Race 3 - Zilco Three-Year-Old (1070 Metres)

Subsequent to race day it was established that this race which had been advertised as 1100 metres had been started from an incorrect marker resulting in a distance of 1070 metres, with the official result being altered accordingly.

Gore RC - Friday 21 August 2020

Race 7 - O'Connor Richmond / Auto Funds Handicap 2000

TRANSCENDENT - Co-trainer K Tyler advised that the mare had recovered well but he was still awaiting the results of blood tests and would be carrying on with its current campaign at this stage.

RAISE YOU FIVE - Co-trainer B Anderton advised that the gelding had recovered well and he had been happy with its progress since and intended to carry on with its current campaign.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE 3YO (1200m)
SUPER ABBA (C Barnes) - Slow into stride, raced greenly in the early stages getting its head up on a number of
occasions.
PLATINUM STAR (K Asano) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding outside runners, contacted near the 400
metres, inconvenienced near the 300 metres.
CUOW PATT (C Tables a) Crowdad at the start lasing ground have and a south a 700 metros and when heirs
SHOW BAZZ (S Toolooa) - Crowded at the start losing ground, hampered near the 700 metres and when being
corrected shifted back inwards hampering WATCHMAKER.
STRANGER THINGS (D Prastiyou) - Got head up when being restrained to take cover in the early stages.
WATCHMAKER (K Chowdhoory) - Hampered 700 metres, lay inwards early in the run home and continued to do so
for the majority of the straight making contact with PLATINUM STAR near the 400 metres.
EVA JAMES (S Wynne) - Ducked outwards crossing the junction onto the course proper near the 700 metres
hampering SHOWEMHOWITSDONE and SHOW BAZZ.
SHOWEMHOWITSDONE (B Murray) - Hampered 700 metres.
Race 2 SPEIGHT'S MAIDEN (1400m)
KNEAZLE (L Callaway) - Rider reported that he had been instructed to ride the mare back in the field today. Jumped
away awkwardly getting its head up when being restrained in the early stages and continued to race ungenerously for
some distance.
HEARTOHEART (K Chowdhoory) - Jumped away awkwardly, contacted near the 400 metres being bumped wider.
QUELLA RAGAZZA (S Wynne) - Slow to begin, raced wide for the remainder of the race with the rider reporting that
the bit had pulled through the mare's mouth.
MONSTER TAJIMA (Z Bholah) - Slow to begin.
BLACKJAKK (G Jogoo) - Got its head up when being restrained to avoid the heels of the runner in front when over
racing near the 1000 metres hampering VARDON ROAD, continued to over race for some distance.
VARDON ROAD (K Asano) - Hampered near the 1000 metres.
RAZOR (C Johnson) - Inclined to over race in the middle stages on a moderate tempo, then raced wide from the 800
metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had not been suited by the muddling
pace of the race.
LAST HOORAH (B Murray) - Crowded having to be steadied near the 400 metres when SERIOUSLY (R Cuneen) shifted
outwards to obtain clear running. In assessing this incident Stewards took into account that there appeared to be a
marginal run for SERIOUSLY to the inside of LAST HOORAH prior to HEARTOHEART being bumped outwards dictating
SERIOUSLY outwards. In the circumstances R Cuneen was issued with a warning.
RUSSIAN FABLE (S Toolooa) - Lay out rounding the turn near the 400 metres making contact with HEARTOHEART and
was then inclined to shift ground under pressure in the straight.

IWONDERWAI (K Williams) - Lost a hind plate during the running.

Race 3 STALLION TENDER - OPEN NOW MAIDEN (1400m)

JOJO ROXX (S Wynne) - Slow to begin, placed in restricted room having to steady near the 1000 metres to the inside of AYAPPAN which shifted in and away from DAME DU JOUR (A Balloo) which improved inside the heels of LAPHROAIG. A Balloo was advised to exercise greater care.

MISS ADELAIDE (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

AQUATTACK (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground, had to be steadied shortly after the start when JOJO ROXX (S Wynne) shifted inwards. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care.

LAPHROAIG (J Laking) - Raced wide without cover throughout, inconvenienced passing the 700 metres, came together with SUNNY LADY passing the 200 metres and was then inclined to lay in under pressure for the remainder of the race.

SUNNY LADY (R Cuneen) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages, had to shift out to avoid heels passing the 700 metres inconveniencing LAPHROAIG, came together with LAPHROAIG passing the 200 metres with R Cuneen advising that his saddle had then shifted backwards inconveniencing him for the remainder of the race, crowded near the 100 metres when LAPHROAIG (J Laking) lay in when being ridden with the whip. J Laking was advised to exercise greater care.

MAZZONI (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

NONS THE NAME (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

BROTHER WILL (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

JACK THE RIPPER (B Murray) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages, had a tendency to lay inwards in the final straight.

GRAB THE BAR (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

MISS OAKS (C Johnson) - Over raced in the middle stages.

ZURAFAA (T Moseley) - Lay in under pressure in the run home making slight contact with ROAD TO DIAMONDS in the shadows of the finish.

VOLVIK (S Wynne) - Came together with TANTALEE on a number of occasions over the final 200 metres.

TANTALEE (Z Bholah) - Came together with VOLVIK on a number of occasions over the final 200 metres.

S Toolooa (BROTHER WILL) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 PGG WRIGHTSON SEEDS 1400 HANDICAP (1400m)

THE BUFFER (L Callaway) - Slow into stride.

QWERTY (K Mudhoo) - Very slow to begin.

TAPONISME (R Mudhoo) - Began slowly losing ground.

QUEEN JETSUN (K Williams) - Briefly placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when NOAH improved forward to sit outside the leader, raced three wide without cover throughout.

BELINDABELLA (B Murray) - Held up rounding the final turn.

Race 6 JON SNOW @ CLEARVIEW PARK 1400 HANDICAP (1400m)

EL BEE JACK (K Asano) - Slow to begin then being restrained to the rear to shift to a position adjacent to the running rail after jumping from a wide barrier.

EMILY MARGARET (S Toolooa) - Blundered leaving the barriers losing ground, raced three wide without cover throughout.

CARSON RIVER (K Chowdhoory) - Held up in the early part of the run home.

OWEN PATRICK (R Beeharry) - Held up in the early part of the run home until near the 200 metres.

DEVIOUS (T Comignaghi) - Lay out rounding the final turn continuing to do so throughout the straight.

Race 7 HYGAIN/MITAVITE 1200 HANDICAP (1200m)

SIGNIFY (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhoory) - Bounded at the start. Contacted near the 400 metres.

PURE CLASS (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

EL BEE DARCI (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TURNCOAT (W Papier) - Began awkwardly.

DARCI MAC (B Murray) - Raced wide throughout.

GIGOLO GEORGE (T Moseley) - Over raced in the middle stages.

HE KIN FLY (R Cuneen) - Made contact with NELLIE BLY when attempting to obtain clear running near the 400 metres, then being held up having to steady and shift ground passing the 175 metres.

QUALITY PREVAILS (L Callaway) - Inconvenienced near the 250 metres when ARNAGE lay out under pressure.

PIPPI REA (T Comignaghi) - Held up for clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

Race 8 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO 2000 HANDICAP (2000m)

PRODUCER (T Jonker) - Slow to begin then raced three wide without cover throughout.

JILDI JILDI (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

FIVE PRINCES (G Jogoo) - Restrained to the rear on jumping, had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home only gaining clear racing room near the 250 metres.

STOP MAKING SENSE (K Asano) - Had to be firmly restrained off the heels of KAHARAU (L Callaway) for a distance near the 1800 metres when KAHARAU was being steadied. Rider L Callaway was reminded of his obligation not to steady his mounts to a degree that puts other riders in difficulty.

HOT TAP (S Toolooa) - Hampered when crowded near the 400 metres when JUST PUSH PLAY had to be steadied and shift inwards to avoid the heels of the weakening OCEANS AWAY.

JUST PUSH PLAY (K Chowdhoory) - Had to be steadied and shift inwards near the 400 metres to avoid the heels of the weakening OCEANS AWAY.

STANDREWS MASONIC (T Comignaghi) - Crowded and had to be steadied near the 300 metres when racing between FIVE PRINCES which shifted out looking for clear racing room and METASEQUOIA which lay in at this point.

Race 9 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1600 HANDICAP (1600m)

BRONTE BEACH (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

STRAD (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

ITSONLYMONEY (S Wynne) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding outside runners, held up rounding the final bend making contact with CAMINO ROCOSO near the 450 metres which then bumped GEE TEE ELEANOR out onto the heels of EFFERVESCENT, continued to be held up early in the run home before shifting ground inwards to find clear running near the 350 metres.

KANDARI (K Williams) - Began to over race shortly after the start and passing the 1200 metres had to shift outwards to avoid the heels of the runner in front when racing fiercely and in doing so forced EFFERVESCENT wider on the track, continued to over race badly through the middle stages. When questioned rider reported that the gelding had then been unable to finish the race off as a consequence.

EFFERVESCENT (B Murray) - Forced wider near the 1200 metres and obliged to race three wide without cover from this point.

CAMINO ROCOSO (C Johnson) - Over raced in the middle stages, bumped near the 450 metres, then being held up until near the 350 metres.

GEE TEE ELEANOR (R Mudhoo) - Bumped near the 450 metres and had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of EFFERVESCENT.

UPPERHAND (T Comignaghi) - Lay out under pressure in the straight.

S Wynne (ITSONLYMONEY) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

T Comignaghi (UPPERHAND) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
