Race 1	MATAMATA FUNCTION CENTRE 1600
<p>TUTTA LA CLASSE (K Ramsamy) – Slow away (10L). The connections were advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>RISING RANSOM (C Grylls) – Jumped away awkwardly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found a superficial wound on the left fore pastern.</p> <p>PRESTIGIOUS LAD (C Ormsby) – Slow away.</p> <p>NOBLE STAR (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly when being restrained approaching the 1200 metres.</p> <p>DR HANK (T Thornton) – Steadied off heels near the 1300 metres after TAREE (M Kareem) shifted in when not fully clear. M Kareem was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>T Newman (REACT) – Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>JOHNNIE REDMOND (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had hung during the running and was unsuited by today's track conditions.</p> <p>KAIPAKI ROAD (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse, however was of the opinion that the mare would benefit from a step-up in distance at its next start.</p>	
Race 2	J SWAP CONTRACTORS LTD 1600
<p>TEEN TITAN (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SWITCH IN TIME (S Spratt) – Knuckled shortly after the start.</p> <p>TUNZAGUTZ (T Newman) – Slow away.</p> <p>HATTIE BEE (C Lammas) – Slow away. Pulled up by its rider rounding the final bend. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have suffered from atrial fibrillation and bled from both nostrils. The connections were advised that the mare would now be subject to the mandatory 3 month stand down from racing, 2 month stand down from training with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialing next.</p> <p>RISING RENOWN (A Calder) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>T Newman (TUNZAGUTZ) – Admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively when riding TUNZAGUTZ prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.</p>

<p>DELUXE EDITION (T Newman) – Slow away.</p> <p>ARICINA (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>INTRIGUE (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>COMMUNIQUE (C Grylls) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>LUBAYA (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p> <p>H Schofer (NO LOITERING) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>A Calder (CHERRY LANE) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 4	FAIRVIEW MOTORS 1200
<p>BELLE FOLIE (J Fawcett) – Was removed from its barrier after being fractious and underwent a veterinary examination being cleared to start. Began awkwardly. Commenced to over-race in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>IFFIE SHOWS (A Goindasamy) – Crowded at the start losing ground. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had not travelled comfortably throughout, and had been unsuited by today's track conditions.</p> <p>TANNAHILL (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LACED WITH GOLD (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>BURCHA (B May) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>ROYCE ROCA (M Cameron) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>FLASH WARRIOR (S Spratt) – Commenced to over-race approaching the 900 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BURCHA (B May) which shifted in. B May was advised to exercise care.</p>	
Race 5	COMAG MAIDEN 1400
<p>HARVEY DARVEY (C Ormsby) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>GRACIES GOLD (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>VANILLA CHINCHILLA (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>DAWNTING (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LIMENTIS (D Johnson) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Commenced to over-race in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>LIGHTNING WARRIOR (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>PINEAPPLE LUMP (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.</p>	

C Ormsby (HARVEY DARVEY) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6	WRIGHTWAY BUILDERS MAIDEN 1400
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LOFTY (C Burdan) – Slow away.

OCEAN SPIRIT (S McKay) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had been unsuited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

IRISH BOY (A Calder) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early stages.

SUNTORY LADY (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

GLEN FREY (C Grylls) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

C Lammas (SUNTORY LADY) – Spoken to regarding his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 7	JIMMY NEAL ELECTRICAL HANDICAP 1400
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AMAZING AZ (M Cameron) – Slow away. Shifted out slightly just prior to the winning post making contact with YAMUNA which shifted in. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer M Bradley advised that the gelding had raced well fresh in the past and had benefitted from today's track conditions.

LIQUID INSPIRATION (D Danis) – Slow away. Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres.

RIP EM UP (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

WHEAO (R Simpson) – Began awkwardly.

FLAUNTING (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DIOGENES (C Burdan) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of LOVE STRUCK which was forced inwards by WHEAO which shifted in and away from RUKUHIA passing the 1100 metres, then continued to over-race through the middle stages.

LOVE STRUCK (C Grylls) – Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had been unsuited to today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

PALAMEDES (A Goindasamy) – Held up having to shift out approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

YAMUNA (S Collett) – Shifted in just prior to the winning post making contact with AMAZING AZ which shifted out slightly.

R Simpson (WHEAO) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively when riding WHEAO prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Payment was withheld while the connections of the second placed YAMUNA viewed video footage of the final straight before electing not to proceed with a protest.

<p>YATIMA (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SODA (M Kareem) – Slow away. Improved on to heels passing the 400 metres having to be firmly restrained.</p> <p>ORAKEI OVERLORD (C Ormsby) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>RITANI (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>KARALINO (C Grylls) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>SHERRIF (D Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>L Innes (DEMONETIZATION) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 9	CUNNINGHAM DECORATING SERVICES HANDICAP 1200
<p>JUSTACANTA (D Danis) – Slow away.</p> <p>LONDON EXPRESS (H Schofer) – Raced ungenerously for a distance approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>VIKTOR VEGAS (S Spratt) – Knuckled shortly after the start. When questioned regarding performance rider S Spratt advised that in her opinion the gelding had been unsuited by today's holding track conditions.</p> <p>MIDNIGHT RUNNER (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced when being restrained in the middle stages.</p> <p>NEW YORK JAZZ (T Newman) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>S McKay (INCA WARRIOR) – Spoken to regarding raising his arm higher than shoulder height when using the whip.</p>	
Race 10	WAIKATO STUD 1200
<p>WELL CHOSEN (D Johnson) – Slow away.</p> <p>MAKE TIME (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Improved on to the heels of MIRAZUR approaching the 1000 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>QIJI DANCER (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LAVAGLO (S Weatherley) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Held up passing the 200 metres having to shift inwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p>MIRAZUR (A Goindasamy) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>VIKING (L Innes) – When questioned regarding performance rider L Innes advised that the gelding had been unsuited by today's track conditions, however in his opinion would derive benefit from today's outing.</p>

<p>MONT VENTOUX (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>DEEJAY MAC (A Goindasamy) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p>	

GREENCAST (J Fawcett) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early stages.

AMUN RA (S McKay) – Placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres having to be steadied when weakening.

COLLINSTREET (H Schofer) – Had to shift out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

DOUBLE HAPPY (L Innes) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions which he described as holding.

J Riddell (VERRY FLASH) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively when riding VERRY FLASH prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

C Orsmby (EL LUCHADOR) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively when riding EL LUCHADOR prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.
