SUPPLEMENTARY:

<u>Cambridge Jockey Club - 19 September 2020</u> R Oliver – Class A Rider R Oliver admitted a breach in that he failed to comply with a directive given by Stipendiary Stewards when riding work at the Cambridge Jockey Club on the morning of 19th September 2020 after being given an instruction not to do so until presenting a medical certificate for declaration of fitness. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the 10 th October up to and including racing on the 24 th October, 2 weeks, and also imposed a fine of \$1,000.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB READY TO RUN BREEZE UPS 12-13 OCTOBER 3YO
<p>ON DISPLAY (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Crowded for a distance passing the 1100 metres being hampered after making contact with the running rail.</p> <p>ALL BLACK BOURBON (D Johnson) - Crowded for a distance passing the 1100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Johnson advised the gelding would appreciate further easing of the ground and a step up in distance.</p> <p>LA ROMANEE (T Harris) - Hampered start losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance Rider T Harris advised that the gelding had been difficult to ride throughout the race. A veterinary examination found the gelding to have lost left front plate and as a consequence had punctured the sole of its hoof.</p> <p>ATISHU (S Spratt) - Crowded and checked passing the 1100 metres. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres when MEGA BOURBON (M McNab) shifted in under pressure. M McNab was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>C Grylls (TRUE BLESSING) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted TRUE BLESSING to shift in near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of ATISHU which was crowded and hampered and shifted in crowding ALL BLACK BOURBON and ON DISPLAY. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 4th October up to and including racing on Saturday 10th October, 4 national riding days.</p>	
Race 2	WEBSITE ANGELS 2100
<p>FINAL SUGGESTION (D Johnson) - Contacted 400 metres by VADAVAR which was looking to obtain clear running.</p> <p>VADAVAR (M Cameron) - Held up for clear running until near the 250 metres.</p>	
Race 3	BCD GROUP 2100
<p>YATIMA (C Burdan) - Crowded and steadied shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>NOT USUAL GLORIOUS (M McNab) – Slow away.</p> <p>TRANSFORMER (C Jones) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.</p> <p>BAK DA MASTER (J Kamaruddin) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>RIP EM UP (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Johnson advised that she will be recommending gear changes.</p> <p>WORDSWORTH (L Innes) - Was not persevered with from near the 300 metres. L Innes advised that the gelding had been reluctant to hit out with Wordsworth undergoing a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 4	HAPPY 50TH BIRTHDAY LONEE MUNRO 1400
<p>SONOFABUTCHER (C Burdan) - Slow away.</p> <p>VIKTOR VEGAS (A Goindasamy) - Slow away. Was coughing following the race and underwent a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which found dirt in the trachea.</p>	

CHURCH ROAD (M McNab) - Raced in restricted room for a distance in the early stages.

SECRET SQUIRREL (S Weatherley) - Raced in restricted room to the inside of CHURCH ROAD (M McNab) for a distance in the early stages then having to be further restrained off heels passing the 900 metres. M McNab was advised that he must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

PARISIAN (D Danis) - Steadied away from heels when awkwardly placed near the 900 metres.

BOUNDTOBEHONORED (S Spratt) – Raced in restricted room and steadied passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed to the inside of PARISIAN which had improved into a marginal run to the inside of CHURCH ROAD which shifted in slightly.

OSAKA (D Johnson) – Lost the near fore plate during the running.

Race 5 | **LODGE XMAS RACEDAY 19/12 3YO**

GEE CEE (S Spratt) - Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier and then was restrained to obtain cover, losing ground. When questioned regarding performance Rider S Spratt advised that the colt had got further back than intended from a wide barrier but had run on fairly in the home straight.

HIGHLAND WHISPER (T Yanagida) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MILFORD (T Harris) - Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 350 metres inconveniencing ROYCE ROCA which was forced wider on the track.

ROYCE ROCA (A Goindasamy) - Inconvenienced 350 metres and forced wider.

NO LIMITS (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

Race 6 | **SKYCITY HAMILTON 1200**

SHOWROSES (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance Rider D Johnson reported the mare had hung throughout and had been difficult to ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be lame in the right hind leg. A veterinary certificate of fitness is required for the mare before racing next.

JUSTACANTA (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

COVENTINA BAY (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 150 metres.

AIR CENTRE (S Weatherley) - Restrained from a wide barrier. When questioned regarding the performance Rider S Weatherley advised the gelding would prefer more rain affected footing.

Race 7 | **TE AKAU 2019/20 NO. 1 STABLE 1200**

STYLISH SUGGESTION (D Johnson) – Lost both front plates during the running.

THUNDER (M Kareem) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres becoming awkwardly placed shifting back on to BARNEY RUBBLE which was hampered.

THUNDER BAY (S Weatherley) - Slow away.

BARNEY RUBBLE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Hampered 900 metres.

BAD 'N' BOUJ (T Yanagida) - Raced in restricted room approaching the 400 metres.	
Race 8	VALACHI DOWNS MILE
<p>TIPTRONIC (C Ormsby) – Became awkwardly placed inside heels approaching the 1200 metres then over-raced for a distance. Could not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>VEE CECE (M Cameron) – Slow away.</p> <p>INSCRIPTION (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>GUILLADA (S Weatherley) - Slow away.</p> <p>SHERRIF (L Innes) - Crowded and hampered approaching the 1200 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of TIPTRONIC (C Ormsby) which had commenced to over race after becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of TE AKAU CALIBURN which was being restrained. After considering the incident Stewards took no further action other than advising C Ormsby to exercise more care when in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>FISCAL FANTASY (J Riddell) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>NASHA RIVA (C Grylls) - Over race for a distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>DEZELLA (S Collett) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>FINBARR (S Spratt) - Over-raced in the middle stages.</p>	
Race 9	SARTEN MEMORIAL RACEDAY 24/10 MILE
<p>HEAR MY VOICE (S Collett) – Slow away.</p> <p>SHELOB (E McCall) - Slow away.</p> <p>PLUSHENKO (M Hashizume) - Slow away.</p> <p>JACK THE LASS (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly making contact.</p> <p>EL NYMPH (M McNab) - Crowded start. Held entering the final straight and again held up for a distance passing the 300 metres. Shifted out approaching the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>WHEAO (R Simpson) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>SNOWDEEL (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Cameron advised that he had attempted to ride the mare quietly which had not proven beneficial. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have a mild dry cough consistent with having ingested dirt.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (FRIDAY WOOLFE) - Reminded of his obligation concerning whip use.</p>
