RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WELCOME BACK TO SOUTHERN RACING (760m)
<p>BURT THE SQUIRT (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CHOUX IN (B Murray) – Slow to begin. Severely crowded, having to be heavily restrained passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>THE GIFT (C Johnson) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) – Hampered near the 150 metres when the runner in front was checked, eventually clipping that runner's heel and blundering passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>S Wynne (CHITONA) admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) Careless Riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards passing the 150 metres crowding and checking CHOUX IN. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the JCA suspended Miss Wynne's riding licence from the 20th July up to and including the 25th July. (3 days)</p>	

Race 2	SPENCER FAMILY TRIBUTE TO DAVEY MAC (760m)
<p>The explanation tendered by J Laking when unable to make the contracted weight on SWEET OAK was accepted by the Stewards on this occasion.</p> <p>TAP TAP (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the seemingly improved performance co-trainer K Taplin advised a change of shoeing and training regime had led to the mare’s better showing today.</p> <p>EPIC DREAMER (S Wynne) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>KNEAZLE (R Beeharry) – Lay out rounding the bend by the 300 metres.</p> <p>MISS MAXIPARK (A Bohorun) – Steadied away from the heels of FRIAR TUCK passing the 150 metres. Rider reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action during the running. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the mare to have suffered a superficial wound to the left front leg consistent with having struck itself during the running.</p> <p>FORTUNE PATCH (Y Chew) – Briefly steadied off heels passing the 75 metres.</p> <p>JULIETTE (C Johnson) – Rider reported in his opinion the mare had failed to handle the Heavy 11 track conditions.</p>	
Race 3	SOUTH PORT HANDICAP (1100m)
<p>MERITORIUS (R Mudhoo) – The explanation tendered by trainer A Schwarz for the late declaration of rider was accepted by the Stewards on this occasion. Shifted in at the start crowding inside runner.</p> <p>MARMADUKE (K Selvan) – Crowded at the start with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>ACEKINGSUITED (B Murray) – Shifted out at the start contacting outside runner then began to over-race for a distance and continued race keenly through the middle stages. Placed in restricted room passing the 850 metres having to be restrained. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ARNAGE (S Wynne) – Bounded at the start. Raced awkwardly throughout, getting its head up on a number of occasions. Crowded near the 250 metres when BELOW ZERO lay in.</p> <p>KATE THE GREAT (K Asano) – Began awkwardly and got back. Rider dropped his whip near the 100 metres.</p> <p>C Campbell (BELOW ZERO) was issued a warning for Careless Riding when allowing his mount to shift in passing the 900 metres when not fully clear of ACEKINGSUITED which was crowded and steadied.</p>	
Race 4	CENTRAL SOUTHLAND FREIGHT HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>WESTERN DREAM (K Asano) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after dislodging its rider around at the start area and was cleared to race. K Asano was uninjured in this incident. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FINE BOUQUET (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>WINTER GOLD (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Had to shift across heels passing the 75 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>FOX IN SOCKS (C Johnson) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>I'M A TIGER (R Beeharry) – Raced wide throughout and without cover from the 800 metres.</p> <p>LITTLE FLICK (R Mudhoo) – Lost a front racing plate during the running.</p> <p>R Mudhoo was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 5	LIVAMOL HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>PETITE ROSE (C Johnson) – Blundered on jumping.</p> <p>RENOUNCE (R Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied away from heels when over racing shortly after the start then raced wide without cover thereafter.</p>	

KATRINA MARIE (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
Race 6	McCALLUMS GROUP HANDICAP (1200m)
THE STYLE (G Jogoo) – Got back after the start and was outpaced through the early stages despite the efforts of the rider.	
RELIABLE BELLE (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
FINBARR (S Wynne) – Held up from the 350 metres until early in the run home.	
Race 7	BELLEW & COMPANY @ HARCOURTS HANDICAP (1600m)
MISS CATHERINE (R Beeharry) – Trainer G Tippet was issued a warning under Rule 616(4) when presenting this runner without the notified Blinkers. Slow to begin.	
RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (C Johnson) – Had to be steadied off heels for a distance when over-racing passing the 800 metres.	
INVIGORATE (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
Rider J Lowry (PERFECTO) was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.	
Race 8	PHILLIPS HORSE TRANSPORT THANKS OWNERS & TRAINERS (1600m)
FRANCIS DRAKE (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.	
SHAKTI (R Mudhoo) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.	
CHOICE DU JEU (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover through the early to middle stages.	
PABLEAU (B Murray) – Held up from the 400 metres only gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.	
THE MAN (C Campbell) – Crowded when tiring passing the 250 metres having to be steadied.	
Race 9	LIGHTNING JACK HANDICAP (1400m)
RINGBOLT (C Barnes) – Very slow to begin (6L.) Trainer J Gordon was advised that a warning would be placed on the barrier manners of the gelding.	
ESCAPOLOGIST (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
MIDNITE KAOS (B Murray) – Held up passing the 450 metres and had to be steadied away from heels.	
GOLD'NGURU (S Wynne) – Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.	
ROSIE GLOW (K Asano) – Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.	
TIMES TIME (K Chowdhoo) – Lay out throughout the run home having to be straightened passing the 100 metres.	
Race 10	DAVEY MAC APPRECIATION HANDICAP (1400m)
Due to heavy fog covering the majority of the course Stewards had limited visual coverage of this race.	
MANGAROA SKY (G Jogoo) – Under pressure passing the 600 metres and gave ground from this point eventually finishing in a distant last placing. Rider reported that the mare had held its breath during the running. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.
