K Tyler.

WYNMOORE (A Balloo) – Lay out home straight and inconvenienced **WAY ABOVE** and **BRUZO** by shifting them wider on the track.

D Hirini was spoken to regarding her use of the whip behind the barriers.

Race 5 | **BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES 1400m**

MEARA MARY (K Chowdhooory) – Crowded at the start between TOUCH THE SKY and SOLOMON which both began awkwardly and shifted ground. Had a tendency to over race in the early and middle stages.

SOLOMON (J LAKING) – Began awkwardly making contact.

TOUCH THE SKY (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly making contact.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

Race 6 | **ARCHMORE CONTRACTORS & FAHEY CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1400m**

OUR ROSETTE (K Chowdhooory) – Slow away. Raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the winning post on the first occasion getting its head up and shifted outwards making the first turn awkwardly. Again raced ungenerously when being steadied after becoming awkwardly placed near heels approaching 800 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised he had not received a clear run in transit but had failed to finish the race off and maybe better suited over a shorter distance, in his opinion. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

TOP GHIA (S Macnab) – Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers. Held up for a distance near the 400 metres.

LADY CAMORRA (R Mudhoo) – Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers. Steadied when passing the 1200 metres and then having to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of OUR ROSETTE.

HIJACKED (D Hirini) – Commenced to over race approaching the winning post on the first occasion continued to race fiercely for some distance and shifted outwards crowding DON'T DOUBT CHOUX, which was hampered. Lay-in under pressure in the home straight.

DON'T DOUBT CHOUX (K Mudhoo) – Hampered going into the first turn near the 1200 metres.

TE MOKOPUNA (T Moseley) – Placed in restricted room to the inside of SPINDLESHANKS passing the 150 metres.

EXPRESSIVE (K Kwo) – Raced three wide without cover.

Race 7 | **WILD BUCK' NZ ALE/IKAMATUA HOTEL REEFTON CUP 1400m**

NOWHERE MAN (K Chowdhooory) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to over race when the pace eased near the 1100 metres and improved forward to lead near the 800 metres.

XCUSES XCUSES (C Johnson) – Commenced to over race shortly after the start and made the first turn near the 1200 metres awkwardly running wide hampering TORRE DEL GRECO, then continued to over race into the middle stages.

TORRE DEL GRECO (S Macnab) – Hampered going into the first turn near the 1200 metres, having to be steadied. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

TICKET TO RIDE (K Williams) – Raced ungenerously approaching the crossing near the 1100 metres going back onto HE'S GOLD, which was hampered.

HE'S GOLD (B Morgenrood) – Hampered near the 1100 metres. Placed in restricted room when TICKET TO RIDE shifted inwards when under pressure just near the finish.

B Morgenrood was spoken to regarding his use of the whip on consecutive strides prior to the winning post.

Race 8**REEFTON CRANE & CONSTRUCTION 1400m**

SHANPARK (S Macnab) – Slow away then commenced to over race for a distance shortly after the start.

SWISS EIRE (K Chowdhooory) – Raced fiercely early stages. Inconvenienced 150 metres.

VIVA LA BLUES (C Johnson) – Held up near the 300 metres, then was steadied to shift outwards across the heels of MOREIRA near the 150 metres inconveniencing the weakening SWISS EIRE. Raced in restricted room between MOREIRA and WHY ME over the final 100 metres when both those runners shifted ground and was unable to be ridden out over the concluding stages as a result.
