Race 1	MCCALLUMS GROUP HANDICAP (1200m)

TICKETS ON HER (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Briefly held up near the 350 metres.

**OPIO ROSE** (A Bohorun) – Raced wide in the early stages.

Race 2 CENTRAL SOUTHLAND FREIGHT MAIDEN (1200m)

I'M A TIGER (B Murray) – Began awkwardly. Shifted outwards near the 150 metres bumping with GOODTHINGSTAKETIME. B Murray was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**LAST TRY** (L Hemi) – Shifted outwards at the start hampering an outside runner. Raced wide in the early stages. Raced greenly near the 250 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of GOODTHINGSTAKETIME. Lay inwards near the 150 metres.

**TAPDOG** (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Lay outwards through the early stages before being restrained to the rear of the field. Rider reported the gelding had hung badly throughout and felt indifferent in its action from the 700 metres and was eased out of the race. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be showing signs of shin soreness.

**RETALIATE** (K Mudhoo) – Hampered at the start.

**RUBY ROYALE** (S Wynne) – Hampered at the start. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the filly had raced greenly throughout in its first race day start however would derive benefit from the run.

**DRUMCASTLE** (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.

**GOODTHINGSTAKETIME** (Z Bholah) – Raced wide from the 700 metres.

**UP MY SLEEVE** (T Moseley) – Bumped by outside runner passing the 200 metres.

**BATTLE CODE** (A Balloo) – Lay inwards near the 200 metres.

Apprentice rider **A Balloo** was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift ground inwards near the 200 metres making firm contact with UP MY SLEEVE.

# Race 3 SOUTH PORT MAIDEN (1600m)

Trainer **G Robinson** was issued with a warning for a late declaration of rider for SANDY COOL.

PICTURE THIS (L Hemi) – Shifted outwards at the start dictating ROSIE MAE wider on the track.

**I REMEMBER YOU** (A Bohorun) – Got back shortly after the start.

**BUCK SHELLFISH** (C Johnson) – Got back shortly after the start. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had failed to let down when placed under pressure from the 700 metres and was disappointing. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

ROSIE MAE (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide in the early stages when progressing forward to the lead near the 1000 metres.

## Race 4 MEDITERRANEAN SHIPPING CO. HANDICAP (1600m)

**FRANCIS DRAKE** (R Mudhoo) – Got back shortly after the start.

**THE BUMPER** (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover through the middle stages. Gave ground from the 250 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle the prevailing Dead 4 track conditions.

OUR BOY BAZ (C Barnes) - Raced wide from the 700 metres.

Apprentice rider K Chowdhoory (ROSIE GLOW) was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

#### Race 5 MCKNIGHT & BROWN MAIDEN (2200m)

**PABLO PICASSO** (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a slow recovery and to be showing signs of dehydration.

**JANDLES** (C Johnson) – Got back shortly after the start.

**PLATINUM TOUCH** (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages before being restrained to take cover passing the 1700 metres. Gave ground from the 700 metres.

**OPAL FIRE** (C Campbell) – Gave ground from the 900 metres.

**PORT STEPHENS** (S Wynne) – Gave ground from the 400 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

**SENOR MOSS** (B Murray) – Had to be steadied away from the heels of the tiring RELIABLY PERKY passing the 400 metres. Placed in restricted room momentarily passing the 150 metres.

**RAISE YA CARDS** (J Lowry) – Lay inwards and bumped with MY CASHIER passing the 150 metres placing SENOR MOSS in restricted room. **J Lowry** was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

**MAGICAL MYSTERY** (C Barnes) – When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner rider was of the opinion the mare had not backed up from its previous run on Saturday.

# Race 6 ILT FOUNDATION HANDICAP (2200m)

**PERFECTO** (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and got back shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.

CHOOKIE'S GIRL (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly and bumped with PERFECTO shortly after the start.

**COLOUR ME RED** (S Wynne) – Raced wide in the early stages.

**LARIPPA** (C Campbell) – Raced wide in the early stages.

**HE AIN'T HEAVY** (A Bohorun) – Raced wide from the 1500 metres.

**COUNTESS RUBY** (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**SCANDALOUS** (T Comignaghi) – Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

**TRANSCENDENT** (T Moseley) – Hampered shortly after the start. Shifted ground inwards over the concluding stages.

Apprentice **Z Bholah** (NEVER QUITZ) with assistance of Mr D Walsh admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip on more occasions than is permitted prior to the 100 metres all the while on a runner out of contention. After viewing the replays and hearing penalty submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$300.

#### Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400m)

**DOONA'S SISTER** (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

LOVE TO DREAM (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly.

G'DAY GORGEOUS (R Mudhoo) – Steadied near the 400 metres. Placed in restricted room near 350 metres.

**PERCEIVE** (C Campbell) – Shifted ground outwards near the 350 metres placing G'DAY GORGEOUS in restricted room. Lay outwards near the 250 metres bumping with MISS ATOMIC BOMB. **C Campbell** was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

MISS ATOMIC BOMB (T Moseley) – Bumped with PERCEIVE rounding the final bend.

# Race 8 SEE YOU AT ILT PUB PUNT DAY MARCH 29 (1400m)

**QASHQAI** (L Hemi) – Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the gelding was unsuited by the prevailing track conditions and would benefit from more distance in future racing.

**COCEE** (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Briefly held up near the 150 metres.

FOX IN SOCKS (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

**NERUDA** (C Barnes) – Raced greenly near the 1100 metres.

**GARMENT** (Z Bholah) – Raced wide throughout.

**FAZIOLI** (B Murray) – Gave ground from the 600 metres.

<b>CITY SLICKER</b> (K Chowdhoory) – Raced wide from the 500 metres. Shifted ground near the 250 metres dictating FOX IN SOCKS wider on the track. Apprentice K Chowdhoory was advised he must straighten his mounts sooner than he did so on this occasion.
