RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE HANDICAP 2200m
<p>Trainer T Rae – Admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) in that she presented HATRICK BOYS with the incorrect saddle cloth number with the JCA imposing a fine of \$50.</p> <p>HATRICK BOYS (S Wynne) – Knuckled leaving the barrier losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend then steadied away from heels passing the 500 metres continuing to be held up until early in the run home.</p> <p>NATHAN DETROIT (K Asano) – Restrained to the rear of the field shortly after the start to obtain cover with the rider reporting that his mount had hung inwards throughout.</p> <p>FIVE PRINCES (G Jogoo) – Raced wide through the early stages before being taken forward to sit outside the leaders passing the 1400 metres.</p>	

SLAMMER (C Campbell) – Held up briefly rounding the final bend.

SATIN GURU (K Chowdhoo) – Held up briefly in the home straight.

DANTE FIRE (K Mudhoo) – Held up for a distance passing the 200 metres having to be steadied and shift ground outwards to find clear racing inside the final 125 metres.

Race 2	BUSY BEE CLEANING SERVICES HANDICAP 1200m
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FINAL SAVINGS (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Lay in throughout the home straight.

SO NATURAL (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Briefly held up when passing the 100 metres.

MANHATTAN FLAME (K Williams) – Got back from a wide draw to obtain cover. When asked to comment on today's performance the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding was now looking for better tracks and further distance.

Race 3	MELBOURNE CUP DAY – TICKETS ON SALE NOW MDN 1200m
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Trainer C Anderton (CLUB SPIRIT) – Issued with a warning after presenting CLUB SPIRIT with incorrect gear namely pre-race ear covers.

Trainer R Dennis (CHOUX IN) – Admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) in that he omitted the surcingle for CHOUX IN with the JCA imposing a fine of \$100.

MONFERRINA (C Barnes) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after making firm contact with the starting gates and was cleared to start. Hampered shortly after the start.

FLOAT (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly hampering MONFERRINA and then raced ungenerously through the early to middle stages.

NO QUANTUM (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly hampering SECRET DREAMS.

SECRET DREAMS (S Wynne) – Hampered at the start losing ground when outside runner shifted in.

CHOUX IN (G Jogoo) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

SOVIET WONDER (K Chowdhoo) – Blundered shortly after the start.

THE LAST WORD (C Johnson) – Raced four wide without cover throughout. Lay in over the concluding stages.

BELLA EVE (L Callaway) – Briefly placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres when runners either side shifted ground marginally.

QIJI SPIRIT (R Cuneen) – Galloped on during the running and lost a plate.

Race 4	BUSY BEE CLEANING SERVICES HANDICAP 1200m
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FULLTOTHEBRIM (J Laking) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after rearing in the Birdcage and was cleared to start.

PURE CLASS (A Balloo) – Slow to begin. Also held up over the concluding stages.

GLORIOUS OCEAN (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOAH (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the run home and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running and went to the line not tested by its rider.

STELLA DAZE (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing some ground. Had to be restrained away from heels passing the 650 metres. Held up passing the 100 metres.

MIDDAGURD (R Cuneen) – Got its head up on a number of occasions in the early stages when being restrained to take

cover.

KITTY POWER (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Held up passing the 150 metres until inside the final 100 metres.

EASY HABIT (T Moseley) – Rider reported that the saddle slipped forward during the running placing him at a disadvantage and was not persevered with over the concluding stages.

NEVER QUITZ (C Barnes) – Had to be restrained when improving onto heels at the 100 metres.

Race 5	SOUTHERN WIDE REALTY MDN 1600m
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The start was delayed when GLACIER POINT and ROX both proved difficult to load.

GLACIER POINT (J Laking) – Proved very difficult to load at the start with the connections advised that the gelding was being placed on a barrier manners warning. The trainer advised he was reviewing the gelding's racing future.

ROX (K Asano) – Proved difficult to load at the start with the connections advised that the mare was being placed on a barrier manners warning. Began awkwardly getting back as a result.

AQUATTACK (K Chowdhoo) – Slow to begin. Bumped near the 200 metres and shifted ground passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room inconveniencing the tiring MOLLY MAGUIRE with the rider K Chowdhoo being advised he must take greater care when shifting ground.

RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (C Johnson) – Very slow to begin. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle part of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

MOLLY MAGUIRE (S Wynne) – Over raced in the early stages. Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres making contact with AQUATTACK.

MANGAROA SKY (G Jogoo) – Gave ground from the 600 metres quickly tailing off from the field and was not persevered with from this point. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities with the trainer advising that the mare would now be retired as a racing proposition from his stable.

NOT USUAL WINGS (T Comignaghi) – Lay inwards in the home straight. When spoken to regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly in its first start in the South Island and in her opinion, would derive benefit from today's outing.

Race 6	BUSY BEE CLEANING SERVICES MDN 1600m
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GOODANYA (J Laking) – Was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.36 pm after going under the outside rail and landing in the outside ditch.

STEP SON (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

INVIGORATE (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

HILLBILLYCHARLIE (C Barnes) – Commenced to over race shortly after the start continuing to do so through to the middle stages.

SHELBY DEVINE (R Beeharry) – Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of HILLBILLYCHARLIE on at least two occasions passing the 1000 metres.

GOA HEAD CALLER (R Mudhoo) – Had to be restrained away from the heels of SHELBY DEVINE who shifted in when only marginally clear. R Beeharry was advised to exercise greater care.

TURN YOUR EYES (T Comignaghi) – Held up rounding the final turn having to angle outwards to obtain clear running, had to be steadied away from the heels of YING RESOLUTE when laying in near the 100 metres.

ASATHOUGHT (C Johnson) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

Race 7	OAMARU JC WINTER CUP BONUS JULY 2021 MAIDEN 1400m
<p>WHERO (J Laking) – Reared at the start losing ground.</p> <p>HIGH REZ (L Callaway) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly crowding TANZANITE, DREAM BRAVE, SHAKER and GERRY JOYCE.</p> <p>TANZANITE (G Jogoo) – Crowded at the start.</p> <p>DREAM BRAVE (C Johnson) – Crowded at the start. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight. Stewards questioned rider C Johnson in regards to his ride. Of particular concern was early in the straight when there appeared to be a gap in front of him Mr Johnson showed no vigour. Mr Johnson explained that his horse was not travelling good enough to take the marginal run and when that run closed he had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the rest of the run home. Stewards noted Mr Johnson’s explanation.</p> <p>SHAKER (C Campbell) – Crowded at the start.</p> <p>GERRY JOYCE (K Mudhoo) – Crowded at the start.</p> <p>LUGANO’S ACE (R Cuneen) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>WINTER GOLD (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>I’M A TIGER (K Asano) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BLACKJAKK (K Williams) – Raced four wide without cover.</p> <p>HEY MICKEY (T Comignaghi) – Made the bend by the 800 metres awkwardly getting its head up on a number of occasions when being steadied away from heels.</p> <p>JACK KNOWS BEST (T Moseley) – Rider was reminded of his obligations to ride his mount out to the finish.</p>	
Race 8	BUSY BEE CLEANING SERVICES HANDICAP 1400m
<p>THE STYLE (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin before being further hampered by SPLENDIOR which jumped outwards.</p> <p>OUTRAM (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BLUEY’S CHANCE (Y Chew) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DREAMING EASY (R Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1100 metres when racing keenly going off stride briefly. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised he got back from a wide draw, had to improve very wide rounding the final bend and only battled over the concluding stages.</p> <p>RELIABLE BELLE (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover from the 750 metres.</p> <p>DOUGH BOY (T Moseley) – Held up for clear running early in the run home having to shift ground outwards near the 250 metres, then held up for a short distance before improving into a run between BRONTE BEACH and FIELD OF FIRE near the 100 metres.</p> <p>RUBY MARIE (G Jogoo) – Held up passing the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running consequently inconveniencing ZAREEBA.</p> <p>ZAREEBA (T Comignaghi) – Inconvenienced when weakening near the 150 metres.</p> <p>FIELD OF FIRE (K Chowdhoo) – Bumped and briefly unbalanced passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>CRISPIN (C Barnes) – When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance stable forewoman and jockey C Barnes, advised the mare had had an economical trip and had a good record on course.</p>	
Race 9	FATHERS DAY RACES 6TH SEPTEMBER HANDICAP 1600m

RAISE YOU FIVE (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

ROSIE GLOW (K Asano) – Slow to begin.

JUST PUSH PLAY (K Chowdhoo) – Over raced in the early stages. Had trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the last 125 metres.

ARE YOU CEREAL (R Mudhoo) – Had to be restrained off heels near the 500 metres when over racing.

GOLD'NGURU (S Toolooa) – Raced wide without cover through the middle stages.

TUILANA (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MONTERRAT (C Barnes) – Held up early in the run home and when shifting out to find clear racing made contact with THE GORDONIAN near the 250 metres and then lay inwards for the remainder of the run home.

SHANZINO (T Jonker) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres when shying away from a runner improving to the inside crowding STOP MAKING SENSE.

STOP MAKING SENSE (A Balloo) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 175 metres.

OUR TEDDY BOY (C Campbell) – When asked to comment on today's performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.

NEWMARKET (S Wynne) – When asked to comment on the performance of the favourite, rider advised she had raced three wide but with cover and had been disappointed with its effort over the final stages.

Race 10	SPEIGHT'S HANDICAP 1600m
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DRUMSTORM (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Blundered shortly after the start.

MIDNITE KAOS (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of PABLEAU near the 1300 metres. Was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight until inside the final 100 metres.

PABLEAU (K Kwo) – Blundered on jumping shifting in abruptly hampering HEBERITE.

HEBERITE (C Campbell) – Hampered at the start losing ground. Steadied off heels for a distance passing the 900 metres. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle part of the run home.

TOP GHIA (C Barnes) – Raced three wide without cover. Ducked out passing the 200 metres being inclined to race greenly under pressure in the straight. When asked to comment on the improved performance trainer P Harris advised that the horse had not had much luck in recent starts and the stable had always rated the mare and a good performance today was not a surprise.

S Wynne (EFFERVESCENT) – Issued with a warning under the careless riding rule for allowing her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of TIMES TIME who had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres.
