Race 1	MILNES TRANSPORT & HAZLETT SPRAYING (1200m)
DRUMCASTLE (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.	
G'DAY GORGEOUS (BB Hong) – Began awkwardly hampering GELIBOLU.	
GELIBOLU (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and was then further hampered when G'DAY GORGEOUS shifted outwards on jumping. Hampered on two occasions near the 1000 metres. Inconvenienced near the 50 metres.	
POINT SCORE (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1000 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SECRET DREAMS and ducked inwards hampering GELIBOLU on two occasions.	
UP MY SLEEVE (K Kwo) – Knuckled shortly after the start was effected. Rider dropped the right rein near the 250 metres and shifted inwards, making contact with SANDY COOL.	
EGOTISTIC K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	

BUCK SHELLFISH (T Comignaghi) – Lay outwards over the final 50 metres inconveniencing GELIBOLU.

SANDY COOL (L Callaway) – Contacted near the 250 metres. Had to be steadied when improving onto the heels of THE SELECTION passing the 50 metres.

Following the running of this event the official track conditions were downgraded to Slow 7 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2	BAY ROAD SERVICE CENTRE & WRENS (1200m)

MISS MAXIPARK (A Bohorun) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious in its barrier and was cleared to start. Reported by the rider to have hung throughout the running.

DRUMSTORM (C Johnson) – Slow to begin. Went off stride and blundered near the 250 metres.

TAP TAP (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly, losing ground. Struck a heel of KNUTQUACKER shortly after the start and blundered.

SON OF SURF (C Campbell) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

TICKETS ON HER (C Barnes) – Forced wider on the track rounding the final bend near the 350 metres.

KITTY POWER (K Asano) – Forced wider on the track rounding the final bend near the 350 metres.

Race 3	NATHAN CLEAVER BUILDING & NIND DAIRY SERVICES (1400m)

HEINBACK EREBUS (C Campbell) – Not persevered with from the 600 metres after becoming tailed off, with the rider unable to offer any tangible explanation for the performance. Connections were advised the gelding needs to be more competitive in its future racing. Trainer S McKay advised the Stewards that she would be making gear changes in an attempt to improve the racing competitiveness of HEINBACK EREBUS.

LIGHTNING JACK (K Asano) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GERRY JOYCE (R Mudhoo) – Had difficulty obtaining clear racing room in the final straight until near the 100 metres.

FROMAJACK TOAKING (L Callaway) – Rider reported the gelding to have held its breath throughout and further advised he would be recommending gear changes prior to FROMAJACK TOAKING racing next.

Race 4	STEVEN SHEARING CONTRACTING & RIVERTON ELECTRICAL (1400m)

THE MOLE (C Barnes) – Contacted leaving the barriers.

TO SIR WITH LOVE (A Bohorun) – Began awkwardly losing some ground.

GEMSTONE JEWELS (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly, getting its head up and losing ground as a result.

LITTLE FLICK (R Mudhoo) – Restrained to avoid heels approaching the 1000 metres, then raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 900 metres.

FAZIOLI (T Moseley) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

BELOW ZERO (C Campbell) – Badly held up in the final straight until near the 100 metres.

SOUTHERN JAZZ (A Bohorun) – Very slow to begin, losing several lengths.

HEAVEN KNOWS (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Raced wide rounding the final bend.

OUR BOY BAZ (K Kwo) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

COLOUR ME RED (T Moseley) – Held up rounding the final bend and had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

MADAM DE SOIR (J Lowry) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

SHAKTI (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.	
Race 7	TORRESDALE STUD & ADVANCE AGRICULTURE (1200m)
<p>MOSS JAZZ (A Bohorun) – Reefed and bucked shortly after the start dislodging rider A Bohorun and escaping riderless for some distance. A Bohorun was examined by the on course St John Ambulance Paramedics and found to have suffered some minor bruising to a shoulder. Connections were advised MOSS JAZZ must trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.</p> <p>TIMES TIME (K Asano) – Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages, inconveniencing PROMISING passing the 150 metres. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>PROMISING (K Kwo) – Inconvenienced when tiring passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>D Bothamley was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 8	TONY ROY BUILDING & BRENDON SHEARING CONTRACTING (1600m)
<p>LOCK 'N' TAP (C Johnson) – Late scratching at 1.52pm due to the track downgrade.</p> <p>PORT STEPHENS (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Rider reported the gelding had failed to handle today's testing tracks conditions.</p> <p>ROSIE MAE (R Mudhoo) – Improved wide from the 1000 metres. Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.</p> <p>DONTPUTYAFOOTINIT (K Asano) – Lay inwards under pressure inconveniencing ROSIE MAE near the 200 metres.</p>
