GENERAL:

<p>J Lowry did not attend the meeting due to illness and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.</p> <p>Several races on today's programme ran late due to a combination of factors including short intervals, horse behavioural issues, and the distance from the stables to the birdcage. It is recommended that with capacity sized fields at this venue 35 minute intervals is a general requirement.</p>

Race 1	SUPREME EQUINE FEEDS MAIDEN (1200m)
LETHAL (J Laking) - Bounded at the start losing ground.	
SPINDLESHANKS (C Johnson) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting SANTISSIMA .	
FOLLOW YOUR HEART (K Asano) - Jumped away awkwardly becoming unbalanced contacting JACK ATTACK .	
SANTISSIMA (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly then further hampered when contacted losing ground.	

JACK ATTACK (C Barnes) - Contacted start, raced three wide without cover.

TRADITION (R Beeharry) - Over raced through the middle stages clipping a heel and blundering passing the 600 metres.

GOOSE BAY (Y Chew) - Lay out rounding the final turn. Apprentice Chew was shown film footage in the presence of the riding master.

LET'S GO BERNIE (T Moseley) - Bumped becoming unbalanced passing the 350 metres when LADY CANTO shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

LADY CANTO (K Williams) - Made contact with LET'S GO BERNIE when shifting outwards to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.

K Chowdhoo (ROCK SENSATION) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Y Chew (GOOSE BAY) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2	THE HANLEY FORMULA AND ONCEUPONATIME MAIDEN 1200 (1200m)

JACK KNOWS BEST (T Comignaghi) - Jumped inwards contacting GOODONYAMATE at the start, had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of RAZOR (R Cuneen) going into the bend near the 900 metres. R Cuneen was advised to exercise care. Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

GOODONYAMATE (B Murray) - Contacted at the start, held up rounding the final turn from the 600 metres.

TAPDOG (C Johnson) - Knuckled on jumping losing ground.

BARRETT (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

OVATION (G Jogoo) - Raced at the rear throughout losing contact with the remainder of the field from the 800 metres dropping out to finish a distant last. When questioned, rider advised that the mare had raced very greenly. Trainer B Tapper was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare and that it would be expected to be more competitive in future racing. Mr Tapper indicated that OVATION would not be persevered with as a racing proposition.

LITTLE JOHN (J Laking) - Raced keenly into the first bend having to be restrained and getting its head up on a number of occasions.

RAZOR (R Cuneen) - Had to be firmly restrained racing into the first bend getting its head up on a number of occasions.

OPHELIA ROSE (R Mudhoo) - Commenced to over race passing the 1000 metres.

IRISH GIRL (S Wynne) - Raced three wide without cover, had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the straight.

Race 3	COUPLAND'S STOCKFEED MAIDEN (1200m)

Trainer **R Beckett** (SHE'S RECOMMENDED) - Fined \$50 under the minor infringement schedule after failing to obtain permission for an item of notifiable gear by the required time.

SHE'S RECOMMENDED (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly becoming unbalanced hampering WILLNOTQUIT, held up rounding the final turn and could not obtain clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

STELLA CREEK (K Williams) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact and becoming unbalanced nearly dislodging its rider, raced wide without cover throughout.

MISS PENVOSE (B Murray) - Contacted by STELLA CREEK on jumping losing ground.

GONE WITH THE WIND (S Wynne) - Bounded on jumping and further hampered when contacted becoming unbalanced losing ground, steadied when improving onto heels near the 700 metres, checked and went off-stride near the 650 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of COURTINASLIPSTREAM which had ducked inwards away from THE GIFT which lay in. Rider S Wynne advised that the filly had raced greenly and over-reacted in this incident.

WILLNOTQUIT (G Jogoo) - Hampered leaving the barriers and further hampered shortly after when SHE'S RECOMMENDED shifted away from ONE MORE CHANCE with WILLNOTQUIT being checked losing ground.

COURTINASLIPSTREAM (R Cuneen) - Ducked inwards near the 650 metres having to be corrected with the rider advising that the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

THE GIFT (K Mudhoo) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied going into the bend near the 900 metres.

LADY MODENA (R Mudhoo) - Had to be firmly restrained for a distance when improving onto the heels of TAVILIGHT passing the 600 metres.

TAVILIGHT (T Comignaghi) - Lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 4 | **TEMUKA HOTEL 1200 (1200m)**

REDFORD (R Beeharry) - Began awkwardly getting its head up with the rider becoming unbalanced.

SURE IS (T Comignaghi) - Slow away.

ACEKINGSUITED (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly contacting LOUIE LOUIE

LOUIE LOUIE (C Johnson) - Hampered when contacted on jumping getting back, raced wide throughout.

NOAH (R Cuneen) - Contacted by REDFORD after jumping.

EXCLAIM (Y Chew) - Raced three wide without cover.

MISS DIORELLA (C Campbell) - Steadied when improving onto heels near the 500 metres.

T Moseley (ACEKINGSUITED) - Spoken to regarding his whip use on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **DAVE GRANT & NEIL KINGSTON DASH (1200m)**

RICKY BAKER (Y Chew) - Slow away, lay in under pressure in the straight.

MISS TILLY WINKS (D Prastiyou) - Raced keenly into the first bend having to be restrained off heels by its rider and commenced to over race.

RIVERFALLS (K Chowdhoo) - Had to be steadied when crowded near the 1100 metres, contacted when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

G Jogoo (SHE'S A SMASH HIT) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not fully clear of RIVERFALLS which had to steady.

RUNNING MAN (R Cuneen) - Raced three wide without cover.

MEDITERRANEAN STAR (B Murray) - Raced four wide without cover, lay in under pressure near the 300 metres when weakening making contact with RIVERFALLS.

OUR PROM KING (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover.

WHERE ANGELS WALK (C Johnson) - Held up entering the straight near the 350 metres then having to check when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of OUR PROM KING.

Race 6	GERALDINE VILAGE INN SPORTS BAR SPRINT HANDICAP (1200m)

Trainers **M & M Pitman** - Fined \$50 after presenting CONFSSIONAL with an incorrect saddle cloth number.

VASILIKI (T Moseley) - Slow away.

PHANTOM WITNESS (S Wynne) - Bounded at the start losing ground, had a tendency to hang outwards throughout having to be steadied away from heels near the 600 metres.

BLACK LABEL (C Campbell) - Jumped inwards contacting PIPPI REA which became unbalanced for a few strides, commenced to over race approaching the first bend getting its head up on a number of occasions.

JEWEL OF PATCH (B Murray) - Began awkwardly with rider becoming unbalanced.

PIPPI REA (T Comignaghi) - Unbalanced when contacted at the start.

REMINGTON (R Mudhoo) - Caught wide in the early stages.

SPIDER (L Callaway) - Commenced to over race passing the 700 metres having to be restrained, contacted near the 350 metres.

ROCANTO (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover.

MISS BRAHMOS (K Williams) - Shifted outwards to obtain clear running making contact with SPIDER near the 350 metres.

CONFSSIONAL (W Papier) - Had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the straight.

NOWHERE MAN (K Chowdhoo) - Checked when improving onto heels near the 100 metres.

Race 7	THE JON SNOW AT CLEARVIEWPARK MILE HANDICAP (1600m)

TUILANA (S Wynne) - Slow away.

DREAMING EASY (R Mudhoo) - Slow away, crowded near the 200 metres.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race, contacted near the 200 metres.

KANDARI (K Mudhoo) - Commenced to over race when being restrained shortly after the start and continued to do so through the middle stages.

PAPAGENA (S Toolooa) - Lay out throughout the race making the final turn awkwardly making contact with **SPLENDIOR** near the 300 metres

SPLENDIOR (C Campbell) - Contacted near the 300 metres.

VERMONT (B Murray) - Held up passing the 300 metres and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running to the outside of **SPLENDIOR** was taken out by that runner making contact with **DREAMING EASY** near the 200 metres which was crowded onto **BLUEY'S CHANCE**.

MANHATTAN FLAME (K Williams) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse.

LINEDANCEKING (K Asano) - Rider reported that his saddle had shifted forward during the running.

Race 8 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE (1600m)**

GINGER JANE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly and crowded between runners getting its head up on a number of occasions, had to be steadied off heels passing the 1400 metres again getting its head up on a number of occasions.

THE EMPRESS (K Chowdhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

MISS HARLEY QUINN (G Jogoo) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up, raced ungenerously in the early stages continuing to get its head up on a number of occasions.

MAN OH MAN (T Jonker) - Restrained shortly after the start in an attempt to obtain cover after being caught wide going back onto **IRISH HI** which was hampered.

IRISH HI (T Comignaghi) - Hampered shortly after the start having to be steadied off heels.

ON THE RIVET (T Moseley) - Raced three wide without cover.

ATLANTEAN (R Cuneen) - Lay outwards rounding the final turn running wide on the track then ducking inwards near the 200 metres, with the rider advising that the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

BETATHEDEVILUNO (C Campbell) - Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the straight.

SOVIET WONDER (Y Chew) - Held up approaching the 200 metres having to shift ground outwards.

MISS OAKS (K Asano) - Lay in under pressure making contact with **MAH GIRL** near the 75 metres.

MAH GIRL (C Barnes) - Contacted near the 75 metres.

Race 9 | **JOHN WALSH 1600 (1600m)**

TAPONISME (R Mudhoo) - Reluctant to load delaying the start, got its head up when racing keenly approaching the first turn near the 1300 metres.

MONKEY SHOULDER (T Comignaghi) - Commenced to over race in the early stages skying its head on a number of occasions before settling.

YANNICK (C Johnson) - Restrained in the early stages when endeavouring to find cover and was inclined to over race.

SANCTIFY (S Wynne) - Raced wide without cover before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 900 metres, steadied over the concluding stages when placed in restricted room.

ZAREEBA (B Murray) - Raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres, steadied over the concluding stages when awkwardly placed near heels.

Race 10 | **TEMUKA SEED (1984) LTD MILE (1600m)**

SWEET OAK (BB Hong) - Slow to begin.

TAMALIN (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

ARE YOU CEREAL (T Moseley) - Had to be steadied away from heels near the 1400 metres, over raced in the middle stages getting its head up.

HEAD OFFICE (R Beeharry) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DANCING CHOUX (K Kwo) - Clipped a heel of ARE YOU CEREAL and blundered near the 1400 metres when ARE YOU CEREAL had to be steadied to avoid the heels of APELLIDO which shifted outwards across the heels of GRANITE RIDGE (C Barnes) which shifted inwards when only marginally clear. C Barnes was advised to exercise greater care.

BRIDGET TOWN (C Campbell) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

KHAFEEF (J Laking) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse, advising that the gelding had received a nice trip and had been very disappointing. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 11 | **TEMUKA TRANSPORT (1967) LTD STAYERS (2200m)**

NATHAN DETROIT (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin, steadied to shift outwards across the heels of PICKUP to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

FRANCIS DRAKE (G Jogoo) - Bounded leaving the barriers and slow to begin then getting its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained, again got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 1600 metres when the pace eased.

PRODUCER (A Balloo) - Slow to begin, got its head up on a number of occasions in the early stages after the rider endeavoured to settle his mount, caught wide for the majority of the race.

FIGEAMEOUT (T Moseley) - Over raced passing the 1600 metres when the pace eased and continued to do so for a distance.

S Wynne (THE SAINTLY ONE) - Spoken to regarding the manner in which she eased the pace near the 1600 metres.

Race 12 | **CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS MAIDEN 2200 (2200m)**

WHEREO (D Bothamley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

ROCKWITHME (S Wynne) - Skyed its head on jumping.

LAST LETTER (A Balloo) - Slow away, inconvenienced near the 200 metres when ROAD TO DIAMONDS shifted outwards.

INVIGORATE (B Murray) - Restrained to the rear in the early stages.

HIGHLY POLISHED (K Asano) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages, forced outwards contacting SHINNECOCK passing the winning post on the first occasion.

WHEREABOUTS (L Callaway) - Steadied to avoid the heels of EISENHOWER near the 2000 metres, raced keenly into the first bend having to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the winning post on the first occasion and shifting outwards forcing HIGHLY POLISHED onto SHINNECOCK which then ran wide.

T Comignaghi (EISENHOWER) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards near the 2000 metres when not fully clear of WHEREABOUTS which had to be steadied.

ROAD TO DIAMONDS (K Mudhoo) - Over raced when being restrained near the 1700 metres, steadied and shifted outwards across the heels of EISENHOWER to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

SHINNECOCK (J Laking) - Contacted passing the winning post on the first occasion then running wide rounding the first turn, placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres to the outside of PRINCE AZLAND which was taken out by EISENHOWER (T Comignaghi) which lay out when improving forward. T Comignaghi was advised to exercise greater care. Also taken into account was HIGHLY POLISHED which was racing tight to the outside of SHINNECOCK. With PRINCE AZLAND continuing to give ground SHINNECOCK then clipped a heel of that runner near the 500 metres and continued to be held up behind PRINCE AZLAND for a distance then not being persevered with in the straight.
