Race 1	BHL FEEDS MAIDEN HURDLES 2900M
	CHOWDER (R Cole) – Retired in the home straight when well back and out of contention.
	KEEP IT UP (D Parker) – Retired in the home straight when well back and out of contention.
	NIGHTTRONIC (G Walsh) – Retired in the home straight when well back and out of contention.
	GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS – (B Lammas) – Slow away.
	MASTER FIN (A Kuru) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence unbalancing the rider.

STRATIUS (L Douglas) – Fell at the first fence in the home straight on the first round.

BUDDY PERFECT was unable to avoid the fallen runner resulting in rider B Donoghue becoming dislodged. B Donoghue was unhurt.

RITESAIDZED (S Karnicnik) – Had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen runner and shifted out hampering KEEP IT UP. Had to steady to avoid a loose horse near the 1600 metres. Did not finish.

DUNDEE STREET (J Seivwright) – Had to be taken wide to avoid the fallen runner.

L Douglas (STRATIUS) – Sustained a collar bone injury and is to provide a clearance prior to his next ride.

Race 2 | **ECOLAB MAIDEN HURDLES 2900M**

Due to there being no replacement rider available for the injured L Douglas, ZEDBRA was late scratched.

DEAR DOUGLAS (R Cole) – Failed to finish when well back and out of contention.

WONDER LASS (G Lass) – Failed to finish when well back and out of contention.

PREDICTION (B Donoghue) – Failed to finish when well back and out of contention.

BRUNO KELLY (M Cropp) – Failed to finish when well back and out of contention.

EL PABLO (J Seivwright) – Failed to finish when well back and out of contention.

VAN BLANC (A Kuru) – Was inclined to run some of its fences down.

R Cole reported that DEAR DOUGLAS may have held its breath.

Race 3 | **WEIR BUSES MAIDEN 2100M**

Following consultation with riders track conditions were downgraded to Slow 9.

MASTER BLACK JACK (M Hudson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

C Burdan (BEAR GRYLs) – Dropped her whip in the final straight.

Race 4 | **GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1200M**

SWEET KARMA (C Burdan) – Slow away.

TEQUILA SPIRIT (J Parkes) – Was tightened at the start and got back when there was simultaneous movement from runners either side.

LOVE FOR ALL (D Bradley) – Wide throughout without cover. Had to be straightened near the 100 metres when shifting in.

BOLD BETTE (M Hudson) – Was held up for a short distance near the 150 metres when attempting to improve.

Race 5 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200M**

MEILA REI (R Myers) – Slow away.

When questioned into the run of **DUBAI'S MOKO** L Hemi was of the opinion the mare would now be better suited to a longer distance.

When questioned into the run of **HE'S DONE A RUNNER** J Parkes advised that the gelding was not suited to the track conditions.

Race 6	BROTHER PAUL YAXLEY MAIDEN 1400M
S McKay (SHEEZ LEICA) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
Race 7	HAPPY BIRTHDAY HEATHER D MAIDEN 1400M
MITCHELL (D Bradley) – Was late scratched at 2.55 pm after refusing to parade. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against MITCHELL with regarding to its barrier manners.	
SHOWSHANELLE (S McKay) – Slow away.	
MCGOWAN (S Weatherley) – Shifted out abruptly at the start dictating JOLENE, ANOTHER SECRET and LOVE STORM outwards.	
SIR CALEB (D Bradley) – Raced wide throughout.	
ANOTHER SECRET (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
TENNESSEE ROSE (S Macnab) – Briefly held up prior to entering the home straight.	
Race 8	HEATHER D YAXLEY MARTINEZ TROPHY HANDICAP 1400M
RUFUS RUFFCUT (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly and was slow away.	
BECKIDIBOO (A Goindasamy) – Jumped in at the start losing ground.	
BATCHELOR BABE (D Hirini) – Was steadied towards the end of the back straight when in restricted room.	
FLORAL ART (F Lazet) RUFUS RUFFCUT (C Burdan) came together for several strides near the 800 metres.	
SHOWMEWARE (S Macnab) and BEYOND THE FORT (R Myers) came together and bumped for some distance when SHOWMEWARE was seeking a run passing the 800 metres.	
ROSEWOOD – Finished well back. Apprentice T Taiaroa advised the mare would be better suited to more rain affected (looser) footing.	
Race 9	JOSIE AMBER YAXLEY MAIDEN 1600M
JENEVER (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly and was slow away.	
MANHATTEN AFFAIR (A Mudhoo) – Tended to over race in early and middle stages.	
LETTERUP (S McKay) – Finished some distance last, when questioned S McKay was of the opinion the mare would be better suited to firmer track conditions.	
The saddle on CISJURANE slid forward in the back straight placing rider S Macnab at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.	
Race 10	MICHELLE PAYNE GOLD CUP HANDICAP 1600 1600M
STORMY HABIT (M Hudson) – Was slow away.	
RUBY NEGRONI – Was not persevered with in the home straight after rider S Mackay considered something may be amiss. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
VENT (C Burdan) – Shifted ground outwards over the final stages making contact with WILLIAM WALLACE (R Myers) near the finish. Apprentice Jockey C Burdan was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master and advised that	

she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

Race 11

CHILLCO REFRIGERATION 2100M

ONE OF THE BEST– Dislodged rider D Weatherley in the preliminary and galloped some distance so was scratched by the Stewards at 5.10pm. D Weatherley was cleared by paramedics.

EM KAY POPS (S Macnab) – Slow away.

EKSTREMEMISS (S McKay) – Over raced early.

ROCKING GOOD TIME – When questioned into the disappointing run rider N Alam advised the gelding was unsuited to the slow pace.
