## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 2060m</b>
<b>IRISH FLARE (T Thornton)</b> - Raced wide throughout in search of better footing.	

**ALBARON (S Macnab)** - Was inclined to lug outwards throughout the home straight.

**EL PABLO (M Hudson)** - Began awkwardly

**MANAWAPOU (T Taiaroa)** - Shifted out on jumping away into the line of **TITLETATTLE (L Allpress)** which was tightened and got back.

**FATHER DOM (S McKay)** - Slow away

**D BRADLEY (Te Kahu)** - Was spoken to regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

**Race 2** | **PALAMOUNTAINS SCIENTIFIC NUTRITION HANDICAP 800m**

**POWER AND MONEY (A Mudhoo)** - Began awkwardly

**SKY HI RAHTWO (T Thornton)** - Held up early in the home straight and had to change ground passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

**H SCHOFFER (COLLYS' FOLLY)** - Reported the mare was never comfortable in the track conditions.

**Race 3** | **CARPET MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING MAIDEN 1200m**

**ALL IN BLOOM (M Hudson)** - Charged the front of its gate prior to the start and after a veterinary inspection was cleared to run.

**IRISH PRAYER (D Hirini)** – Was slow away (5L). Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the mare with regards to its barrier manners.

**AFTER YOU (T Taiaroa)** - Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

**Race 4** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1200m**

**CRIMSON STAR (S McKay)** – Slow away

**IRISH HEART (L Hemi)** - Was held up for several strides early in the home straight on the heels of **WHITE LIGHTNING**.

**WHITE LIGHTNING (L Allpress)** – Failed to run on to any extent over the final stages. When questioned, Rider L Allpress advised that after being taken on in the early and middle stages when in a forward position, the filly failed to run on but would take natural improvement with the run.

**Race 5** | **G BRISTOL & SONS HWT HANDICAP 1600m**

**WILLIAM WALLACE (S O'Malley)** - Stood in its gate as the start was made and as a result was very slow away. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the gelding with regards to its barrier manners.

**HAMILTONIAN (K Macnab)** – Slow away

**S O'MALLEY (WILLIAM WALLACE)** - Admitted a breach of Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) with regard to his whip use prior the 100 metres. S O'Malley was fined the sum of \$300.

**Race 6** | **MANAWATU SOUND SERVICE MAIDEN 1600m**

**GREAT NORTH ROAD (J Parkes)** - Had to be steadied off the heels of **BREATH OF FIRE** going into the first turn.

**EIGHT MILE (B Ansell)** and **CANUCIA (R Myers)** - Came together and bumped for several strides near the end of the back straight.

<p><b>SENASSY (J Seivwright)</b> – Slow away</p> <p><b>MANDALAY (T Johnson)</b> – Slow away</p> <p><b>N DOWNS (Infocicated)</b> - Was spoken to with regard to his whip use on a runner out of contention.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES HWT HANDICAP 2060m</b>
<p><b>BAD BOY BROWN (E Nicholas)</b> - Slow away</p> <p><b>ONEFORTHEDITCH (T Johnson)</b> – Slow away</p> <p><b>AVE MARIA (K Macnab)</b> - Was tightened in the home straight on the first occasion when <b>S O'Malley (KIRKLAND)</b> allowed his mount to shift in when not fully clear. S O'Malley was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).</p> <p><b>IT'S A WONDER (J Seivwright)</b> - Over-raced in the early stages. Bumped early in the home straight.</p> <p><b>ZENTANGLE (D Parker)</b> - Lay inwards and bumped <b>IT'S A WONDER</b> early in the home straight.</p> <p><b>ZAC BROWN (R Cole)</b> – The rider reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. ZAC BROWN underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>M ROUSTOBY (BAK DA MASTER)</b> – Was given a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) after he allowed his mount to shift ground outwards near the 250 metres when not fully clear of <b>HURRY CANE</b> which had to change ground inside to improve.</p> <p><b>S O'Malley (KIRKLAND)</b> - Was given a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) regarding the manner in which he used his whip (above shoulder height) near the finish.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>RIVER CITY CABS HANDICAP 1200m</b>
<p><b>DESERT MAGIC (D Hirini)</b> - Steadied near the home turn off the heels of <b>MISS LIZZIE</b> then angled inwards to improve. A short distance further was tightened momentarily when <b>CHOSEN PEAK (T Taiaroa)</b> was angled inwards in search of clear running. T Taiaroa was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Master and advised to exercise more care when shifting ground. Stewards took into account outwards movement from <b>TIMES TICKING</b> when assessing the interference.</p> <p><b>SHOWMEWARE (R Myers)</b> - Was held up and unable to improve throughout the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested.</p> <p><b>SEA STAR (L Allpress)</b> – Had difficulty obtaining clear running over the final stages and went to the line without being fully tested. L Allpress was dislodged on pulling her mount up but was uninjured.</p> <p><b>MISS LIZZIE (B Ansell)</b> - Lost a right-front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>SPOONER, HOOD &amp; REDPATH LTD 1360m</b>
<p><b>MISS GIDGET (M Sanson)</b> – Slow away. Dropped out and finished some distance last. When questioned, M Sanson advised the mare was not comfortable in the going.</p> <p><b>MY ZED (L Allpress)</b> – Slow away. Was held up for some distance approaching the 100 metres and had to change ground to improve when <b>MANHATTAN AFFAIR (D Hirini)</b> rolled inwards into its line. D Hirini was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.</p> <p><b>BELLA NERO (D Bradley)</b> – Received an interrupted run in the home straight.</p>	
<b>Race 11</b>	<b>WANGANUI GREYHOUND RACING CLUB RACING TONIGHT 1360m</b>

Stewards gave permission for Apprentice T Taiaroa to replace R Elliot on **OVERTHETOP** due to there being no suitable replacement rider.

Stewards gave permission for **VENT** to race minus the near hind shoe after the farrier advised stewards the filly was unable to be re plated.

**YOUNG SQUIRE (S McKay)** – Slow away

**SHANPARK (D Hirini)** – Slow away

**OVERTHETOP (T Taiaroa)** - When questioned into the improved performance of the winner OVERTHETOP, trainer W Thurlow advised the gelding had performed well at a recent jumpout and the improved run was not entirely unexpected.

**LA LANDONNE (D Bradley)** - Gave ground rounding the home turn and finished well back. D Bradley had no excuse.

**WHATA RED PRINCE (J Parkes)** rider reported mount never comfortable in Heavy 11
