Race 1 WAHAROA INDUSTRIAL PARK 1600

PEERLESS WARRIOR (D Johnson) – Trainer R Manning advised Stewards, that upon return to the stable PEERLESS WARRIOR underwent an Endoscopic Examination which revealed no abnormalities.

R Manning further advised it is his intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

Race 4 ONE AGENCY MATAMATA 1400

LENNON (M Cameron) – Co-trainer A Forsman reported, LENNON pulled up sore the following day, with LENNON undergoing a veterinary examination which included X-rays, with the gelding showing no other abnormalities. A Forsman further advised the gelding has now been sent for a spell until Autumn.

Race 5 PAUL JONES CONTRACTING 1400

THE GREEN DRAGON (O Bosson) – Co-trainer P Gerard advised Stewards, she was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding and it is her intention to continue on with THE GREEN DRAGON'S current preparation.

Race 8 FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400

HOLA SENORITA (S Collett) – Trainer V Prendergast advised Stewards she was satisfied with the post-race condition of HOLA SENORITA, however, has now been sent for a spell until Autumn.

Race 10 J P WILLS BLOODSTOCK 2000

ZINZAN (O Bosson) – Trainer M Brooks reported, upon return to the stable the gelding underwent a Veterinary Examination which revealed a stress fracture to the near fore splint bone. ZINZAN will now be sent for a spell.

Race 5 VODAFONE 1400 METRES

SACROSANCT (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, will look at racing SACROSANCT on left-handed tracks.

Race 9 AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS 1200 METRES

MAISON ROXANNE (M Cameron) – Co-trainer J Ritchie reported the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of MAISON ROXANNE and advised it is their intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation, with her dropping back in distance at her next race day start.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PUNTER OF THE YEAR NOVEMBER 14 1200
HAPPY REMARK (S Collett) - Dislodged its rider during the preliminary, galloping for a distance before being recaptured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination, being late scratched at 12:24pm.	
SUPER PURSUIT (A Calder) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up until passing the 200 metres.	
LES CRAYERES (D Johnson) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.	
RAKUTEN (D Montes de Oca) - Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages before improving to lead approaching the 500 metres. Lay out when placed under pressure. Shifted out abruptly prior to the winning post inconveniencing SNAKEYE.	
PRINCE KANTO (R Elliot) – Contacted passing the 800 metres by RAKUTEN which shifted in slightly. Lay in when placed under pressure over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.	

SNAKEYE (R Simpson) - Inconvenienced prior to the winning post.

DIAMOND (M Cameron) - Unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

D Monte de Oca (RAKUTEN) – Was questioned regarding his decision to maintain a three wide position passing the 850 metres when there appeared to be an opportunity to ease his mount and obtain cover. D Montes de Oca explained that he believed he was unable to restrain the gelding at that stage of the race due to it racing keenly, however agreed with Stewards that a better attempt should have been made to obtain cover. D Montes de Oca was advised by Stewards that he would be expected to show better judgement in the future.

Race 2 | **MILLS REEF WINERY 1200**

MATTERHORN (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.

MISCONDUCT (J Kamaruddin) – Slow away. Steadied after improving on to heels approaching the 800 metres. Improved on to heels passing the 250 metres having to be firmly restrained by its rider and shifted out hampering ZUMA ROCK.

ITS SO EASY (J Fawcett) – Travelled wide without cover throughout.

ZUMA ROCK (S Collett) – Hampered passing the 200 metres.

QUEEN SARABI (D Johnson) – Held up for a distance passing the 100 metres.

Race 3 | **ZEST 1200**

CARLITO (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground. Held up entering the final straight.

ALI ARC (A Calder) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Improved on to heels approaching the 550 metres having to be steadied.

TAUPO MISSY (A Goindasamy) – Travelled three wide without cover throughout. Contacted for a distance passing the 350 metres.

AURORA DOLCE (S Weatherley) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

LORD ARDMORE (S Spratt) – Improved into a marginal run passing the 350 metres making contact with TAUPO MISSY for a distance.

SAINTE ELISABETH (M Hashizume) – Unable to obtain clear running over the final 100 metres.

FERDINAND (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and had not responded when placed under pressure in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be mildly shin sore in the right foreleg. Trainer C Chipperfield advised that he would be experimenting with gear changes prior to the gelding starting next.

Race 4 | **MATCO CIVIL CONTRACTORS 1300**

SAM'S SONG (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had hung throughout and in her opinion would be better suited to a step-up in distance and racing left handed.

WAIMOKU FALLS (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.

CATWALK GIRL (A Goindasamy) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1000 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight. Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

PRINCESS CATHARINA (A Calder) – Slow away.

EASY PEASY (J Fawcett) – Slow away.

KING OF THE ROAD (S Collett) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Made the bend near the 950 metres awkwardly.

MASTER OAKLEIGH (M Hashizume) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres to the inside of CATWALK GIRL which was racing ungenerously.

SHAKE THAT TUSH (M Cameron) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE BOOGEYMAN (D Danis) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight, and shifted out passing the 100 metres inconveniencing CATWALK GIRL.

Race 5

BETAVET 1600

LADY GWENDOLYN (C Grylls) – Slow away.

SHAM ON TOAST (M Hashizume) – Slow away.

SHOCKING PENNY (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover.

LEICALOT (L Satherley) – Held up until passing the 200 metres.

ALL THE RAGE (B May) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting wider.

CLEESE (T Thornton) – Shifted out approaching the winning post inconveniencing HESAGOODBOY.

HESAGOODBOY (T Yanagida) – Inconvenienced just prior to the winning post. Received veterinary attention post-race for a mild eye injury.

PLAYING THE FOOL (S Spratt) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding would be suited by some easing of the ground.

C Ormsby (WOODWIND) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6

TRITON PACIFIC OWENS PLATE

MR INCREDIBULL (D Johnson) – Slow away.

ANATOW (T Thornton) – Slow away. Lay out in the final straight with its rider unable to ride the gelding to full advantage. Shifted out when hanging passing the 100 metres hampering MISS VALENCIA.

MARBUZET (C Grylls) – Slow away.

MISS VALENCIA (T Yanagida) – Travelled wide without cover throughout. Hampered when weakening passing the 100 metres.

FELIX FAURE (R Simpson) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres.

C Ormsby (HE CAN SING) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

A Calder (AMBITIOUS SHOWGIRL) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out when not clear forcing ATLANTA GEORGIA and MISS VALENCIA outwards placing FELIX FAURE in restricted room which had to be steadied passing the 250 metres.

DUDEWITHATTITUDE (S Collett) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 | **GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1600**

BLUE ICE (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CLIQUE (D Johnson) – Slow away.

HAND OVER (B May) – Slow away. Shifted out to avoid heels passing the 900 metres, then was obliged to race four wide without cover for the remainder.

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (A Calder) – Slow away. Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 800 metres when the pace steadied.

GERI (D Danis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (C Ormsby) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight.

BEAUTY'S SECRET (T Thornton) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the outside of CLIQUE (D Johnson) which shifted out when not fully clear. D Johnson was advised to exercise care.

TWO MADISON (T Yanagida) – Rider dropped his whip passing the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **ULTIMATE MAZDA 1300**

LITTLE SHIRLEY (T Thornton) – Slow away. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

SO MUCH MOUR (J Fawcett) – Slow away.

VALETTI (C Burdan) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres and shifted out slightly hampering ZOULUMINOUS. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ZOULUMINOUS (J Kamaruddin) – Hampered near the 900 metres.

CRAFTYAFFAIR (C Jones) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TANGODANZER (S Weatherley) – Held up until approaching the 100 metres.

Race 9 | **BAYLEYS COUNTRY 1300**

KIWIANNA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

REIKO (D Johnson) – Slow away. Shifted out to avoid heels passing the 900 metres when racing keenly.

IMAREADY (S Spratt) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages, making the bend at the 900 metres awkwardly. Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

SAINT CROIX (C Burdan) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages, making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

MILITARY STEP (O Bosson) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres when racing keenly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

BLUETWENTYTWO (M Hashizume) – Checked passing the 900 metres after MILITARY STEP made the bend awkwardly.

LAURAMIA (C Jones) – Shifted in near the 900 metres making contact with BLUETWENTYTWO becoming momentarily unbalanced.

VICTORY GLORY (D Danis) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages, having to be steadied near the 900 metres when the pace eased.

MAKABAR (R Beemud) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 metres.

JUST RAJ (J Fawcett) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing IMAREADY passing the 100 metres.

S Spratt (IMAREADY) – Issued with a warning for the manner in which she eased the pace approaching the 900 metres causing interference to trailing runners.

The connections of the third placed IMAREADY viewed video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

CAPELLANI (B May) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

OUR CRAFTSMAN (S Collett) – Slow away.

MIDNITE INVASION (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

ZEDCREST (A Goindasamy) – Slow away.

RED JOHN (L Satherley) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1800 metres.

PRESTIGIOUS LAD (J Riddell) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 1700 metres and shifted out. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

S Spratt (OUR WONDERLAND) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
