INCA WARRIOR (S Spratt) – Rider dropped her whip near the 100 metres.

C Dell (AMUN RA) – Issued with a warning for using his whip on a horse that was out of contention.

Race 5 DUNSTAN 100% NZ MADE 1100

WESTERN CHOICE (S Spratt) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

MY SUPERIOR GIRL (A Calder) - Restrained from a wide barrier. Shifted inwards passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

LOOKS LIKE (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hung when placed under pressure early in the final straight, then was not persevered with over the final 150 metres.

R Oliver (FERINDI) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mount out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 6 DUNSTAN 100% NZ OWNED 2100

PAVLICHENKO (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

PLUSHENKO (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin. Apprentice Rider M Hashizume reported that the saddle had moved forward early in the race placing him at a disadvantage.

OLD COUNTESS (T Newman) – Slow to begin.

VILLA NINE (J Fawcett) – Restrained to obtain cover passing the 2000 metres.

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (E Nicholas) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

T Thornton (ARITE GURU) – Reminded of her obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 7 DUNSTAN EQUINE-SAFE 1300

N Kelly (CAPTAIN REG) – Issued with a warning after CAPTAIN REG was presented without notified gear (blinkers).

RENEGADE FIGHTER (C Dell) – Threw its head down as the start was effected beginning awkwardly and hampered ABU DHABI.

ABU DHABI (C Ormsby) – Hampered start losing ground.

ELLE D'BERRY (M Cameron) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 1200 metres.

JAKAMA KRYSTAL (C Burdan) – Steadied when in restricted room shortly after the 1200 metres. Crowded approaching the 400 metres when TAHUROA HEIGHT (N Alam) shifted in under pressure. As a result CAPTAIN REG and ALL THE RAGE were hampered. N Alam was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

RED RUSHIN (T Newman) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

CAPTAIN REG (S Weatherley) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages shifting out and making contact with TAHUROA HEIGHT which then became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance and was hampered near the 900 metres. Hampered 400 metres.

TAHUROA HEIGHT (N Alam) – Hampered 900 metres.

ALFA ROSSO (A Calder) – Raced ungenerously when leading in the early to middle stages.

ALL THE RAGE (B Rogerson) – Hampered 400 metres.

DIOGENES (C Jones) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

M Hashizume (ALTAR GIRL) – Reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 8 DUNSTAN DECADES OF DELIVERY 1300

INNAMINCKA (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

HEAR MY VOICE (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

OUR CRAFTSMAN (A Calder) – Slow to begin and then crowded.

LORD VALENTINE (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TUNZAGUTZ (T Newman) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final turn for a distance until shifting in approaching the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (M Hashizume) – Raced keenly when wide without cover throughout, and then lay in under pressure in the final straight.

D Johnson (ZENNTARI) – Issued with a warning for using the whip excessively.

J Fawcett (SPEECHMAKER) – Reminded of her obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 9 DUNSTAN SUSTAINABLE GRAIN KEGS 1300

RODOLFO (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground.

SPIDER (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced passing the 300 metres when TIPICAL (M Hashizume) shifted out under pressure. Crowded and steadied when weakening near the 175 metres to the outside of TIPICAL which shifted out under pressure. Contributing was slight inward movement from ANSWER BACK. Apprentice Rider M Hashizume was reprimanded and advised to exercise greater care.

MAJOR TOM (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

CHERRY LANE (A Calder) – Raced in restricted room in the early stages.

KAHARAU (C Burdan) – Raced in restricted room in the early stages and again near the 700 metres.

MONT VENTOUX (C Dell) – Shifted out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 10 DUNSTAN DRIVING PERFECTION 1600

DELEGATE (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

TWIN SPINNER (M Hashizume) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight with the Rider dropping his left rein approaching the 100 metres.

Race 11 DUNSTAN DRIVING PERFORMANCE 1600

SUMMER WARRIOR (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

GO GO GONZO (S Macnab) - Slow to begin.

GABRIEL (A Calder) – Began awkwardly and then was ridden urgently to recover.

M Kareem (SUMMER WARRIOR) – Apprentice Rider M Kareem was spoken to advisedly in the presence of Riding Master N Harris regarding the manner in which he used his whip.

MISS FENDT (B Rogerson) – When questioned regarding the performance of MISS FENDT Apprentice Rider B Rogerson explained that the filly commenced to hang when placed under pressure and then had tired appreciably.
