RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TE WHANGAI ROMNEYS HAWKE'S BAY HURDLE (3100 metres)
---------------	--

MASTER COURSTMAN - (S O'Malley) - Slow away (4 lengths), had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen runners at the second and fifth fence.

LAEKEEPER (S Fannin) – Fell at the second fence.

LAKE SUPERIOR (H McNeill) – Was unable to avoid the fallen runner after jumping the second fence and was brought down.

BAD BOY BROWN (I Lupton) – Had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen runners, fell at the fifth fence sustaining an injury and was humanely euthanized.

The field was directed around the second and third fence in the back straight to avoid the fallen rider.

ALI BABA (M Rousteby) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres and landed awkwardly.

ZENTANGLE (D Parker) - Jumped the last fence poorly almost unseating the rider.

S Fannin sustained a dental injury when falling and was taken to hospital for observation.

Race 2	REDWOOD TROPHY (2000 metres)
---------------	-------------------------------------

The start of this race was delayed 8 minutes due to the paramedics attending the injured S Fannin.

LA CASA (M McNab) - Began awkwardly and shifted in hampering ZAC BROWN, ducked in abruptly near the 300 metres and tightened ONE OF THE BEST which was dictated inwards onto WAISAKE.

ZAC BROWN (R Elliot) – Hampered at start.

BRINGITONPET (C Grylls) - Was tightened at the start when ONE OF THE BEST shifted out dictating FANTASY FLIGHT out into its line.

ONE OF THE BEST (J Parkes) - Raced wide in the early and middle stages before being taken forward near the 1800 metres. When questioned, J Parkes advised that the gelding raced fiercely in the early stages so he elected to go forward.

RIPCORD (S O'Malley) -Had to steady for some distance passing the 800 metres when in restricted room and continued to be held up until near the 400 metres.

WAISAKE (T Harris) – Bumped at the 300 metres.

T HARRIS (WAIKASE) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$450.

Race 3	AHD HAWKE'S BAY STEEPLECHASE(4800 metres)

The start of this race was officially delayed by 10 minutes.

MANDALAY (H McNeill) - Slow away, lost rider at fence near the 1400 metres on the first round.

DES DE JEU (J Sievwright) – Slowed up at the first fence and went back onto COCONUT, slipped and fell on the adverse camber reentering the course proper near the 800 metres on the last occasion. J Sievwright was questioned and confirmed the gelding slipped on the sharp adverse camber. This part of the track was inspected by the RIU and no other anomalies were detected. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed right forelimb lameness.

COCONUT (M Cropp) - Rider lost the use of his outside iron at the first jump when DES DE JEU slowed up prior to regaining it before the next jump, retired from race when well back and out of contention.

ZAMORA (C Studd) – Put in a bad jump at the second fence, retired from race when well back and out of contention.

TAI HO (R Cole) – Put in a poor jump near the 400 metres and dislodged the rider. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed an over reach injury to the left forelimb.

DELACROIX (B Lammas) - Landed awkwardly at the fence near the 400 metres.

A KURU (PERRY MASON) -Was spoken to regarding his victory celebration prior to the finish.

Race 4	TAYLORS POOLS & SPAS 1300 (1300 metres)
---------------	--

This race was officially delayed 6 minutes.

SECRET SQUIRREL (R Myers) - Shifted out abruptly dictating SAVETTE outwards onto PENNY ROYAL resulting in both of those runners losing ground.

SAVETTE (C Grylls) – Dictated outwards, then commenced to race very greenly losing considerable ground. Connections were advised that the mare must trial prior to racing next. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

PENNY ROYAL (J Bassett) – Lost ground at start, hampered over the final stages.

JE SUIS TIGER (J Fawcett) - Shifted out and away from KATIE PERRY over the final stages resulting in TIME TICKING and PENNY ROYAL being hampered.

TIME TICKING (S O'Malley) - Hampered over the final stages.

TOP BRASS (M Cameron) - Lay out when under pressure near the 100 metres hampering MOTIVATION which was improving to its outside.

MOTIVATION (C Ormsby) –Held up early in the home straight and jostled with SECRET SQUIRREL for some distance, hampered near the 100 metres.

J FAWCETT (JE SUIS TIGER) – Was issued with a warning under [Rule 638(1)(d)] when she allowed her mount to shift out near the 300 metres when not clear of MEHRTENS which had to check. After questioning riders, inward movement from TIMES TICKING which shifted in and made contact with MEHRTENS immediately prior to JE SUIS TIGER shifting out was taken into consideration when assessing the degree of interference.

MERHTENS (J Riddell) – Checked 300 metres.

Race 5	REMEMBER "JOOKY" 1200 (1200 metres)

KING FAROUK (J Parkes) – Slow away.

AMERICO (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground

CROSS ROADS (R Myers) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied, raced keenly in the middle stages making the bend near the 700 metres awkwardly.

ALEGRE (M Cameron) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages.

THUNDER (M Kareem) - Contacted entering the final straight, steadied prior to the winning post when placed in restricted room.

VIKING (C Ormsby) - Shifted out entering the final straight making contact with THUNDER

VAMOS BEBE (D Johnson) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened over the concluding stages.

Race 6 | **EL ROCA – SIR COLIN MEADS TROPHY (1200 metres)**

KOBE ROCKS (R Bishop) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CUTTING EDGE (S McKay) – Checked near the 400 metres when KOBE ROCKS shifted ground.

YOURPOINT (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance, rider could offer no excuse.

R Bishop (KOBE ROCKS) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(1)(d)] in that he allowed his mount to shift ground near the 400 metres when not clear of CUTTING EDGE, which was checked. After submissions by the stewards the JCA imposed a suspension from the close of racing on 24th September up to and including 3rd October (5 days)

Race 7 | **HASTINGS – HEART OF HAWKE’S BAY (1200metres)**

CYBER ATTACK – Began awkwardly and slow away.

MISS LABASA (R Bishop) - Raced three wide throughout.

MASCARPONE (R Elliot) – Raced three wide throughout.

CAVALLO VELOCE (S McKay) – Over-raced into the first turn and had to be steadied, lay in and away from VIGOR WINNER over the final stages.

C GRYLLES (BURGUNDY BELLE) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **HAWKE’S BAY BREEDERS GOLD TRIAL STAKES (1200 metres)**

NO ROCK NO POP (L Hemi) - Slow away.

MISS DIXIE (H Schofer) - Became unbalanced for several strides when racing in restricted room to the inside of TOKORANGI nearing the 800 metres.

TOKORANGI (M McNab) - Improved into a marginal run near the 50 metres then shifted out making firm contact with the hind quarters of SWEET ANNA. SWEET ANNA was then turned inwards by this contact forcing TOKORANGI inwards onto the hind quarters of BABYLON BERLIN which was contacted and unbalanced near the finish. After questioning riders, M McNab was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Connections of the fourth placed TOKORANGI viewed footage of the final stages and elected not to proceed with an objection.

BABYLON BERLIN (S Collett) – Unbalanced close to finish.

SWEET ANNA (M Cameron) – Unbalanced close to finish.

MISS AOTEAROA (C Grylls) – Lay in over the final stages and had to be straightened.

Race 9 | **VET SERVICES EQUINE HAWKE'S BAY OPEN 1600 (1600 metres)**

PEP TORQUE (R Bishop) – Charged the gate immediately prior to the start and began awkwardly getting back, raced three wide without cover throughout and was inclined to lay in around home turn.

DE GAULLE (L Hemi) – Checked near 600m. After questioning riders and viewing footage it was established that interference occurred when SAVY YONG BLONK was angled outwards to improve simultaneously as PEP TORQUE, which was racing in a three wide position lay inwards, dictating POLZEATH inwards onto SHERRIF and DE GAULLE which was checked.

RED SIERRA (R Myers) - Shifted outwards making contact with BEAUDEN near the 100 metres.

Race 10 | **TARZINO TROPHY (1400 metres)**

MR UNIVERSE (S Collett) - Underwent a veterinary inspection prior to the start after becoming fractious in the barrier and was cleared to start.

AVANTAGE (D Johnson) – Slow away.

THE MITIGATOR (S McKay) - Began to give ground in the home straight near the 200 metres and went back onto BAVELLA which had to shift out to avoid heels and in doing so made contact with GERMANICUS which was forced out onto the hind quarters of SHADOWS CAST which was turned inwards and unbalanced. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality. Connections undertook to monitor the progress of the gelding over the coming days and report any anomalies to the RIU.

SHADOWS CAST (J Parkes) – Unbalanced near the 200 metres.

GERMANICUS (C Ormsby) – Hampered when tightened near the 200 metres.

BAVELLA (L Innes) –Trainer L Noble requested a post race veterinary inspection which revealed a poor recovery rate then thumps (electrolyte imbalance) developed.

KIWI IDA (C Grylls) – Displayed a poor race recovery with evidence of the thumps

D Johnson (AVANTAGE) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$800.

Race 11 | **J SWAP CONTRACTORS 1400 (1400 metres)**

CINZENTO (J Parkes) – Slow away, over-raced and had to steady off the heels of SPIDERMAN near the 800 metres, raced wide for the remainder.

PLAY THE FIELD (M Hudson) – Shifted out abruptly after the start and tightened LINCOLN STAR then commenced to over-race into the first turn.

LINCOLN STAR (S O'Malley) – Tightened and got back at start.

YOSSARIAN (S Collett) – Steadied approaching the 100 metres.

R Myers (PRINCESS ANI) – Was issued with a warning under [Rule 638(1)(d)] after she angled her mount outwards approaching the 100 metres when not clear of YOSSARIAN which had to steady.

HOOTER (D Bradley) – When questioned regarding performance rider stated the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions. Further advising in his opinion the gelding would be better suited to some easing in the track.
