## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NIGHT N DAY MAIDEN 1200m</b>
<b>Trainer J Coutts</b> (PLEADINGGUILTY) – Admitted a breach of Rule 616(4) in that he failed to remove items of notified gear and was fined \$100 by the JCA.	
<b>GALLANT FREDI</b> (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Lay in once placed under pressure in the home straight.	

<b>SOMBRA DEAMOR</b> (T Comignaghi) – Steadied when crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.	
<b>PLEADINGGUILTY</b> (C Barnes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>THE FABULOUS PEARL</b> (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.	
<b>ANTICIPATE</b> (C Campbell) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>LINDSAY MOYLE MEMORIAL 1200m</b>
<b>OUR TEDDY BOY</b> (C Campbell) – Jumped away awkwardly.	
<b>FIRE SHOW</b> (T Comignaghi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the straight.	
Stewards questioned apprentice W Papier (CONFESSIONAL) with trainer M Pitman present in regards to his ride. Of concern to the Stewards was that CONFESSIONAL had remained wide throughout the running when leading. W Papier advised that he had been instructed to stay one off the rail which was confirmed by trainer M Pitman but it was acknowledged that he had overdone these instructions. Stewards advised W Papier that he had erred in his judgement and that even in light of the instructions given, he should have positioned his mount closer to the rail.	
Following the running of this event the track was downgraded to Dead 4 after consultation with the riders.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>TEMUKA TRANSPORT 1200m</b>
<b>Trainers M &amp; M Pitman</b> – Fined \$50 after presenting SWISS EIRE with incorrect saddle cloth number.	
<b>SECRET SOUND</b> (C Barnes) – Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout. Rider reported the mare had held its breath during the running.	
<b>OUT OF ACES</b> (R Mudhoo) – Over raced in the early to middle stages with the rider reporting that the saddle had shifted sideways placing the rider at a disadvantage.	
<b>LADY DAVONE</b> (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PETER LYON SHEARING 1600m</b>
<b>MISS ATOMIC BOMB</b> (J Laking) – After becoming fractious in the barriers was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection and was cleared to race.	
<b>MEMO</b> (B Murray) – Slow to begin. Tailed the field throughout finishing in last placing. Rider reported the mare had hung inwards throughout and proved a difficult ride.	
<b>OUTCOME</b> (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. Rider C Barnes advised that gelding had been under pressure throughout and would be better suited to more distance and tracks with more moisture in them.	
<b>VERDIGRIS</b> (R Mudhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly	
<b>DANCING CHOUX</b> (K Kwo) – Crowded shortly after the start.	
<b>DR PEPPER</b> (K Chowdhoory) – Went off stride coming off the 1600 metres chute approaching the 1400 metres and blundered hampering MIRADELLO. Steadied to avoid the heels of HOMBRE (C Johnson) which shifted inwards passing the 1300 metres when not fully clear. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.	
<b>MIRADELLO</b> (S Wynne) – Hampered approaching the 1400 metres.	
Following the running of this event two riders reported that their mounts had jumped a patch on the track approaching the 1400 metres. Stewards carried out an inspection and found a small bare patch of turf with this then being covered by grass clippings.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>HELENSVALE PROPERTIES 1600m</b>
<b>JIMINY CRICKET</b> (L Callaway) – Very slow to begin.	

<p><b>ALAGANT ANGEL</b> (C Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly then being further hampered when being contacted by ROX.</p> <p><b>ROX</b> (T Moseley) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>LUGANO’S ACE</b> (J Laking) – Held up behind the weaken ARTIC WARRIOR approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>EAVESDROP</b> (K Mudhoo) – Had to be checked away from the heels of the quickly weakening ARTIC WARRIOR approaching the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>SHAKER</b> (C Campbell) – Lay in throughout the run home.</p> <p><b>KEEP QUIET</b> (K Asano) – The tongue tie became detached in the starting gates and could not be reapplied.</p> <p><b>C Campbell</b> (SHAKER) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>Following the running of this race the track was downgraded to Dead 5.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>EDINBURGH REALTY &amp; WALTER PARKER MEMORIAL 2200m</b>
<p><b>SUPERSTITION</b> (R Mudhoo) – Very fractious in the barrier with a barrier manners warning being placed against the mare. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>METASEQUOIA</b> (C Johnson) – Jumped away very awkwardly hampering MADAM DE SOIR and PRODUCER which both lost ground.</p> <p><b>MADAM DE SOIR</b> (B Murray) – Hampered start losing ground.</p> <p><b>PRODUCER</b> (S Wynne) – Hampered start losing ground. Raced ungenerously getting its head up near the 1900 metres. Steadied to avoid heels near the 500 metres. Held up early in the straight.</p> <p><b>SCOOBY</b> (K Chowdhoo) – Briefly steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>B Murray</b> (MADAM DE SOIR) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for striking his mount consecutively prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>R.M.G. BEAUMONT CUP 1600m</b>
<p><b>SHAARA</b> (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>OREPUKI LAD</b> (K Williams) – Lay in approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>SON OF MAHER</b> (K Asano) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had been keen in the early stages but had not let down when placed under pressure in unfavourable track conditions.</p> <p>Following the running of this race the track was downgraded to Slow 7.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600m</b>
<p><b>TAIERI GEM</b> (C Barnes) – Blundered at the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>CITY SLICKER</b> (K Asano) – Crowded shortly after the start. Raced wide from the 700 metres.</p> <p><b>HEIDI HI</b> (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>
