**Race 4 BCD GROUP 1400 HANDICAP**

**PRINCESS ORIGAMI** (M Cameron) - Co-trainer A Forsman advised the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and it is now their intention to continue on with PRINCESS ORIGAMI'S current preparation.

**Race 6 FIBER FRESH 3YO 1200 MAIDEN**

**CARAMELLA** (M Cameron) - Co-Trainer S Ritchie reported the filly pulled up sore and has now been sent for a spell until Autumn.

**Race 10 TARZINO TROPHY (1400 metres)**

**THE MITIGATOR** (S McKay) - Trainer P McKay advised he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding and he intends to continue on with THE MITIGATOR'S current preparation.

**Race 5 Northland Business Systems 1200**

**AWARENESS** (C Burdan) - Trainer J Richards advised he was satisfied with the post-race condition of AWARENESS, however, may look at experimenting with the mare's race day gear.

**Race 6 Bay of Islands ITM – Haruru 1600**

**KAARERAWAY** (L Satherley) - Co-trainer C Gibbs advised the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare and they intend to carry on with her current preparation.

**Race 7 Harcourts Tai Tokerau Trophy (1200 metres)**

**MELT** (C Jones) - Trainer N Tiley reported, MELT pulled up well after the race and it is his intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

**RACE COMMENTS:**

**Race 1 WAHAROA INDUSTRIAL PARK 1600**

The start was delayed slightly as two horses had been loaded incorrectly.

**MR MOSS** (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages when being steadied.

**ISOLA SACRA** (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**VENI VICI** (S Collett) – Raced in restricted room entering the final straight.

**PEERLESS WARRIOR** (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality other than abrasions to the right hip.

**Race 2** | **GREGORY EQUINE 1600**

**IVERSON** (M Cameron) – Crowded and hampered losing ground at the start.

**PATSY'S LAD** (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SWEET LILLY** (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

**ISTINA** (S Collett) – Held up early in the final straight.

**KNOCK ON WOOD** (T Thornton) – Held up early in the final straight, then raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.

**OCEAN SPIRIT** (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance rider S Weatherley could offer no excuse.

**Race 3** | **SUPER LIQUOR MATAMATA 1600**

**TIMBERLAKE** (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider A Goindasamy advised that the gelding never travelled well throughout and may benefit from further easing of the ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**TURRET** (C Jones) – Slow to begin (5L). Trainer K Fawcett was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the mare.

**KIPLING** (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered 200 metres.

**TAREE** (M Hashizume) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

**OSTASIO** (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**CRAFTYEVA** (C Grylls) – Contacted for a short distance passing the 400 metres by EL NYMPH (T Yanagida) which attempted to shift out. T Yanagida was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

**RISING RENOWN** (A Calder) – Improved on to heels passing the 250 metres, then shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres hampering BECAUSE and KIPLING.

**BECAUSE** (D Johnson) – Hampered 200 metres.

**EL NYMPH** (T Yanagida) – When questioned regarding performance rider T Yanagida could offer no excuse.

**A Calder** (RISING RENOWN) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled RISING RENOWN out near the 200 metres when not clear of BECAUSE and KIPLING which were both hampered and forced wider on the track. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended A Calder's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 30 September up to and including racing on 9 October, 6 national riding days.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>ONE AGENCY MATAMATA 1400</b>
<p><b>GRIP</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>EAGLE HUNTER</b> (E Leighton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>ALIGHIERI</b> (S McKay) – Restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p><b>LENNON</b> (M Cameron) – Raced fiercely in the early to middle stages. Not persevered with from near the 300 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>ROCKET SPADE</b> (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1000 metres when being restrained. Shifted in slightly approaching the 50 metres making brief contact with LORD PAINTON which had shifted out under pressure.</p> <p><b>LORD PAINTON</b> (M McNab) – Shifted out under pressure making brief contact near the 50 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>PAUL JONES CONTRACTING 1400</b>
<p><b>MAKARAKA</b> (S Weatherley) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>POCHESTI</b> (M Kareem) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>DAWNTING</b> (S McKay) – Restrained from a wide barrier. Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>DOHA</b> (E Leighton) – Held up early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>MAC'S EXPRESS</b> (A Calder) – Crowded passing the 250 metres by MAKARAKA which lay in when struck with the whip despite the efforts of its rider.</p> <p><b>THE GREEN DRAGON</b> (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding performance O Bosson could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>WAIKATO FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1200</b>
<p><b>SAHALAINN</b> (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>ARYA STARK</b> (S Collett) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p><b>DAME KIRI</b> (T Newman) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, then crowded passing the 900 metres between GREASE LIGHTNING (J Fawcett) which shifted in and away from SILVER LAKE and HIBERNIA SEA which shifted out and away from FIVE SCHILLINGS. J Fawcett was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p><b>COVENANT</b> (L Satherley) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>MAASIR</b> (D Montes de Oca) – It was brought to the Stewards attention approximately 10 minutes before the race that apprentice rider D Montes de Oca had weighed out at the incorrect weight (not claiming an allowance). Apprentice D</p>	

Montes de Oca was re-weighted with MAASIR then being taken from the parade area to be re-saddled. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**D Montes de Oca** (MAASIR) – Severely reprimanded after relaxing his ride from near the 50 metres with Stewards taking into account that MAASIR would not have finished in a dividend-bearing position or a higher stake bearing position. Apprentice D Montes de Oca has been referred to the Rider Skills Review Panel (Rule 343).

**RADEGAST** (O Bosson) – Raced wide for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding performance O Bosson advised he was under pressure from near the 600 metres after racing wide and the gelding had not responded.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>ONSITE DAIRY SOLUTIONS 1100</b>
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**ZENDORA** (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground and then commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied through the early stages.

**PRIMO STELLA** (C Burdan) – Slow away.

**CHARMAINE'S DREAM** (D Johnson) – Inconvenienced near the 100 metres when in restricted room to the inside of GRAND GESTURE which lay in.

**TERESITA** (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance rider M Cameron advised that the filly had raced greenly and will be better suited to more ground. Trainer J Mahoney was advised that a warning would be placed against the filly for being uncompetitive.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400</b>
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**HOLA SENORITA** (S Collett) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider S Collett advised that the mare had become agitated in the barriers and will be advising the connections that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

**WELL CHOSEN** (A Goindasamy) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw, then commenced to over-race for a distance. Held up for a distance passing the 200 metres when improving on to heels before obtaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.

**LIMENTIS** (D Johnson) – Crowded and steadied losing ground at the start.

**FALKIRK LASS** (S Spratt) – Restrained approaching the 800 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of BOLT FROM THE BLUE which was taken in slightly by CAITHNESS KID (S O'Malley). Apprentice rider S O'Malley was advised to take greater care in a similar circumstance. FALKIRK LASS then raced ungenerously for a distance.

**BOLT FROM THE BLUE** (A Calder) – Inconvenienced when crowded 800 metres.

**CAITHNESS KID** (S O'Malley) – Raced wide without cover.

**DON DRAPER** (M Cameron) – Inconvenienced passing the 350 metres when awkwardly placed to the outside of LAVAGLO (S Weatherley) which shifted out. S Weatherley was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

**LAVAGLO** (S Weatherley) – Lost the off fore plate during the running.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS 1400</b>
<p><b>SUMMER NIGHT</b> (S Weatherley) – After becoming fractious in the barriers was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection and was cleared to race. When questioned regarding performance rider S Weatherley advised that the mare would benefit from more easing of the ground.</p> <p><b>ELLE MCMASSEY</b> (A Calder) – Restrained from its wide barrier draw.</p> <p><b>RISING STEPS</b> (C Grylls) – Crowded passing the 1300 metres by MARMELLOS which had lay in and away from SAVAPPIEL with MARMELLOS and RISING STEPS both becoming unbalanced with RISING STEPS then being restrained to obtain cover.</p> <p><b>PANGO</b> (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously laying out in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>UNCLE TERRY</b> (J Riddell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SAVAPPIEL</b> (S Spratt) – Briefly steadied near the 100 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of UNCLE TERRY which was taken in by SUPER SID (O Bosson) which shifted in under pressure.</p> <p><b>O Bosson</b> (SUPER SID) - Issued with a warning after permitting SUPER SID to shift in near the 100 metres when not clear of UNCLE TERRY which dictated inwards crowding SAVAPPIEL which was briefly steadied.</p> <p><b>C'EST LA GRIS</b> (J Fawcett) – When questioned regarding performance rider J Fawcett advised that the mare would benefit from more easing of the ground.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>J P WILLS BLOODSTOCK 2000</b>
<p><b>BANKS ROAD</b> (A Goindasamy) – Slow away then further hampered.</p> <p><b>CUBA</b> (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered 200 metres and forced wider on the track.</p> <p><b>CAUTIOUS APPROACH</b> (L Innes) – Crowded passing the 1600 metres between HUSK (C Jones) which shifted in and CASSIO (Y Coonee) which shifted out. Apprentice Riders C Jones and Y Coonee were both reprimanded by Stewards and were referred to the National Riding Master N Harris for further tuition. Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p><b>HUSK</b> (C Jones)- Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p><b>R Simpson</b> (UNDER THE PUMP) - Reminded of his obligations in that he must not steady the pace to a degree that places riders in difficulty.</p> <p><b>ZINZAN</b> (O Bosson) – Crowded and checked 500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider O BOSSON advised that ZINZAN had been disadvantaged after receiving interference at the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>R Oliver</b> (SILVER NUGGET) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted SILVER NUGGET to shift out near the 500 metres when insufficiently clear of ZINZAN which was checked. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended R Oliver's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 30 September up to and including racing on 4 September, 3 National riding days.</p>	

**R Oliver** (SILVER NUGGET) – Issued with a warning after permitting SILVER NUGGET to shift out approaching the 200 metres when insufficiently clear of CUBA hich was hampered and forced wider on the track.

**CAN'T FIND ONE** (J Riddell) – When questioned regarding performance rider J Riddell could offer no excuse.
