RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JOCK HARRIS MEMORIAL (2100 Metres)
L Latta (JENEVER) – Admitted a breach of Rule 534(1) in that she failed to scratch her runner JENEVER by the required time and was fined \$250.	
DE SILVER LINING (C Burdan) - Shifted outwards at the start tightening PIRI PIRI PETE which settled back.	

PIRI PIRI PETE (S O'Malley) - Tightened start, settled back.

FLYING HABIT (L Hemi) - Over-raced in the early stages.

SWIFT (M Sanson), **FLYING HABIT** (L Hemi) and **NELLIE JEAN** (S Macnab) were tightened going into the first turn when there was simultaneous movement from **DE SILVER LINING** (C Burdan) which shifted outwards and **GOLDIE'S REVENGE** (E McCall) which shifted in when not the required distance clear. E McCall was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the riding master and issued with a warning.

YULONG LANSON (T Thornton) was steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of **SHACKELTON'S EDGE** at the crossing near the 1600 metres. Also hampered was **DUNDEE STREET**, which had to steady off the heels of **YULONG LANSON**. Following the running, T Thornton approached stewards and advised that this section of the rail over the crossing near the 1600 metres needed adjusting which was carried out prior to the running of Race 2.

DUNDEE STREET (R Bishop) – Steadied off heels 1600 metres.

The rider of **YULONG LANSON**, T Thornton, dropped her whip near the 150 metres.

Race 2 | **LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES (2100 Metres)**

ZENA BELLA – C Burdan replaced C Dell. Began awkwardly and then tightened and got back when runners either side shifted ground. Over-raced early and had to be steadied off heels for some distance near the 1600 metres. C Burdan reported the gelding hung throughout.

WOTABLAST (D Hirini) - Slow away. Commenced to over-race approaching the winning post on the first occasion, having to shift outwards to avoid heels and continuing to over race in the middle stages.

TROSETTE (S Macnab) - Raced fiercely in the early stages and skied its head for some distance when being restrained into the first turn. Had to check off the heels of **CLASSCLOWN** passing the winning post on the first round when continuing to over-race. Made the first bend awkwardly.

MY JIMMY POCKET (M Hudson) - Made the first bend awkwardly and shifted wide.

GREAT NORTH ROAD (H Schofer) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MATARO (T Thornton) - Raced wide throughout.

Race 3 | **TONY PEETI ENGINEERING LTD (2100 Metres)**

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly and shifted out bumping **FLORAL ART**.

FLORAL ART (H Schofer) – Bumped start. Over-raced early.

JUMP FOR JOY (S Macnab) - Dictated wide at the start.

PERRY MASON (M Sanson) - Held up behind a tiring runner approaching the final turn.

RODOLFO (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 | **GRAHAM MOTT RUAHINE CONTRACTORS (1200 Metres)**

REGAL RIPA (L Hemi) - Late scratching at 2.43pm after refusing to load. Connections were advised that **REGAL RIPA** must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to its next start.

BATOUTAHELL (J Riddell) – Commenced to buck shortly after the start losing ground. Had to steady near the 150 metres when GLIDE QUEEN shifted out, and was not persevered with over the final stages. When questioned J Riddell advised that after racing erratically early and being hampered near the 150 metres the gelding was not persevered with. Connections were advised that BATOUTAHELL must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to its next start.

GLIDE QUEEN (S Macnab) – Shifted out 150 metres.

ARKLOW (T Thornton) - Over-raced in the back straight. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FIDDYAFORTNIGHT (A Goindasamy) - Had to steady off heels near the 800 metres when over-racing and went back on to GLIDE QUEEN which had to steady and shift ground outwards to avoid that runner's heels and when doing so took BOLD IRIS over extra ground.

BOLD IRIS (C Burdan) – Taken over extra ground 800 metres.

TAMAHINE (L Satherley) – Shied at the winning post.

Race 5	GREEN BELT TRUST (1300 Metres)

RUIE'S CRUMPET (L Satherley) – Underwent and passed a veterinary examination prior to the start after making contact with a gate in the enclosure. Over-raced throughout. When questioned L Satherley advised the mare hung throughout when over-racing.

FLYING SURF (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly. Had to be steadied into the first corner and shifted out simultaneously as POWER 'N' PASSION was improving to its inside resulting in POWER 'N' PASSION making the bend near the 800 metres wide.

RUFUS RUFFCUT (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly and got back.

EMPRESS TZU HSI (A Mudhoo) - Slow away.

HYDROEXPRESS (S Macnab) - Hung inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened by the rider near the 150 metres. A short distance further, HYDROEXPRESS shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip into the line of STREAK OF POWER which was attempting to improve to its inside, resulting in STREAK OF POWER having to check.

STREAK OF POWER (L Hemi) – Checked 150 metres.

S Macnab (HYDROEXPRESS) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she permitted her mount to shift in near the 150 metres when not clear of STREAK OF POWER, which was checked. After submission S Macnab had her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 10 October 2020 up to and including racing on Saturday, 17 October (4 national days).

L Hemi (STREAK OF POWER) – Dropped her whip near the 200 metres.

GAELIC SPIRIT (H Schofer) – Dislodged rider in the preliminary. H Schofer was examined by paramedics and cleared to ride. Held up until inside the final 200 metres.

KALUANUI (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly and was then further hampered and got back when there was simultaneous movement from runners either side.

LLANACORD (L Hemi) - Slow away. Held up early in the home straight and had to shift ground over the final stages when in restricted room.

HAKA BOOGIE (A Goindasamy) - Held up early in the home straight and raced in restricted room for the remainder.

BRADMAN (D Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover.

NO ROCK NO POP (D Hirini) – Jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages and hung outwards, running off rounding the bend, losing all chance. Connections were advised the filly must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to its next start.

Race 7 | **CENTRAL WOOL TRANSPORT (1400 Metres)**

The start of this race was approximately 10 minutes late.

CHASE (L Hemi) – Late scratched by the veterinary surgeon at 4.27pm after being kicked at the start.

CHILLAX 'N' CHASE (A Goindasamy) - Late scratched at 4.32pm after the rider was dislodged at the barriers suffering a minor shoulder injury, standing down from his remaining ride.

OHITI LASS (R Bishop) - Shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres, forcing LINCOLN TOWN over extra ground.

LINCOLN TOWN (J Riddell) – Forced over extra ground near the 200 metres.

PABLO ESK (H Schofer) - Shifted wide near the 700 metres when ROSE OF DELGATIE was angled out.

MOZZIE (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 | **DAVID & ELLEN OLIVER MILE (1600 Metres)**

MITCHELL - L Satherley replaced A Goindasamy as there was no apprentice rider available.

VEDETTE ROUGE (H Schofer) – Slow away.

GRAND PROSPECT (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

PRINCE LEO (R Bishop) - Raced greenly in the home straight.
