GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE (1200m)

TENNESSEE ROCK (R Beeharry) – Jumped inwards at the start crowding inside runners. Raced wide throughout.

WILLNOTQUIT (C Barnes) – Jumped outwards abruptly at the start crowding outside runners. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

MISS HARLEY QUINN (G Jogoo) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

ZARA MAC (T Comignaghi) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

TAWNY WAY (T Moseley) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

THE EMPORESS (K Chowdhoory) – Severely crowded at the start having to be checked, losing ground.

JUST A GIRL (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend until near the 250 metres.

Race 2 THOMAS GREEN MAIDEN 1200 (1200m)

BORN TO BE BAD (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) – Shifted outwards abruptly shortly after the start hampering TAPDOG which then had to be checked to avoid the heels of HENLEY.

TAPDOG (L Callaway) – Hampered having to be checked shortly after the start.

EXCLAIM (T Comignaghi) – Raced three-wide without cover.

MARMADUKE (D Bothamley) – Raced wide throughout.

THE LAST WORD (C Johnson) – Held up entering the straight near the 250 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 150 metres. Inconvenienced near the 75 metres.

HENLEY (J Lowry) – Shifted outwards under pressure inconveniencing THE LAST WORD near the 75 metres.

Race 3 HOKONUI SUZUKI / ADVANCE AGRICULTURE HANDICAP 1200 (1200m)

EASY HABIT (T Moseley) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

FLYING SARDINE (Y Chew) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Raced wide throughout.

SHAARA (R Beeharry) – Had to be restrained away from the heels of EASY HABIT shortly after the start, losing ground.

ACEKINGSUITED (T Comignaghi) – Hampered shortly after the start, becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

IRISH EXCUSE (R Mudhoo) – Steadied passing the 1000 metres when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of PETITE ROSE which lay inwards when being restrained. Held up passing the 400 metres and was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

PETITE ROSE (C Johnson) – Raced fiercely in the early to middle stages, shifted outwards to avoid heels passing the 800 metres and raced three-wide without cover from that point. Gave ground quickly from the 300 metres finishing in a distant last placing. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that after traveling strongly the mare had been quickly beaten when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed PETITE ROSE to have superficial abrasions to the left hind leg consistent with being galloped on during the running.

Race 4 KIM MCDOWELL PAINTING MAIDEN 1335 (1335m)

FLOAT (T Comignaghi) – Jumped away awkwardly.

ARE THERE (G Jogoo) – Inconvenienced crossing the junction onto the course proper near the 1100 metres when MEGALOMANIAC jumped outwards.

SENOR MOSS (A Balloo) – Raced three-wide without cover.

THE MARLBORO MA'AM (R Mudhoo) – Restrained off heels for some distance from near the 600 metres before obtaining clear running inside the final 250 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.

I'M A TIGER (K Asano) – Lost the left front plate during the race.

NO QUANTUM (K Mudhoo) – Following the running of this event Stewards sought a Ruling from the Judicial Committee pursuant to Rule 632(1) as to whether the gelding had been denied a fair start when being held by a Starters Assistant as the gates opened and as a result lost considerable ground and its chance in the race. After hearing from rider K Mudhoo and the Starter Mr K Price and viewing replays of the start the Judicial Committee declared NO QUANTUM to be a non-starter with all bets on that runner to be refunded.

DREAM BRAVE (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that he had been unable to improve when held up rounding the final bend but then had failed to run on in the straight and had been disappointing, adding that in his opinion the gelding may not have been suited by the holding nature of today's track conditions.

MEGALOMANIAC (C Campbell) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had held its breath.

Race 5 CROYDON CONTRACTING / FALLS HOTEL HANDICAP 1335 (1335m)

SOUNDS PROMISING (S Wynne) – Fractious in its barrier and reared as the gates opened losing several lengths as a result.

SO NATURAL (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin. Held up from near the 600 metres until obtaining clear running when angling outwards across heels near the 200 metres.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) – Shifted outwards abruptly to avoid the heels of HAZELNUT when that runner was being steadied near the 700 metres hampering TRICKLE TREAT and GARMENT. A Balloo was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

TRICKLE TREAT (T Comignaghi) – Hampered near the 700 metres.

GARMENT (K Kwo) – Hampered near the 700 metres.

HAZELNUT (R Mudhoo) – Raced three wide without cover.

HE'S GOT POWER (K Asano) – Gave ground from the 400 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that he had attempted to go forward from a widish barrier but after being caught wide he had elected to restrain to obtain cover and the gelding had then felt to switch off. Mr Asano added that in his opinion HE'S GOT POWER is better suited to being ridden forward however he was unable to do so on this occasion. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

FIRE KATYUSHA (G Jogoo) – Held up rounding the final bend and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres hampered the weakening ONCE A WEEK.

ONCE A WEEK (T Moseley) – Hampered when giving ground near the 200 metres.

Race 6 HENDERSON LIVESTOCK / LIVESTOCK SUPPLIES MAIDEN (2000m)

WHERO (J Laking) - Bounded at the start.

STEP SON (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

MOUNT HERCULES (K Asano) – Raced keenly shortly after the start when being restrained to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Raced wide in the middle stages.

RAISE YOUR SIGHTS (C Johnson) – Raced four-wide without cover in the middle stages.

GOA HEAD CALLER (R Mudhoo) – Lost the left hind plate during the race.

T Moseley (MISS CATHERINE) was spoken to regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 O'CONNOR RICHMOND / AUTO FUNDS HANDICAP 2000 (2000m)

CHOOKIE'S GIRL (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

DANTE FIRE (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

TRANSCENDENT (T Moseley) – Had to be firmly restrained and shifted inwards to avoid the heels of SHANTAV near the 1800 metres making contact with PERFECTO. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed TRANSCENDENT to have a slow recovery with blood tests to be conducted early next week which Stewards will follow up.

PERFECTO (K Asano) – Hampered when contacted near the 1800 metres.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (C Johnson) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of PERFECTO near the 1800 metres.

SHANTAV (T Jonker) - Had to be steadied away from the heels of FINE BOUQUET which lay inwards rounding the first bend near the 1550 metres.

COME FLY WITH ME (A Bohorun) – Gave ground from the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that in his opinion the big weight had been a factor and that the mare had not felt comfortable in the prevailing track conditions.

RAISE YOU FIVE (C Campbell) – Gave ground from the 600 metres and was not persevered with thereafter with the rider reporting he felt there may have been something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 8 HOKONUI CONTRACTING / LONGFORD TAVERN HANDICAP (1800m)

FRANCIS DRAKE (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground then raced ungenerously in the early stages, getting its head up on a number of occasions.

ROSIE GLOW (K Asano) – Slow to begin. Raced wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the mare had hung outwards throughout and had failed to respond to his urgings. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with an appropriate veterinary clearance now required prior to racing again.

ARE YOU CEREAL (R Mudhoo) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle todays track conditions.

Race 9 KEVIN COYLE MEMORIAL HANDICAP 1800 (1800m)

RELIABLE GLOW (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly. Saddle shifted during the running inconveniencing the rider who also reported that in his opinion the mare had failed to back up after winning at Riccarton the previous Saturday.

YOUVEBEENLITUP (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1550 metres.

SHOCK AND AWE (T Moseley) – Got back shortly after the start.

ESCAPOLOGIST (S Wynne) – Blundered near the 1300 metres.

THE STYLE (T Jonker) – Raced wide in the early stages.

ZED LEPPELIN (C Campbell) – Raced wide in the early stages. Rider dropped his whip near the 800 metres.
