RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 JAMES HARDIE MAIDEN HURDLES (2800 Metres)

WONDER LASS (J Seivwright) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence and then commenced to over-race. Raced keenly throughout. Lost rider when hitting the fence near the 800 metres. J Seivwright was examined by paramedics and cleared to ride.

PRIZED PINS (N Downs) - Inclined to hang in the early stages. Retired from the race when well back and out of contention.

MASTER PATRICK (S Karnicnik) - Had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen rider at the fence near the 800 metres.

Race 2 TASMAN INSULATION PINK FIT MAIDEN HURDLES (2800 Metres)

IZYMYDAAD (S Karnicnik) - Slow away.

KEEPIN HARMONEE (J Seivwright) – Inclined to lug out rounding the first turn. Retired from the race when well back and out of contention.

THE FOT (L Douglas) - Retired from the race when well back and out of contention.

FINAL SAY (N Downs) – Retired from the race when well back and out of contention. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. After undergoing a veterinary inspection, the gelding was confirmed to have bled. FINAL SAY is now unable to be in training for two months and is unable to trial or race for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialling next.

THE POORMANZABEEL (R Cole) - Landed awkwardly at the last fence and lost momentum.

Race 3 MANAWATU ITM AWAPUNI HURDLES (2900 Metres)

ZENTANGLE (B Lammas) - Inclined to over-race early.

GALLANTE (R Cole) – Ran off rounding the home turn on the last round and did not finish. Stable representative M Northcott advised stewards that the gear on GALLANTE would be altered prior to its next start and a veterinary inspection would be carried out early next week with any anomaly reported to the RIU. A further warning has been placed against the racing manners of GALLANTE.

SO KEEP EM (L Douglas) – Retired at the straight entrance when well back and out of contention.

NO TIP (A Kuru) - Hung inwards approaching the last fence.

SENASSY (J Seivwright) – Hit the last fence.

TRISHA LEA (C Studd) - Rider advised the mare was making respiratory noises. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 4 CODY SINGER MEMORIAL MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (3200 Metres)

KILRONAN (E Farr) – Fell at the first fence dislodging rider E Farr who was examined by paramedics and cleared to ride. KILRONAN underwent a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.

BIGREDMOON (B Lammas) – Rider lost the use of his left iron at first fence on landing, resulting in him becoming unbalanced and being dislodged. B Lammas sustained a minor leg injury but was cleared by paramedics.

ZARTAN (R Cole) - Hampered by a riderless horse for some distance in country on the first occasion. When questioned R Cole said that after being hampered by the riderless runner the gelding hung outwards badly going into the back straight so was retired from the race.

MR DAVINCI (G Walsh) - Was inclined to hang rounding the first turn when hampered by a riderless runner. Made a poor jump at the first fence in the home straight.

KEYBOARD WARRIOR (C Studd) – Retired from the race when rider C Studd was of the opinion the gelding may have a wind problem.

MESMERIZE (I Lupton) and **THE ANARCHIST** (A Kuru) came together and bumped at the last fence when THE ANARCHIST shifted in.

The field was diverted around the first two fences in the back straight on the second occasion as a result of paramedics attending to the fallen riders.

Race 5 LJ HOOKER MANAWATU STEEPLECHASE (4400 Metres)

WISE MEN SAY (I Lupton) - Landed awkwardly at the first fence in the home straight on the first round.

TAI HO (S Karnicnik) – When questioned in the run of TAI HO, rider S Karnicnik advised the gelding travelled well until hitting the third last fence. Tai Ho also hit the last fence. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

HIGHLY LIKELY (C Studd) - Returned to the enclosure minus a plate.

Race 6 IPL PLYWOOD & NELSON PINE INDUSTRIES MAIDEN (2200 Metres)

ROHAN (S O'Malley). Underwent a veterinary examination at the start and was cleared to start after coming into contact with a gate leaving the enclosure.

RAUCOUS (J Parkes) - Over-raced and was inclined to get its head in the air when being restrained in the early and middle stages.

M Sanson (WEST COAST) - Lost her whip early in the home straight

NEDWIN (R Bishop) – Raced wide throughout without cover. When questioned, rider R Bishop advised the gelding was unsuited to the Heavy 11.

IRISH FLARE (D Bradley) and OUR CUZZIE (S Macnab) came together and bumped approaching the 200 metres.

S O'Malley (ROHAN) – Spoken to regarding his whip use in the home straight.

Race 7 WINSTONE WALLBOARDS HANDICAP 1000 (1000 Metres)

MARIA DIOR (D Hirini) - Slow away.

YOUNG SQUIRE (F Lazet) - Slow away.

TABARD (M Sanson) - When questioned into the run of TABARD, rider M Sanson advised the gelding had been outpaced throughout.

Race 8 RED STAG 1300 (1300 Metres)

CHEEKY AZZ (L Hemi) - Checked and lost ground going into the first turn when IF I ONLY KNEW shifted out momentarily which resulted in FULL SWING shifting out and away from that runner simultaneously as FLYING SURF shifted inwards. After questioning riders and viewing video footage the incident was considered accidental.

Race 9 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1300 Metres)

SEA STAR (M Hudson) – Slow away.

RIPCORD (S O'Malley) - Slow away.

DUBAI'S MOKO (L Hemi) - Inclined to hang in over the final stages and had to be straightened.

MIDNITE INVASION (J Parkes) – Momentarily hampered in the home straight when HE'S DONE A RUNNER shifted in near the 200 metres. Finished well back. When questioned, rider J Parkes said the mare may have got its tongue over the bit. A post-race veterinary examination confirmed the tongue had caught up in the back of the mouth

placing it at a disadvantage.

HE'S DONE A RUNNER (F Lazet) – Shifted in near the 200 metres.

Race 10 PASLODE NZ HANDICAP 1400 (1400 Metres)

PLATINUM RAPPER (R Bishop) - Began awkwardly and was slow away.

TORRE DEL GRECO (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

MAUNA KEA (J Parkes) - Commenced to give ground rounding the home turn and dropped out. When questioned J Parkes advised that the combination of weight (62kg) and Heavy 11 track had contributed to its disappointing run.

Over the final stages the winner **TIMES TICKING** (E McCall) shifted in and made contact with the second placed **TORRE DEL GRECO** (T Taiaroa). T Taiaroa viewed footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection. E McCall was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master and advised she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

D Hirini (HUNTA PENCE)- Spoken to regarding the use of her whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 11 ITM FRAME AND TRUSS HANDICAP 2200 (2200 Metres)

HAMILTONIAN (L Hemi) – Slow away.

HI I'M NIKKITA (R Myers) - Bumped going out of the straight on the first occasion when racing in restricted room.

SYLVESTER (D Hirini) - Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 300 metres and bumped BAKELA.

BAKELA (T Taiaroa) - Bumped 300 metres.
