<b>FLEURISSIMO</b> (D Johnson) – Trainer R Manning advised Stewards, that he is satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and he intends to continue with the mare's preparation.

<b>DON DRAPER</b> (S McKay) – Trainer S Marsh reported to Stewards, that he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, will now apply blinkers to the gelding's gear before his next race day start.

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>ALEXANDRITE</b> (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Lost off the hind plate during the running.</p> <p><b>THE LAST TSUNAMI</b> (D Danis) - Slow away then restrained.</p> <p><b>TURRET</b> (C Jones) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages shifting out to avoid heels approaching the 900 metres. Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>CERYS</b> (A Calder) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>HOLA SENORITA</b> (S McKay) – Steadied approaching the 400 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.</p> <p><b>CANNOLI</b> (D Johnson) - Lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>LODGE RENTALS 1200</b>
<p><b>SWEET CLEMENTINE</b> (M Hashizume) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>TROUBLE</b> (S McKay) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground then further restrained racing ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p><b>GORGEOUS GEISHA</b> (C Jones) – Slow away then travelled wide throughout.</p> <p><b>JEWEL OF PATCH</b> (C Ormsby) – Had to be restrained away from the heels of <b>STYLISH SUGGESTION</b> passing the 900 metres which steadied to avoid the heels of <b>IMBLAZE</b> (C Burdan) which shifted in, <b>SACRED CHARM</b> which was following also had to be restrained. C Burdan was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance. Improved onto heels passing the 400 metres then shifted in an attempt to obtain clear running</p> <p><b>SACRED CHARM</b> (S Spratt) - Crowded and steadied 900 metres.</p> <p><b>QUIZZY LIZZY</b> (R Elliot) - Slow away. Rider R Elliot advised that the mare’s breathing had been abnormal. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p><b>APPELLANT</b> (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuses.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>FAIRVIEW MOTORS WAIKATO HURDLE (3200 metres)</b>
<p><b>AVA MARIA</b> (R Elliot) - Misjudged the first fence and fell. The horse was uninjured with the rider sustaining a possible collarbone injury and was transported to the medical centre for further evaluation. Hampered as a result was <b>ABACUS</b>.</p> <p><b>ABACUS</b> (M Cropp) - Hampered after jumping the first fence. Stumbled on landing after jumping the second to last fence dislodging rider M Cropp with both horse and rider uninjured.</p> <p><b>SENASSY</b> (J Seivwright) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the fourth fence.</p> <p><b>LAEKEEPER</b> (S Fannin) – Misjudged the fence near the 900 metres and fell with both horse and rider uninjured. <b>SO KEEP EM</b> which was following was unable to avoid the fallen runner and was bought down, with both horse and rider also uninjured. Hampered as a result of the fall was <b>DELEGATE</b>.</p> <p><b>SO KEEP EM</b> (L Douglas) – Bought down 900 metres.</p>	

**DELEGATE** (D Parker) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Hampered 900 metres. Pulled up before jumping the final three fences.

**TRISHA LEA** (C Studd) - Pulled up before jumping the final three fences.

**CASHEL** (N Downs) - Pulled up before jumping the final three fences.

**NO CHANGE** (E Farr) – Hampered by the fallen runner after the second to last fence.

**ARITE GURU** (S Karnicnik) - Made contact with BAD BOY BROWN near the 50 metres when both runners shifted ground.

**BAD BOY BROWN** (I Lupton) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly during the early stages. Made contact with ARITE GURU near the 50 metres after shifting ground.

**Race 4** | **WROTE @ HIGHVIEW MILE (1600 metres)**

**CAMPING** (D Johnson) - Slow away.

**RED RUSHIN** (C Lammas) – Slow away.

**POINT BREAK** (D Danis) – Slow away, then ridden urgently to recover. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

**RELIABULL** (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

**SIGLO** (M Cameron) – Gave ground appreciably from near the 600 metres and was not persevered with over the final 300 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

**ALFA ROSSO** (J Riddell) - Travelled wide throughout.

**D Danis** (POINT BREAK) - Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

**Race 5** | **SIGNATURE HOMES WAIKATO STEEPLECHASE (3900 metres)**

**EL DISPARO** (I Lupton) - Slow away. Pulled up before jumping the final fence.

**ZAMORA** (C Studd) - Slow away. Poor jump at the fence near the 2000 metres.

**EL CORBY** (N Downs) - Poor jump second fence losing ground.

**RAISAFUASHO** (S Karnicnik) - Retired from the race near the 1600 metres with a veterinary examination finding the gelding to have suffered a left-fore tendon injury. Connections advised RAISAFUASHO would now be retired from racing.

**CHOCOLATE FISH** (M Cropp) - Poor jump at the fence near the 1500 metres and then retired from the race.

**ZED CASE** (D Parker) - Pulled up passing the 900 metres.

**NAPOLEON** (R Cole) - Slow away. Made the first jump awkwardly unbalancing the rider. Had to briefly steady near the 300 metres to avoid the heels of **MACKLEMORE** (E Farr) which was shifting in. E Farr was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance. Shifted away from **MACKLEMORE** when jumping the last fence, jumping through the wing and dislodging rider R Cole who was uninjured.

**MACKLEMORE** (E Farr) - Briefly lost its footing when making the bend near the 2400 metres. Rider dropped whip after jumping the final fence.

**N Downs** (EL CORBY) - Reprimanded after jumping the last fence when EL CORBY was tiring and had no reasonable chance of improving its position.

**Race 6** | **FOSTER 2100**

**GABRIEL** (A Calder) - Began slowly losing ground.

**SPRING DELIGHT** (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced in restricted near the 2000 metres then commenced to over-race and further restrained to avoid the heels of **ZABDI** which steadied to avoid the heels of **PURSUED** (M Kareem) near the 1900 metres which had shifted in. Apprentice M Kareem was reprimanded and advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance with Stewards taking into account evidence taken from Rider C Grylls who advised the racing manners of **SPRING DELIGHT** had been the foremost cause.

**PACORUS** (M Hashizume) – Raced in restricted room 2000 metres.

**ZABDI** (L Satherley) - Raced in restricted room from near the 2000 metres before being briefly steadied to avoid heels 1900 metres.

**WOODEN EDGE** (C Jones) - Began awkwardly.

**IRISH CALL** (R Oliver) – Became tailed off rounding the final bend and was not persevered from near the 400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

**D Montes de Oca** (RICHARD OF YORKE) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively. After considering submissions, the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today 8 August, up to and including racing on the 23 August, 6 national riding days.

**Race 7** | **PAK'nSAVE CLARENCE ST 2100**

**ROMANTIC LADY** (C Burdan) - Buffeted shortly after the start. Inconvenienced 300 metres.

**CASAQUINMAN** (R Oliver) - Crowded shortly after the start.

**SAVY YONG BLONK** (D Johnson) - Slow away.

**TELLYAWHAT** (S Collett) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages.

**IHU** (M Hashizume) - Shifted in passing the 300 metres inconveniencing **ROMANTIC LADY**.

Following the race the connections of the second-placed **ROMANTIC LADY** wished to view Stewards footage, electing not to proceed with a protest.

**Race 8** | **SUPER SETH @ WAIKATO STUD 1400**

**LUMINOUS** (D Montes de Oca) - Began awkwardly making contact with **LADYLAX**.

**MARS BARS** (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance Rider S Collett could offer no tangible excuses.

**MOTUMAN** (M Kareem) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ROYAL PRINCE** (A Calder) - Began awkwardly.

**TWEEDLEDEE** (T Yanagida) - Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres.

**VERNANME** (D Johnson) - Shifted in to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Johnson advised the gelding had failed to cope with the impost of 61.5kg together with the existing track conditions.

**Race 9**

**SKYCITY HAMILTON WAIKATO CUP DAY TICKETS ON SALE NOW MILE (1600 metres)**

**VADAVADR** (S McKay) - Slow to begin.

**OBSESSIVE** (D Johnson) - Raced in restricted room leaving the barriers.

**GRAND BOUQUET** (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

**KAIPAKI ROAD** (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly.

**PRINCESS EL JAY** (M Kareem) - Became tailed off and was not persevered with from near the 300 metres.

**REDCAYENNE** (C Dell) - Became tailed off passing the 600 metres and was not preserved with from near the 400 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination found the gelding to have bled. REDCAYENNE is now subject to a three month stand down from racing or trialling and a two month stand down from track work with a veterinary clearance also being required before racing or trialling next.

**Race 10**

**SEE YOU @ VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE DAY 1400**

**NOMOATHAJ** (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly then crowded.

**SAGUNTO** (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

**TABATA** (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance Rider D Johnson advised that the mare had not been entirely comfortable in the existing track conditions.
