GENERAL:

B Lammas was unable to make the carded weight for CANDY CROSS in Race 1 and GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS in Race 3 and was fined \$200 under the provisions of the Minor Infringement Schedule.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN HURDLE (2400 Metres)
ONEFORTHE DITCH (D Parker) - Landed awkwardly and lost ground after jumping the first fence.	

CANDY CROSS (J Seivwright replaced B Lammas) - Over-raced into the first turn. Hit the fence near the 900 metres.

PRIZED PINS (N Downs) - Over-raced and made the first bend awkwardly.

WHOPPERS (K Macnab) – Jumped the second last fence poorly dislodging rider K Macnab. K Macnab was attended to by paramedics and transferred to hospital for observation.

Race 2	BRIAN FM OPEN HURDLE (2400 Metres)

E Farr (ABACUS) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after she allowed her mount to shift in near the end of the back straight tightening TOMMYRA (H McNeill), which had to be steadied.

BIGREDMOON (B Lammas)- Was retired from the event near the straight entrance when well back.

THE GREAT GURU (T Johnson) – Fell at the second last fence. **KING OBERON** (I Lupton) was unable to avoid the fallen runner and dislodged rider I Lupton. Both riders were uninjured. **THE GREAT GURU** returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. **THE GREAT GURU** is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

Race 3	CHASE A FOX RACING SYNDICATE OPEN HURDLE (3000 Metres)

AIGNE (R Cole replaced K Macnab). Jumped inwards at the last fence simultaneously as **ITS A WONDER** jumped out resulting in **AIGNE** having to change ground outwards to improve.

DONARDO (J Seivwright) - Made a poor jump near the 600 metres when tiring and lost ground.

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (L Douglas replaced B Lammas) – Retired prior to jumping the final two fences when well back and out of contention. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.

STARBRO (S Karnicnik) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Retired prior to jumping the final two fences when well back and out of contention.

Race 4	KEVIN MYERS STABLES OPEN STEEPLECHASE (3000 Metres)

GAME PERCY (J Seivwright replaced K Macnab) –

THE FOT (S Karnicnik) -Fell at the fence near the 1100 metres on the final round. S Karnicnik was uninjured and cleared to ride.

EL CORBY (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres dislodging A Kuru who was uninjured and cleared to ride.

THE BIG OPAL (D Parker) - Landed awkwardly at the fence near the 1000 metres and lost ground.

CHOCOLATE FISH (R Cole) – Had to avoid the fallen **EL CORBY** near the 1000 metres losing ground. Retired near the straight entrance when well back and out of contention.

S O'Malley (NAPOLEAN) - Spoken to regarding the use of his whip (2 in succession) prior to 100 metres.

Race 5	PACIFIC GAUGE CALIBRATION LTD MAIDEN 2&3YO (800 Metres)

LA DONNA (K Asano replaced S McKay).

CHICA BONITA (T Thornton) - Slow away. Held up for a short distance early in the home straight.

ANOTHER SECRET (H Schofer) - Slow from its wide draw.

FLYING ZACK (L Hemi) – Slow to begin. Over-raced early.

CANDY O’CEIRIN (T Taiaroa) – Raced greenly throughout.

Race 6	LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES MAIDEN (800 Metres)

C Burdan (JUDITH) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and reminded of her obligations when shifting ground, after shifting out into the line of WEE DRAM near the 100 metres, forcing that runner to change ground to improve.

WEE DRAM (L Allpress) – Steadied off heels near the 100 metres.

Race 7	MARK BUCKLEY MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1200 Metres)

ODE TO JOY (B Ansell) - Shifted out on jumping away, tightening MIDNIGHT SPARK. Hampered shortly after start.

MIDNIGHT SPARK (S McKay) – Tightened start.

SORRY I’M LATE (D Hirini) - Shifted in and away from LINCOLN TOWN shortly after the start resulting in ODE TO JOY being hampered.

Race 8	TINA EGAN RACING HANDICAP (1200 Metres)

SMOKIN’ OAK (R Oliver) – Slow away.

PODKAST (T Taiaroa) – Jumped away awkwardly and then tightened when there was movement from runners either side.

SPRING TIDE (T Thornton) - Over-raced in the back straight and when being steadied shifted out and bumped with MISS LIZZIE near the 1100 metres.

MISS LIZZIE (B Ansell) – Bumped 1100 metres.

ESTEFANIA (J Bassett) – Lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 9	LISA LATTA RACING STABLES MAIDEN (1360 Metres)

HERMES (K Asano) - Tightened at the start and slow away.

GOVERNOR GREY (S Collett) - When questioned into the disappointing run of GOVERNOR GREY, S Collett advised the filly had been outpaced throughout but would take natural improvement with the run.

CARAMEL POPCORN (R Elliot) – When questioned into the run of CARAMEL POPCORN which disappointed, R Elliot advised the filly was never comfortable in the going. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

Race 10	IG & RJ HACKETT FARRIER AND RACING HANDICAP (1360 Metres)

WILLIAM WALLACE (S Macnab) - Slow to begin. Held up near the 150 metres for a short distance.

MISS MAPLE (C Burdan) – When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the filly had failed to handle today’s track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.

Race 11	PALAMOUNTAINS SCIENTIFIC NUTRITION HANDICAP (1600 Metres)

HYPATIA (T Taiaroa) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

WAIT A SEC (J Parkes) – Slow to begin.

MIRACULOUS (D Hirini) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LA PHYTA (S Macnab) - When questioned into the run of LA PHYTA, which finished some distance back, S Macnab advised that in her opinion the mare would improve with the run.

ROCHELLE LOCKETT RACING STABLES HANDICAP (1600 Metres)

KIT KAT (J Parkes) – Slow away. When questioned into the run of KIT KAT, J Parkes advised the mare was unsuited to the Heavy (11) track conditions.

TABOO (S Macnab) - Made the first bend awkwardly and then commenced to over-race.
