Rider L Douglas did not attend today's meeting due to suffering an injury yesterday at Egmont RC 11 September 2020.	
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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Stella Artois Maiden Hurdle (2760 metres)
<p>IZYMYDAAD (S Karnicnik) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>WHOLETTHEFOXOUT (S Fannin) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CLEAVER (E Farr) – Became awkwardly placed on heels after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres and steadied. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 350 metres.</p> <p>ULUAKI (B Donoghue) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 800 metres losing ground.</p> <p>APEROL (M Roustoby) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 700 metres and was retired from the race.</p> <p>ALTIUS (D Parker) – Retired from the race prior to jumping the final two fences.</p> <p>BLANCO BAY (I Lupton) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 350 metres.</p> <p>THE POORMANZABEEL (R Cole) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence.</p> <p>TIPICAL (H McNeill) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After undergoing a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination the gelding was deemed to have bled and is now subject to a three month stand down from racing and a two month stand down from track work with a veterinary clearance being required prior to trialling or racing. The connections advised that TIPICAL would now be retired from racing.</p>	
Race 2	Barfoot & Thompson Hurdle (3350 metres)
<p>EACH WAY (J Seivwright) – Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 3000 metres when improving on to heels. Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>SENASSY (D Parker) – Slow to begin. Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1050 metres. Improved on to heels after passing the 400 metres. Landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence. Lost the left hind plate during the running.</p> <p>GALLANTE (I Lupton) – Shifted in after jumping the second fence with TRISHA LEA shifting away from that runner crowding DELEGATE which was hampered losing ground. Affected as a result was GRINNER which was contacted becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>DELEGATE (S Fannin) – Crowded after jumping the second fence and hampered losing ground. Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1050 metres.</p> <p>GRINNER (E Farr) – Contacted after jumping the second fence becoming unbalanced then raced in restricted room in the early stages. Misjudged the fence near the 1050 metres and fell dislodging Rider E Farr. Both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p>MAGNANIMOUS MAN (A Kuru) – Jumped the fence near the 2600 metres awkwardly, hampering LAKE SUPERIOR which was forced wider.</p> <p>LAKE SUPERIOR (S Karnicnik) – Hampered after jumping the fence near the 2600 metres. The rider became unbalanced when jumping the final fence.</p>	

MAGIC CANNON (R Cole) – Raced wide for the majority of the race. Forced wide after jumping the fence near the 1050 metres.

BANKS ROAD (G Walsh) – Forced wide after jumping the fence near the 1050 metres.

ARITE GURU (H McNeill) – Jumped the fence near the 350 metres poorly.

Race 3	Dunstan Feeds Maiden Steeplechase (4150 metres)
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TE KAHU (M Cropp) – Declared a late scratching at 1.30pm on veterinary advice after being kicked when parading behind the barrier.

DAAD (N Downs) – Slow to begin. Jumped indifferently and was pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

LOTHBROK (B Donoghue) – Slow to begin.

KILRONAN (E Farr) – Jumped the first fence poorly.

CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (R Cole) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres and fell. Jockey R Cole suffered a shoulder injury and was stood down from riding. CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF was uninjured other than suffering a minor laceration on the inside of the left nostril.

A Kuru (THE ANARCHIST) – Admitted a breach in that he used the whip above shoulder height with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

SINO HEIGHTS (D Parker) – Lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 4	Barfoot & Thompson Steeplechase (4150 metres)
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NAPOLEON (D Parker) – Slow to begin.

COUNTRY BUMPKIN (J Seivwright) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence dislodging Rider J Seivwright with both horse and rider being uninjured.

THE ARABIAN DUKE (M Roustoby) – The rider lost the use of the right rein after jumping the first fence, and when attempting to re-gather it shifted out abruptly losing momentum and jumped the second fence poorly.

THAT’S HOW IT GOES (A Kuru) – Jumped the fifth fence poorly.

MAGIC WONDER (S Fannin) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence on the second occasion.

GO GO GONZO (S Karnicnik) – Jumped the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion poorly and landed awkwardly. Put in a poor jump at the final fence and fell. Both horse and rider were uninjured.

ZED CASE (C Studd) – Directed around the final fence to avoid the fallen rider.

THE BIG OPAL (H McNeill) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the second to last fence.

C Studd (ZED CASE) – Admitted a breach in that he failed to obey a directive when not retiring ZED CASE from the race after becoming uncompetitive from near the 1200 metres. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$400.

Race 5	Dunstan Feeds 2100
<p>MAESTRO BLU (M Kareem) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>ZEEFA ZED (M McNab) – Crowded when leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages and directed away from heels passing the 1700 metres.</p> <p>DR HANK (S McKay) – Contacted when leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced. Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>CAPTAINTWINKLETOES (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>MY CALLISTO (A Calder) – Crowded near the 1700 metres and steadied when in restricted room to the outside of ZEDMAN which shifted out when being steadied. Held up for a distance rounding the final turn. When questioned regarding the performance Rider A Calder could offer no tangible excuses other than becoming awkwardly placed amongst other runners.</p> <p>TAHUROA HEIGHT (L Innes) – Crowded for a distance approaching the 300 metres.</p> <p>T Yanagida – Issued with a warning after permitting RENEGADE FIGHTER to shift out under pressure when insufficiently clear of TAHUROA HEIGHT which was crowded for a distance approaching the 300 metres.</p> <p>RIPPEDEEDOODAH (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could offer no excuse.</p>	
Race 6	Otakiri Reserve 1200
<p>LUPELANI (M Hashizume) – Crowded when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>GORGEOUS GEISHA (C Jones) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>AIR CENTRE (C Dell) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MACUSHLA (A Goindasamy) – Steadied away from heels near the 900 metres.</p> <p>AIR CENTRE (C Dell) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>MISS RICKY BOBBY (S Spratt) – Was denied clear racing room passing the 300 metres when improving into a marginal run between DIVINE DIVE and AIR CENTRE both of which shifted ground slightly.</p> <p>L Innes (DIVINE DIVE) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of a race when circumstances permit him to do so.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (MACUSHLA) – Was accidentally struck with the whip by fellow rider C Jones near the 275 metres.</p>	
Race 7	JRA Trophy (1400 metres)
<p>NASHA RIVA (C Grylls) – Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>SWEET CLEMENTINE (A Calder) – Restrained from a wide barrier draw.</p> <p>FINBARR (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Was denied clear racing room approaching the 300 metres when attempting to improve to the inside of THE BUZZ (C Lammas) which had commenced to lay in when placed under pressure. C</p>	

Lammas was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must make a greater effort to straighten his mounts in future.

RITANI (D Johnson) – Steadied when weakening passing the 150 metres when in restricted room.

SHERWOOD FOREST (M McNab) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had never travelled comfortably throughout. The gelding underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found grade 4/5 lameness in the left foreleg. A veterinary certificate of fitness is now required for SHERWOOD FOREST prior to racing next.

Race 8	Auckland Co-op Taxis 1600
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DELUXE EDITION (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly.

BLUE BREEZE (A Goindasamy) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw.

FISCAL FANTASY (L Innes) – Began awkwardly making contact.

PENELOPE CRUISE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

CRITICS CHOICE (M Kareem) – Raced wide without cover.

CODECRACKER (C Grylls) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

YATIMA (C Burdan) – Hampered 700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

LADY SHABEEL (C Lammas) – Held up before shifting out passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.
