GENERAL:

Stewards were advised that Apprentice Rider O Helagi was unwell and would not be attending today's meeting. O Helagi is to provide a medical certificate to Stewards prior to riding next.

L Innes advised on Friday 10 July that he was not attending the meeting and his only riding engagement had been due to a misunderstanding.

An inquiry was opened and adjourned into the non-attendance of Rider T Moki.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Barfoot & Thompson 880
J Waddell - Advised that he was unable to make the contacted weight for MR FOX and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.	
INCY WINCY SPIDER (C Dell) – Slow away.	
EASY PEASY (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.	
CHEERS (M Cameron) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.	
KOHI KID (E Nicholas) – Reared as the gates opened losing ground. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and after a veterinary examination was confirmed to have bled. KOHI KID is now subject to a 2 month stand down from training and a 3 month stand down from trialling or racing with an appropriate veterinary clearance also required prior to racing next.	
DIVINE DIVE (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly but quickly recovered. Contacted for a distance passing the 600 metres by CRIMSON STAR (N Alam) which was attempting to shift out. N Alam was reprimanded by Stewards and will receive further tuition from Riding Master N Harris.	
STARLIGHT EXPRESS (C Burdan) – Raced wide without cover.	
SUSSEX (S Weatherley) – Lay out for the majority of the race when racing wide without cover making the bend awkwardly and then lay out under pressure over the concluding stages and could not be ridden to full advantage.	
BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse other than the filly may not have been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.	
CRIMSON STAR (N Alam) – Lost the near front plate during the running.	

Race 2	Stella Artois 880
<p>SOMETHIN ABOUT IT (M Kareem) – Slow away.</p> <p>EXTERSEA (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded losing ground.</p> <p>CUTTING EDGE (S McKay) – Began awkwardly and then was steadied soon after the start when in restricted room. When questioned regarding the performance Rider S McKay advised that the gelding would prefer better footing.</p> <p>FINAL EXPRESS (A Calder) – Restrained passing the 700 metres to obtain cover and raced ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p>RUBYSHOWOFF (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lay in under pressure in the final straight placing HESAGOODBOY in restricted room near the 300 metres with HESAGOODBOY then having to briefly steady approaching the 100 metres when RUBYSHOWOFF continued to lay in. Rider T Thornton was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p>	
Race 3	Skycity Auckland 880
<p>ELLIOT POWER (L Satherley) - Shifted out abruptly when leaving the barriers crowding KEEP IT REAL, SHOW BIRD, DELUXE EDITION and forcing APPELLANT wider on the track. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and after being examined by the Veterinarian was confirmed to have bled and is now subject to a 2 month stand down from training and a 3 month stand down from trialling or racing with an appropriate veterinary clearance also required prior to racing next.</p> <p>KEEP IT REAL (A Goindasamy) – Crowded when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>SHOW BIRD (C Burdan) – Crowded when leaving the barriers with the rider becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>DELUXE EDITION (T Newman) – Crowded when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>MY WORLD (S Collett) – Crowded when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>APPELLANT (D Johnson) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Rider D Johnson reported that after being crowded when leaving the barriers the filly had got back further than intended.</p> <p>BOLT FROM THE BLUE (A Calder) – Lost the right front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	Dunstan Feeds 1200
<p>J Pranglely – Issued with a warning after RISING RISK was presented to race without notified gear (side winkers).</p> <p>RAIL QUEEN (A Calder) – Reared as the gates opened losing ground.</p> <p>STAR RISE (J Fawcett) – Buffeted shortly after the start.</p> <p>UNCLE TERRY (T Newman) – Contacted shortly after the start.</p> <p>AMA LA VITA (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>RISING RISK (C Jones) – Buffeted shortly after the start. Commenced to lay in soon after leaving the barriers placing Apprentice Rider C Jones in difficulty with RISING RISK then shifting in despite the efforts of its rider and crowding EL NYMPH on to TUMBRIL which were both hampered losing ground. RISING RISK continued to over-race for a distance.</p>	

TUMBRIL (C Grylls) – Crowded and hampered losing ground approaching the 1000 metres.

EL NYMPH (T Yanagida) – Shifted out shortly after the start contacting **UNCLE TERRY**. Crowded and hampered losing considerable ground approaching the 1000 metres. Hampered approaching the 800 metres when improving onto heels and shifted back on to **SIMPLY SILVER** which was also hampered.

SIMPLY SILVER (A Goindasamy) – Hampered 800 metres.

LEICALOT (S McKay) – Eased down from near the 400 metres. Underwent a veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer M Brosnan was advised that **LEICALOT** would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

Race 5 | **Eagle Technology 1200**

THE BUFFER (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

SWISS REGAL (L Satherley) – Slow away.

O’CONNOR (C Ormsby) – Over-raced in the early stages.

BLEW BY YOU (C Grylls) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight having to be corrected by its rider on several occasions.

S Weatherley – (**THE BUFFER**) – Admitted a breach in that he used the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 18 July up to and including racing on 29 July, 5 national riding days.

Race 6 | **Barfoot & Thompson 1600**

YES BOY – Trainer M Farmer advised Stewards at 12.28 pm that Rider T Moki would not be attending the meeting. **YES BOY** was declared a late scratching following Race 4 as there were no Class D Riders available.

MISHKA (H McNeill) – Slow away. Steadied near the 1300 metres when briefly crowded.

GABRIEL (I Fraser-Hayes) – Slow away.

ZEDCREST (S O’Malley) – Slow away.

ZENNTARI (D Parker) – Made brief contact with **MAJOR TOM** near the 100 metres.

MAJOR TOM (E Farr) – Made brief contact near the 100 metres.

TIPICAL (A Kuru) – Shifted out under pressure over the final 150 metres.

E Farr (**MAJOR TOM**) – Issued with a warning regarding her use of the whip.

D Parker (**ZENNTARI**) – Issued with a warning regarding his use of the whip.

N Downs (**SEEMAX**) – Issued with a warning regarding his use of the whip.

H McNeill (**FLORENCE IVY**) – Issued with a warning regarding his use of the whip.

Race 7	Barfoot & Thompson Residential 2200
<p>KEPELLA HEIGHTS – Declared a late scratching following Race 4 due to no Class D riders being available after rider T Moki did not attend the meeting.</p> <p>MAGNANIMOUS MAN (E Nicholas) – Removed from the barriers after making contact with the front gate and cleared fit to race by the On Course Veterinarian. Crowded for a distance approaching the 1850 metres to the inside of TRISHA LEA (C Studd) which shifted in. C Studd was reprimanded and advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>BLANCO BAY (E Farr) – Slow away.</p> <p>MAESTRO BLU (S Fannin) – Slow away.</p> <p>RAAJ (N Downs) – Restrained from its wide barrier.</p> <p>NGATIRA GOLD (J Seivwright) – Slow away.</p> <p>E Farr (Blanco Bay) - Admitted a breach in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.</p> <p>I Fraser-Hayes (CASHEL) – Was questioned regarding his riding tactics and in particular why he had restrained the gelding from near the 1800 metres becoming detached from the field. I Fraser-Hayes explained that he had erred in his judgement of not maintaining contact with the body of the field and has now been referred to the Riding Skills Panel under Rule 343(1)(a).</p>	
Race 8	Barfoot & Thompson Property Management 1400
<p>SIR ZACK (C Jones) – Slow away.</p> <p>HAERE UP (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>FOURCHOUX (T Thornton) – Slow away.</p> <p>COTTON EYE JOE (L Satherley) – Crowded and checked passing the 1100 metres losing ground.</p> <p>MISS FENDT (B Rogerson) – Crowded and checked 1100 metres.</p> <p>M Kareem – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted HUSK to shift in passing the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of MISS FENDT which was checked and shifted in crowding COTTON EYE JOE which was also checked losing ground. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on up to and including racing on, 2 national riding days.</p> <p>WIND CHIMES (C Lammas) – Crowded and hampered 400 metres.</p> <p>M Kareem – Issued with a warning after permitting HUSK to shift out near the 400 metres crowding WIND CHIMES which was hampered.</p>	
Race 9	Barfoot & Thompson Rural 1400
<p>ELLE EYE ARE (J Riddell) – Slow away.</p> <p>HEAR MY VOICE (S Spratt) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages.</p>	

MONT VENTOUX (C Dell) – Hung out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 10 | **Barfoot & Thompson Body Corporate 1200**

ROYAL PRINCE (A Calder) – Began awkwardly losing ground (3L).

RED FOREST (J Fawcett) – Over-raced in the early stages. Crowded 400 metres and steadied when in restricted room to the outside of RITANI which shifted out.

D Johnson – Issued with a warning after permitting RITANI to shift out near the 400 metres when insufficiently clear of RED FOREST which was placed in restricted room and steadied.

LIVIN' ON A PRAYER (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly. Briefly crowded near the 100 metres to the inside of SYMBIO (S Spratt) which shifted in to obtain clear running. S Spratt was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care.

BACK IN A FLASH (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Attempted a marginal run approaching the 100 metres to the outside of LUPELANI with BACK IN A FLASH making contact with the running rail and becoming unbalanced. BACK IN A FLASH then shifted in across the heels of LUPELANI crowding TIME TO FLY.

TIME TO FLY (S McKay) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Crowded over the concluding stages and steadied.

A Goindasamy – Issued with a warning after permitting BACK IN A FLASH to shift in near the 40 metres crowding TIME TO FLY which had to steady.

Following the race the connections of the 3rd placed horse **BACK IN A FLASH** lodged a protest against the 1st placed horse **LUPELANI** alleging interference in the final straight. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

Race 11 | **Barfoot & Thompson Commercial 1200**

RUBY NEGRONI (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly.

LUDUS (D Johnson) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

CAITHNESS KID (J Riddell) – Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres.
