RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE DAY 1400

IRISH BOY (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly and then was further hampered losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

C'EST UNE STAR (C Jones) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

OVERSTAYER (S Collett) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

ISOLA SACRA (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after having to be steadied.

PAPENHUYZEN (C Ormsby) – Crowded shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MACROS (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PATSYS LAD (L Satherley) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

RUIZ (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages, then raced keenly when attempting to be restrained near the 800 metres.

Race 2 ALLIED SECURITY 1400

JAMES BARRIE (S Weatherley) – Slow away. Briefly held up passing the 200 metres. Contacted approaching the winning post becoming momentarily unbalanced.

IMBLAZE (M Kareem) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of LILY D'OR which shifted out passing the 50 metres.

MANNIE'S POWER (T Thornton) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider T Thornton advised that in her opinion the mare would benefit from some easing of the ground.

BOUNDTOBEHONORED (S Spratt) – Held up until shifting inwards near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

FLOMILINE (D Johnson) - Placed in restricted room over the concluding stages having to be steadied.

C Lammas (LILY D'OR) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out over the concluding stages placing IMBLAZE and FLOMILINE in restricted room.

B May (SAIGNON) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively when riding SAIGNON prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

Race 3 PAK'NSAVE CLARENCE ST 2100

MOTUMAN (T Yanagida) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away. Clipped a heel passing the 2000 metres and blundered unbalancing its rider who lost the use of his left stirrup iron for a distance.

OUR CRAFTSMAN (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

LOTHBROK (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin.

QUIZ KID (J Riddell) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SAVASTEP (M Cameron) – Had to change ground passing the 100 metres after VITTACHI shifted into its line when clear.

PLUSHENKO (M Hashizume) – Shifted outwards abruptly passing the 400 metres to avoid the heels of LOTHBROK.

T Newman (JUDY'S SONG) – Admitted a charge in that she allowed her mount JUDY'S SONG to shift in when not clear of MOTUMAN which clipped a heel and blundered near the 2000 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended Miss Newman's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 9 September up to and including 17 September, 4 national riding days.

Race 4 SAVILLE ROW 2100

DIVINE DUKE (M Hashizume) – Contacted and unbalanced shortly after the start losing ground. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in his opinion the gelding would benefit from some easing of the ground and had been left flat-footed when the field sprinted rounding the bend.

EXCALIBUR (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

SPRING DELIGHT (C Grylls) – Had to be steadied passing the 1800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of CHIEF SEQUOYAH which shifted in when only marginally clear.

DEEJAY MAC (A Goindasamy) – Had to be steadled passing the 1800 metres after becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of PURSUED. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

GRAND BOUQUET (D Danis) – When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer L Brennan advised that the mare had benefitted from the improved track conditions.

S O'Malley (BIG MIKE) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 WRC NORTHLAND BREEDERS STAKES

YOURPOINT (D Johnson) – Crowded and steadied at the start losing ground. Lay in making the bend near the 800 metres when racing greenly. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE (T Thornton) – Crowded and steadied at the start losing ground.

SUFFUSED (M Cameron) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the colt had raced greenly throughout and, in his opinion, would derive benefit from today's race.

BOURBONAIRE (S Collett) – The rider dropped her whip passing the 100 metres. Received veterinary attention post-race after suffering a laceration on the left fore cannon.

Race 6 TEN SOVEREIGNS 1200

CASAQUINMAN (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

MR UNIVERSE (C Lammas) – After being fractious in its barrier stall began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

WOODCOTE LASS (C Grylls) – Steadied when placed in restricted room making the bend near the 800 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be suffering from thumps. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

MONEY TRAIL (M Hashizume) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of BAVELLA (L Innes) which shifted in slightly near the 800 metres. L Innes was advised to exercise care.

ROMANTIC LADY (D Johnson) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained passing the 900 metres, then made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

TELLYAWHAT (C Jones) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

TIME TO FLY (T Yanagida) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have suffered from atrial fibrillation. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

Race 7 US NAVY FLAG 1400

VEE CECE (C Grylls) – Slow away.

SAVY YONG BLONK (D Johnson) - Slow away.

VOLER POUR MOI (T Yanagida) – Slow away. Improved on to heels over the concluding stages.

PAISLEY PARK (A Calder) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw.

POLZEATH (J Fawcett) – Unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight.

SHOWBEEL (M Cameron) – Steadied to avoid the heels of PAISLEY PARK (A Calder) passing the 300 metres. A Calder was advised to exercise care.

TE TORO PEARL (S Spratt) – Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

SULTAN OF SWING (C Jones) – Raced in restricted room just prior to the winning post when runners on either side shifted ground.

Race 8 VALACHI DOWNS FOXBRIDGE PLATE 1200

HELLO IT'S ME (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SCOTT BASE (C Ormsby) – Began awkwardly and then was hampered shortly after. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres.

DEMONETIZATION (L Innes) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw.

TRAVELLING LIGHT (S Collett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider S Collett advised that the mare had not travelled comfortably throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed minor lacerations inside both nostrils.

JULIUS (J Waddell) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of ARETHA passing the 600 metres having to be steadied dropping back on to PRISE DE FER.

PRISE DE FER (O Bosson) – Inconvenienced passing the 600 metres after improving on to heels.

O Bosson (PRISE DE FER) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 1000 metres when not clear of TRAVELLING LIGHT and SCOTT BASE which were both placed in restricted room having to be steadied. Also contributing was slight outward movement from PRINCESS KERERU.

PRINCESS KERERU (C Lammas) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

ARETHA (M Cameron) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed lameness in the right hind leg and an irregular heartbeat. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

Race 9 VESPA 1300

MY WORLD (T Yanagida) – Slow away.

A PROPER LADY (L Innes) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.

WORDSWORTH (J Riddell) – Steadied to avoid the heels of TINY TERROR which was forced outwards by CHEERS (A Goindasamy) passing the 100 metres. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care.

LADY LIRA (M Cameron) – Held up over the final 100 metres.

MIRAZUR (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 10 ZACINTO MILE

STAR TSAR (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded shortly after losing ground.

LUMINOUS (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground then commenced to over-race in the early stages.

SODA (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.

RED TSUNAMI (S Spratt) – Was eased down by its rider in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's performance.

TWEEDLEDEE (T Yanagida) – Held up until passing the 200 metres.
