 Race 1
 HASTINGS - HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY 2100 (2100 Metres)

 PIPING HOT (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

 YOSSARIAN (H Schofer) - Began awkwardly then further hampered when crowded, steadied when placed in restricted room near the 600 metres, held up rounding the turn approaching the 400 metres having to be checked when improving onto the heels of ROCK WITH CHOUX and continuing to be held up early in the straight.

 BEAR GRYLS (A Goindasamy) - Crowded after the start, hampered passing the 1600 metres, raced wide without cover

ESTEFANIA (J Bassett) - Made the first turn awkwardly passing the winning post on the first occasion making contact with REX ROYALE, then shifting outwards approaching the 1600 metres hampering BEAR GRYLS. When being corrected, shifted back into the line of GALLARDO which had to be steadied.

REX ROYALE (L Hemi) - Contacted passing the winning post on the first occasion.

GALLARDO (R Myers) - Steadied passing the 1600 metres.

CLASS ABOVE (R Elliot) - Had to be steadied when crowded for room near the 1600 metres to the inside of GALLARDO which shifted inwards when being steadied to avoid the heels of ESTEFANIA.

BRASSY BOY (M McNab) - Gave ground from the 800 metres quickly becoming tailed off and was not persevered with. Rider M McNab advised that the gelding had commenced to hang and was not comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FISHERMANS BLUES (S O'Malley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

D DANIS (PIPING HOT) - Issued with a warning under [Rule 638(1)(d)] after allowing his mount to shift inwards passing the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of FISHERMANS BLUES which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room.

ROCK WITH CHOUX (T Thornton) - Badly unbalanced when contacted after being placed in restricted room to the inside of MALIK which lay inwards near the 400 metres before being immediately corrected by its rider.

MALIK (J Riddell) - Was found to have bled from both nostrils and is now subject to the mandatory stand down periods.

KING FAROUK (J Parkes) - Slow away, raced wide throughout.		

ARANICA (A Goindasamy) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

ALPHA CHARLIE (L Innes) - Raced three wide without cover.

FREE THYME (J Bassett) - Held up early in the straight.

Race 3 VILLA MARIA GIMBLETT GRAVELS 1400 (1400 Metres)

SHADY GREY (H Schofer) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after becoming factitious in its barrier, crowded near the 1100 metres.

CINZENTO (J Riddell) - Slow away.

ROCKONEVE (S O, Malley) - Slow away, held up passing the 200 metres until near the 100 metres.

GUS THE MAVERICK (C Ormbsy) - Crowded near the 1300 metres and then was inclined to over-race into the middle stages.

SPIDERMAN (O Bosson) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 1200 metres before shifting inwards crowding SHADY GREY near the 1100 metres. O Bosson was advised to exercise greater care.

TUPPENCE (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover.

CRUZ RAMIREZ (R Myers) - Disappointed for a run to the inside of MARRONI having to be steadied near the 200 metres, then shifted outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

MATT CAIN (S Collett) - Contacted short of the finish when MARRONI lay out under pressure. Prior to the authorisation of dividends rider S Collett viewed stewards film footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 4LIVAMOL OPTIMISER 1400 (1400 Metres)LINCOLN HILLS (L Hemi) - Held up early in the straight

BLUE ON BLACK (T Thornton) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding was outpaced today when resuming and will be better suited when stepped up over more ground. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 THREE WISE BIRDS 1200 (1200 Metres)

FESTIVITY (D Johnson) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection being cleared to run after contacting the front of the gates forcing its way out before being quickly brought under control by its rider.

LANGKAWI (S Collett) - Slow away.

MERCY HILL (S Weatherley) - Slow away.

ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL (T Thornton) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 900 metres, shifting outwards to avoid the heels of PETRACHOR going into the bend near the 800 metres forcing SERENA to a three wide position.

SERENA (L Hemi) - Raced three wide from the 800 metres.

PETRACHOR (A Goindasamy) - Steadied away from the heels of ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL near the 600 metres.

PINULTIMATE (T Harris) - Was attended to post-race by the on-course veterinarian and found to have had a poor recovery with respiratory thumps being diagnosed.

Race 6 LI REDSHAW MEMORIAL (1200 Metres)

HYPNOS (D Johnson) - Slow away, held up until near the 250 metres.

MELT (L Innes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare was unable to finish the race off after being caught wide and would appreciate some easing of the ground. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

LONDON BOUND (M Cameron) - Made the bend awkwardly at the 850 metres when racing ungenerously.

SHEEZALLMINE (M McNab) - Held up for a distance entering the final straight.

Race 7 DUNDEEL AT ARROWFIELD HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS (1400 Metres)

GENTLEMAN JACK (R Myers) - Knuckled on jumping away, hampered near the 1300 metres.

LAPEL (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly, held up for a short distance entering the straight.

SCREAMIN EAGLE (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly then further hampered when crowded shortly after the start losing ground, steadied near the 1000 metres.

AEGON (L Innes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

VISHAKHA (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

SUFFUSED (M Cameron) - Raced greenly crossing the junction onto the course proper near the 1300 metres hampering GENTLEMAN JACK, GRAND GESTURE and BOURBONAIRE.

GRAND GESTURE (M McNab) - Hampered near the 1300 metres, raced in restricted room to the inside of BOURBONAIRE which lay in near the 100 metres.

BOURBONAIRE (D Johnson) - Hampered near the 1300 metres, raced ungenerously when being steadied away from the heels of GRAND GESTURE near the 1000 metres.

KOBE ROCKS (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover, inclined to over-race in the middle stages, lay in and away from NEED I SAY MORE early in the straight.

NEED I SAY MORE (T Harris) - Raced wide throughout.

MOANA (S Weatherley) - Held up entering the straight and continued to be badly held up until shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres.

S Collett (AUTOBAHN) - Spoken to regarding her whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

T Harris (NEED I SAY MORE) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$600 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 8 FASTTRACK INSURANCE (2000 Metres)

HUNTA PENCE (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly.

RED SIERRA (R Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider reported that the mare would be better suited by some easing of the ground.

R Elliot (BEAUDEN) - Spoken to regarding his whip action.

Race 9 WINDSOR PARK PLATE (1600 Metres)

PRISE DE FER (O Bosson) - Slow to begin.

VANCOOGA (S Weatherley) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

PINMEDOWN (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly.

AVANTAGE (D Johnson) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

JENNIFER ECCLES (M Cameron) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages, contacted 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any significant abnormality with a minor laceration to the right hind pastern.

LOIRE (M McNab) - Made contact with JENNIFER ECCLES when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

TWO ILLICIT (L Innes) - Made contact with GERMANICUS near the 200 metres.

GERMANICUS (C Ormsby) - Contacted near the 200 metres.

Race 10 VANBURGH AT WINDSOR PARK STUD 1600 (1600 Metres)

PENNY ROYALE (J Bassett) - Slow to begin, held up entering the straight before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (R Eliot) - Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start.

IRON EAGLE (D Danis) - Got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained to avoid the heels of RED BEACH (M Cameron) which shifted inwards when not fully clear near the 1400 metres. M Cameron was advised to exercise more care.

TIMES TICKING (O Bosson) - Raced wide rounding the first bend.

PEP TORQUE (H Schofer) - Raced wide throughout.

O Bosson (TIMES TICKING) - Spoken to regarding his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.
