## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TAGGART EARTHMOVING MAIDEN (1400m)
<b>AQUATTACK</b> (K Chowdhoory) - Jumped away awkwardly then further hampered when crowded.	
<b>REPULSE</b> (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly, checked when crowded shortly after the start, had to be firmly restrained when improving onto heels near the 900 metres.	
<b>BB Hong</b> (WENDY DARLING) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear of REPULSE which was forced onto MORE THAN ENOUGH, with BROTHER WILL then being forced outwards as a consequence clipping a heel of REPULSE and blundering near the 1150 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended BB Hong's licence to ride at race meetings for 4 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 1 August up to and including Wednesday 12 August.	

**MORE THAN ENOUGH** (C Campbell) - Checked when crowded shortly after the start, inclined to lay in throughout the home straight.

**BROTHER WILL** (S Toolooa) - Clipped a heel and blundered near the 1150 metres.

**YOUNEVERKNOW** (K Williams) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**WENDY DARLING** (BB Hong) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**JOLLY ZAM** (T Moseley) - Raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

**MATUKI** (R Cuneen) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages. When questioned regarding performance rider reported that in his opinion the filly is now looking for more ground.

**R Myers** (ST NANCY) - When questioned regarding performance rider reported that the filly would derive benefit from its first start effort.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400m)</b>

**SABOTEUR** (J Laking) - Slow to begin.

**SUNNY LADY** (S Toolooa) - Over raced in the early to middle stages, raced wide without cover from the 900 metres.

**L Callaway** (ANDALE ANDALE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start dictating IT'S GUCCI inwards into the line of RINGADINGDING which had to be steadied passing the 1300 metres.

**RINGADINGDING** (R Mudhoo) - Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1300 metres.

**IT'S GUCCI** (C Campbell) - Hung inwards throughout the final straight.

**S MacNab** (JUST A GIRL) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had failed to see out the 1400 metre distance of today's race in the testing track conditions.

**CASE STUDY** (R Cuneen) - Slow to begin.

**CHILLY FILLY** (K Kwo) - Rider reported that the filly had hung outwards throughout and raced greenly.

**MARRONELLE** (S Macnab) - Slow to begin.

**JENNEKE** (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin, hampered near the 550 metres. Rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

**IRISH HI** (K Chowdhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start.

**SOVIET WONDER** (R Mudhoo) - Steadied and shifted inwards to avoid the heels of LITTLE JOHN near the 550 metres dictating IRISH HI inwards hampering JENNEKE.

**IRISH EXCUSE** (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground (4L).

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>OPTIMISE FERTILISERS &amp; EQUI-LISE RATING 65 (1800m)</b>
<p><b>LAST LETTER</b> (A Balloo) - Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>REDESDALE</b> (K Kwo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>TAI HO</b> (T Moseley) - Bumped near the 1500 metres when LAST LETTER lay out.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>GREENWOOD AMBERLEY CUP (1400m)</b>
<p><b>QUEEN JETSUN</b> (K Williams) - Raced wide without cover throughout, steadied to avoid the heels of DYNAMIC (W Papier) which shifted out near the 350 metres when not fully clear. W Papier was advised to exercise greater care. Following the race Stipendiary Stewards became aware that the mare had not raced in the notified of blinkers which had not been detected in pre-race checks. Co-trainer L Prendergast who had not been present on course was spoken to regarding this omission.</p> <p><b>TUILANA</b> (T Comignaghi) - Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>R Myers</b> (FLORAL ART) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL RATING 65 (1400m)</b>
<p><b>FAUX PAS</b> (R Myers) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PUSHYALUCK</b> (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>ATHENE</b> (T Moseley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>YANNICK</b> (C Johnson) - Raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres.</p> <p><b>WANDERIN OVER</b> (K Kwo) - When questioned regarding performance and in particular as to why he had got so far back in the running, rider advised that after a fair beginning the mare had been flat early and had failed to muster any early speed despite his urgings on a fast early pace, adding that when leading in its previous start it had been in a slowly run race. K Kwo further added that the mare had only battled past beaten runners in the straight and may have found today's track conditions too holding.</p>
