Race 1	GRAHAM LEMON, MURRAY DARROCH, OPTIMISM HURDLE (3100 Metres)

TIPICAL (M Roustoby) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

CURIOUS GEORGE (L Douglas) – Began awkwardly. Misjudged the second to last fence.

LOTHBROK (S Karnicnik) – Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of THE COSSACK which shifted in on landing after jumping the first fence.

MAESTRO BLU (S Fannin) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages and misjudged the second fence landing awkwardly. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences when well beaten.

SUMMER WARRIOR (B Lammas) – Commenced to lose ground leaving the straight on the first occasion and was pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 1400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have fibrillated with the connections being advised a veterinary clearance will be required prior to the gelding racing again.

CALL ME ROYAL (H McNeill) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences when well beaten.

PESHAWAR (N Downs) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences when well beaten.

HUNTER VILLAIN (D Parker) – Misjudged the third to last fence landing awkwardly dislodging its rider who was uninjured.

BLANCO BAY (E Farr) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (R Cole) – Hit the final two fences landing awkwardly.

THE COSSACK (A Kuru) – Misjudged the final fence landing awkwardly.

RENEGADE FIGHTER (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly.

GINGEE (C Jones) – Began awkwardly shifting out.

DAAD (T Newman) – Steadied passing the 1700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

MAGIC CANNON (T Newman) – Lost its off hind plate during the running.

JUST AL (S McKay) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

JAKAMA JILL (C Jones) – Raced keenly in the early stages, having to be firmly restrained off heels near the 1000 metres.	
CHEERS (M Cameron) – Raced wide throughout.

FOXSQLLION (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.	
CHUR CHING (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly and then crowded.	
WHY WONDER (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly and rider was unbalanced.	
EASY PEASY (M Cameron) – When questioned into the performance of the favourite rider advised that the mare had began well but felt flat throughout, and also advised that it had pulled up well. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.	
J Pender (WHY WONDER) – Fined \$50 for presenting WHY WONDER without notified gear (blinkers).

CIVIL UNREST (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.	
SHEZA JAKKAL (S McKay) – Slow to begin. Held up for clear running early in the final straight. Shifted in abruptly across heels passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running inconveniencing TRUE BLESSING.	
ANGELINA LAURO (C Jones) – Slow to begin.	
TEREINE (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained. Held up for clear running early in the final straight. Briefly steadied off heels 300 metres.	
JOHNNY CANUCK (A Calder) – Had to steady and shift out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MIRACLE'S HAPPEN which shifted out under pressure passing the 300 metres.	
TRUE BLESSING (B May) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.

DRUMGOLD (H McNeill) – Slow to begin.	
LITTLE MACS (S Fannin) – Slow to begin. Put in a poor jump at the fourth fence.	
THE ANARCHIST (A Kuru) – Ran down the first fence hampering MEDINI. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1600 metres landing awkwardly.	
MEDINI (L Douglas) – Hampered after jumping the first fence.	
DESERT STORM (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the fourth fence.	
GO GO GONZO (S Karnicnik) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the seventh fence.	
CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (R Cole) – Lost its footing prior to jumping the third to last fence.	
VILLA NINE (B Lammas) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

<p>DUDEWITHATTITUDE (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>INSIDE STORY (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>FALKIRK LASS (C Burdan) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>SO MUCH MOUR (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>BALIOS (D Johnson) – Shifted out across heels inconveniencing SPEECHMAKER near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SPEECHMAKER (S Collett) – Inconvenienced near 1000 metres.</p> <p>MAKABAR (R Beemud) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>R Beemud (MAKABAR) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he directed MAKABAR in on to DRAIOCHTA which was forced in on to CALL ME BOB with CALL ME BOB making firm contact with BALIOS being forced into the line of SPEECHMAKER which was crowded and checked losing ground near the 1300 metres. After hearing all relevant evidence the Judicial Committee suspended R Beemud’s license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 8 August up to and including racing on 26 August, 7 National riding days.</p> <p>R Beemud (MAKABAR) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined the sum of \$300 by the Judicial Committee.</p>
