# Race 1 RBC RACING 1600 MAIDEN 1600M

**KARAMELLO KOALA** (T Thornton) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barrier.

**PEERLESS WARRIOR** (A Goindasamy) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barrier.

**TARWYN** (C Ormsby) – Shifted in abruptly leaving the barrier making contact and becoming unbalanced.

**HIT THE ROAD JACK** (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin.

**CUBA** (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

VANILLA CHINCHILLA (C Burdan) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

**GRACIES GOLD** (S Spratt) – Held up rounding the final turn until obtaining clear running near the 100 metres.

**SWEET LILLY** (C Grylls) – Held up having to shift in off heels near the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

**KEEPING LUCKY** (L Satherley) – Held up for the majority of the final straight.

# Race 2 THE CLOTHIER FARM 1600 HANDICAP 1600M

**TINDER HIT** (M Kareem) – Slow to begin.

MIDNITE INVASION (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

**REACT** (T Newman) – Began awkwardly.

PRESTIGIOUS LAD (C Ormsby) – Slow to begin.

**KOOLASCUZ** (S Weatherley) – Tightened shortly after the start.

**TOUCH THE CLOUDS** (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**SACRED DELIGHT** (T Thornton) – Held up for a distance rounding the final bend.

**NOBLE STAR** (C Grylls) – Steadied off heels when weakening passing the 100 metres.

ITS A KINDA MAGIC (T Yanagida) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 100 metres.

# Race 3 MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 1400 MAIDEN 1400M

J Waddell was replaced on UNCLE TERRY by connections due to being 0.5 kg over-weight.

**UNCLE TERRY** (C Lammas) – Slow to begin (3L). Shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

**LIMENTIS** (D Johnson) – Reared as the barriers opened losing ground (5L).

**SAVAPPIEL** (S Spratt) – Raced ungenerously when being steadled in the early stages shifting out near the 900 metres crowding MISCONDUCT. Hampered as a result was LADY GWENDOLYN and SAILOR JERRY.

**TELEKINETIC** (S Collett) – Had to be steadied off the heels of POCHESTI when the pace steadied near the 1000 metres dropping back on to TEARANITA which had to steady with BOUFFANT having to shift out abruptly to avoid that runner's heels. Hampered as a result was LIMENTIS.

LADY GWENDOLYN (A Goindasamy) – Hampered 900 metres.

**SAILOR JERRY** (C Grylls) – Hampered 900 metres.

**DAWNTING** (S McKay) – Over-raced through the middle stages when the pace eased.

**TEARANITA** (L Satherley) – Briefly held up entering the final straight.

**PANGO** (T Thornton) – Had to shift out off heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres. Became awkwardly placed near heels passing the 75 metres and was steadied.

# Race 4 CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES – 23RD DECEMBER MAIDEN 1400M

**IVERSON** (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.

FOXSQUILLION (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

LORD PAINTON (C Grylls) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

**DUNDRUM** (M Kareem) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

**HOLA SENORITA** (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**GLORIOUS SIREN** (A Goindasamy) – Was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. Rider advised that the mare failed to handle the existing track conditions.

### Race 5 GCM FEEDS LTD 1200 MAIDEN 1200M

**EMBER ATTACK** (A Calder) – Began awkwardly.

**BABY CHEESES** (S Collett) – Steadied 1000 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.

**TARGHEE** (C Lammas) – Steadied 1000 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.

**S Weatherley** (MOANA) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

# Race 6 WAHAROA TRANSPORT CO (1995) LTD 1200 MAIDEN 1200M

**EXTERSEA** (A Goindasamy) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced keenly through the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

GITCHE GUMEE (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

THE BOOGEYMAN (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

**GREASE LIGHTNING** (T Yanagida) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

**TRAVELLING KATE** (S Collett) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

# Race 7 THE CLOTHIER FAMILY 1600 HANDICAP 1600M

**FELIX FAURE** (C Lammas) – Made contact with the front of the gate as the start was effected with the gate opening slightly faster. The Stewards were satisfied that the gelding had not gained an advantage. Commenced to over-race when being steadied through the early and middle stages.

GALLARDO (S Collett) – Began awkwardly, then shifted in abruptly hampering FLY TO THE MOON.

FLY TO THE MOON (L Satherley) – Hampered start losing ground.

**S Ralph** (BLUETWENTYTWO) – Presented BLUETWENTYTWO and NIGELLA JAZZ without notified gear (blinkers) and was fined the sum of \$50.

# Race 8 THE ROBERT BRUCE CLOTHIER MEMORIAL HANDICAP 1200M

**OCEAN BELLE** (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

**TANGODANZER** (A Goindasamy) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.

**SILVER SASANOF** (M Kareem) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.

**CAITHNESS KID** (T Yanagida) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres.

**SUPAGILI** (C Burdon) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres.

**FIRST ROCK** (L Satherley) – Raced handy until commencing to give ground early in the final straight and was not persevered with. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a delayed recovery rate.

**PORSHABELLE** (T Thornton) – Had to be steadied just prior to the winning post when placed in restricted room.

**NUCLEAR FUSION** (C Lammas) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Following the race the connections of the third placed horse NUCLEAR FUSION viewed Stewards video footage in the final straight electing not to proceed with a protest.

### Race 9 TRANSPORT MECHANICAL WAHAROA LTD 1200 MAIDEN 1200M

**SHOWCAT** (S Weatherley) – Crowded becoming unbalanced shortly after leaving the barriers. Shifted out and away from MAJOR BILLY LISTER making contact with MARLEY which was forced out on to DUBY which had to be firmly restrained near the 900 metres.

**THE VILLAIN** (L Satherley) – Crowded and hampered soon after leaving the barriers. Raced keenly through the middle stages.

I'M CAPABLE (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly then crowded and hampered soon after leaving the barriers.

HAPPINESS FOREVER (A Goindasamy) – Crowded and hampered soon after leaving the barriers.

MI SKY (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

TICKLE ME ALMO (C Burdan) – Steadied from a wide barrier.

**MAJOR BILLY LISTER** (J Waddell) – Was not persevered with passing the 300 metres with rider J Waddell advising the gelding had hung throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed right hind lameness and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

**DUBY** (C Grylls) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

### Race 10 WAHAROA INDUSTRIAL PARK 2000 MAIDEN 2000M

**MEANT TO BE** (T Newman) – Began awkwardly.

**CAMPING** (R Oliver) – Began awkwardly.

**CASSIO** (D Danis) – Began awkwardly.

CHARRED (T Thornton) – Steadied for a distance passing the 1500 metres when awkwardly placed.

MR GHIBSON (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

**RISING ROAD** (S Spratt) – Had to briefly steady when awkwardly placed inside the heels of A'NOOD DUDE which shifted in slightly under pressure passing the 200 metres.
