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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	EVENTS TARANAKI MDN 1800M
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IRISH FLARE (L Hemi) - Became fractious in its gate being removed and after a veterinary examination was declared a late scratching at 12:03 pm. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

YULONG LANSON (S Macnab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

RUN ZIGGY RUN (J Parkes) – Slow away.

HIJACKED (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover.

RIBZZ (S Collett) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

ACE OF SPADES (C Burdan) – When questioned regarding the perceived improved performance, Trainer C Henderson advised that the mare had taken benefit from its run at Taupo on 13 September, further advising that ACE OF SPADES had worked well in the days leading up to this race.

Race 2	TE AO HONEY MDN 1300M
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SWEET KARMA (T Taiaroa) – Raced greenly early.

MARLEY (T Newman) – Had to be steadied near the 400 metres.

S O'Malley (LUCKY VIKING) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out near the 400 metres forcing MARLEY to be steadied to avoid heels.

ZOLA EXPRESS (J Parkes) – Steadied passing the 400 metres after improving on to heels.

Race 3	TARANAKI PINE MDN 1300M
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CHASING THE CROWN (S Macnab) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight with rider S Macnab being unable to ride the mare out to full advantage over the concluding stages.

INDY FOX (S O'Malley) – Steadied passing the 1100 metres after improving on to heels. Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres by ELEGANT CHARM which shifted out slightly.

ELEGANT CHARM (M Hudson) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be steadied passing the 1100 metres when placed in restricted room.

Race 4	REVITAL FERTILISERS 1600M
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ALBARON (S Macnab) – Slow to begin.

WAY ABOVE (K Asano) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CARDINAL O'CEIRIN (T Taiaroa) – Shifted out on jumping away after beginning awkwardly. Had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when improving on to the heels of TOUCH THE CLOUDS.

WINE N' DINE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

QUIZ KID (C Ormsby) – Raced keenly early and middle stages.

TOUCH THE CLOUDS (T Newman) – Raced keenly early and middle stages.

Race 5	ZED @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1200M
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IHU (K Asano) – Reared as the start was effected. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing or trialing next.

DESTINY ONE (S Macnab) – Slow to begin.

EMPRESS TZU HSI (D Hirini) – Clipped a heel and blundered after being crowded passing 1000 metres.

TELLYAWHAT (A Mudhoo) – Crowded passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied.

R Oliver (IMBLAZE) – Defended a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inward when not clear of TELLYAWHAT (A Mudhoo) which was dictated into the line of EMPRESS TSU HSI (D Hirini), which clipped a heel and blundered near the 1000 metres. After submissions the JCA found the charge proved with R Oliver having his licence suspended from riding in races from the conclusion of racing on 4 October up to and including racing on 10 October (4 national days).

Race 6	SEATON PARK 1400
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MEILA REI (J Parkes) – Eased back at the start from its wide draw.

DUBAI'S MOKO (S O'Malley) – Raced in restricted room passing the 600 metres to the outside of SKY HI RAHTWO (F Lazet) which shifted out slightly. F Lazet was advised to exercise care.

COOGA MOON (C Burdan) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7	NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 1400M
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LUPELANI (C Burdan) – Blundered at the start and then shifted out.

ROSEWOOD (D Bradley) – slow to begin.

LADIES FIRST (S O'Malley) – Began awkwardly.

DEMONETIZATION (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

CHERRY LANE (D Hirini) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1300 metres when runners either side shifted ground. Checked passing the 1100 metres.

CONOR O'CEIRIN (T Taiaroa) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1300 metres when runners either side shifted ground. Crowded passing the 1100 metres. Steadied when paced in restricted room when runners either side shifted ground approaching the 800 metres.

SPRING TIDE (L Hemi) – Crowded passing 1100 metres.

LONDON EXPRESS (H Schofer) – Steadied off heels when the pace eased passing 900 metres.

SWEET CLEMENTINE (S Macnab) – Steadied off heels when the pace eased passing 900 metres.

S Collett (SUPREME HEIGHTS) – Issued with a warning for the manner in which she eased the pace passing the 900 metres dropping back on to LONDON EXPRESS and SWEET CLEMENTINE, which both had to be steadied.

S Collett (SUPREME HEIGHTS) – Admitted a charge in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres crowding SPRING TIDE and CONOR O’CEIRIN on to CHERRY LANE, which was checked. After hearing submissions the JCA suspended of S Collett’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 3 October up to and including racing on 14 October (6 national days).

Race 8	NZB AIRFREIGHT ROADS TO THE JERICHO 3210M
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MONDORANI (K Asano) – Slow away.

JUNIOR (C Burdan) – Clipped a heel of THE POORMANZABEEL passing the 800 metres and blundered.

Race 9	NZB AIRFREIGHT CONSOLATION 3210M
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MEDINI (R Beemud) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MAGIC CANNON (T Newman) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

C Burdan (TWIN SPINNER) – Was issued with a warning for the manner in which she used her whip on a horse that was clearly winning.

Race 10	TWILIGHT FRIDAY RACES 23 OCTOBER 1800M
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COLLINSTREET (H Schofer) – Slow away. Forced over extra ground passing the 800 metres after VADAVAR (C Burdan) shifted out when not clear, C Burdan was advised to exercise care.

WILLIAM WALLACE (R Myers) – Slow away.

PLATINUM RAPPER (D Bradley) – Improved into restricted room passing the 400 metres having to be steadied for a distance.
