Race 3 - ILT Foundation Handicap 1600 Metres

Trainer B Tapper reported to stewards he was happy with the recovery of FRIDAY KNIGHT after the disappointing effort, advising that the gelding would carry on in its current campaign.

Trainer R Dennis advised stewards that PETITE ROSE after a very disappointing effort in this race has been retired as a racing proposition from his stable.

Race 1	TEMUKA TRANSPORT 1967 LTD MAIDEN SPRINT (1200m)	
SERGEANT PEPPER (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.		

IRON BRAVO (D Bothamley) – Shifted outwards on jumping.

ORAKA PLAYBOY (R Cuneen) – Crowded on jumping, steadied passing the 1050 metres when improving onto heels at this point.

NYMPHADORA TONKS (B Murray) – Shifted outwards on jumping making firm contact with ROSE DE GRANVLLE and losing ground.

ROSE DE GRANVILLE (J Laking) – Bumped and crowded at the start, held up for a distance passing the 200 metres.

O'REILLY MCLUKE (K Chowdhoory) – Bumped from the inside shortly after the start becoming unbalanced, dictated inwards when crowded passing the 1100 metres, lay in early in the run home having to be straightened by its rider on a number of occasions.

TENNESSEE ROCK (R Beeharry) – Shifted inwards passing the 1100 metres dictating O'REILLY MCLUKE inwards checking KING RAT which had to be severely restrained.

R Beeharry admitted a charge of careless riding passing the 1100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 8 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 16 October up to and including 28 October.

KING RAT (T Moseley) – Crowded and checked having to be severely restrained passing the 1100 metres.

VAGUE (G Jogoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SWEET DREAMS (S Wynne) – Raced wide throughout.

MERITORIOUS (C Barnes) – Held up early in the run home then raced in restricted room through the middle stages.

Race 2 TEMUKA HOTEL & IVAN WATT MAIDEN (1200m)

SAVANNAH GOLD (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly, lay outwards rounding the final bend.

KITCHENER (K Asano) – Shifted outwards on jumping crowding WILD LIKE, raced wide without cover into the first bend, accidentally struck in the head with the whip near the 250 metres then lay inwards passing the 150 metres crowding RESUSCITATE which had to be steadied.

WILD LIKE (K Chowdhoory) – Crowded on jumping.

SHINING BRIGHT (T Moseley) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

EMMA'S CHANCE (L Callaway) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

RESUSCITATE (G Jogoo) – Over raced in the early stages and made the bend near the 950 metres awkwardly, continued to race keenly and had to be severely restrained off heels passing the 650 metres, crowded and steadied passing the 150 metres.

OPHELIA ROSE (R Beeharry) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages. When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance trainer S Clark advised that the mare had been aided by a better draw today and a positive ride on the pace.

AUTHENTIC CHARM (J Laking) – Briefly placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres when SCALA SANCTA was dictated inwards by IZZY HOUDINI (R Cuneen) before being corrected by its rider. R Cuneen was advised to exercise greater care. Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 250 metres, inconvenienced in the shadows of the post having to be briefly steadied.

EASY ON THE EYE (D Prastiyou) – Had to be steadied when racing keenly passing the 1100 metres.

DANCING IN THE SKY (S Macnab) which returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils underwent a veterinary examination including an endoscopy which revealed the mare to be a bleeder and accordingly subject to the

mandatory stand down periods.

Race 3 ONCEUPONATIME AT BELMONT PARK MAIDEN 1200 (1200m)

DA VINCI GIRL (M Gestain) was late scratched at 12.51 pm on veterinary advice after making contact with the fence in the birdcage before escaping riderless.

TWIN SHOT (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly, made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres shifting out hampering outside runners.

SUPREME KHAN (D Johnson) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

FLORENTIA (K Asano) – Slow to begin.

CARDBOARD GANGSTER (J Laking) – Slow to begin.

KOPUTAROA (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room and made the bend awkwardly near the 950 metres shifting out inconveniencing DIORADELLE and SILVER CANNON, was reported by its rider to have raced greenly throughout the running.

SILVER CANNON (S Macnab) – Hampered near the 950 metres, placed in restricted room and bumped from the inside having to be steadied passing the 800 metres when TWIN SHOT lay out when making the bend awkwardly.

DIORADELLE (C Campbell) – Hampered and forced wider on the track near the 950 metres and then obliged to race wide without cover from this point.

SOOO DUSTY (S Wynne) – Shifted inwards at the start, then raced 3 wide early stages and bumped from the inside having to steady passing the 800 metres.

Race 4 JOHN WALSH DASH (1200m)

REDFORD (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin, improved onto heels of a tiring runner passing the 250 metres having to steady and change ground passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

CAN'T SAY ENOUGH (S Toolooa) – Crowded at the start losing ground, raced three wide without cover throughout.

FIRE KATYUSHA (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly, raced wide without cover throughout.

JUST TICKETY BOO (K Kwo) – Had to be steadied away from the heels of RIPA RUBY which was being steadied near the 550 metres.

DECEPTIO VISUS (J Laking) – Held up rounding the final bend and in the early stages of the run home having to shift ground outwards passing the 300 metres to find clear racing.

PONIARD (C Campbell) – Lay inwards passing the 200 metres when placed under pressure.

MEDITERRANEAN STAR (D Johnson) – Reported by the trainer to have received superficial lacerations to both hind legs and lost a rear racing plate in the running.

NOT USUAL LITENING (K Mudhoo) – Steadied near the 950 metres when improving quickly onto the heels of MEDITERRANEAN STAR

Race 5 SOUTHFUELS LIMITED SPRINT (1200m)

SOLOMON (Y Chew) – Began very awkwardly throwing its head in the air for several strides losing considerable ground. Apprentice rider Y Chew was shown replays of this incident with the apprentice jockey mentor and advised he is expected to make a better effort.

DEVIOUS (D Bothamley) – Crowded shortly after the start, raced wide from the 700 metres, inconvenienced final bend.

MAMMA SANS (BB Hong) – Raced wide without cover in the early to middle stages.

LOUIE LOUIE (K Asano) - Raced wide throughout, hung outwards badly rounding the final bend inconveniencing DEVIOUS

and continued to lay out throughout the run home not being able to be ridden out to full advantage. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the gelding's racing manners.

BENEFICIAL (J Laking) – Briefly held up passing the 100 metres having to steady and shift ground outwards passing the 50 metres.

Race 6 SUPREME EQUINE FEEDS & NIGHT N DAY PARK MAIDEN (1600m)

LEITRIM LAD (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

PARKVIEW (Y Chew) – Slow to begin.

TURN YOUR EYES (T Comignaghi) – Restrained on jumping to obtain cover from a wide draw, held up passing the 200 metres and had to be steadied to avoid heels near the 150 metres.

DANNY GREEN (D Johnson) – Raced keenly though the early and middle stages when sitting outside the leader, crowded and checked near the 150 metres when tiring. When questioned the rider reported the gelding had pulled throughout the running and when placed under pressure had little left to offer.

TANTALEE (Z Bholah) – Raced wide throughout.

JACK THE RIPPER (T Moseley) – Shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

T Moseley (JACK THE RIPPER) admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards over the concluding stages dictating SUNNY LADY inwards onto DANNY GREEN and in turn onto VAN HALEN inwards onto LITTLE JOHN with these runners all being buffeted and unbalanced. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended T Moseley's licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 9 October up to and including 21 October.

SUNNY LADY (R Cuneen) - Dictated inwards and crowded near the 150 metres.

VAN HALEN (R Mudhoo) – Crowded and checked near the 150 metres.

CHITTER CHAT (R Beeharry) – Held up from the 200 metres and had to be steadied near the 100 metres.

LITTLE JOHN (D Bothamley) – Buffeted and steadied near the 150 metres.

Race 7 GERALDINE VILLAGE INN SPORTS BAR MILE (1600m)

SWEET OAK (BB Hong) – Began awkwardly striking the side of the barrier with the rider becoming unbalanced for a short distance and losing considerable ground, had to be steadied passing the 1200 metres when improving into a run that had not fully developed when over racing.

MISS OAKS (K Asano) – Slow to begin, held up in the early stages of the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

SENOR MOSS (A Balloo) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages and wide throughout.

VAN DIAMOND (T Comignaghi) – Over raced having to be steadied away from heels near the 1300 metres and then raced four wide for the majority of the race.

FULL FURY (Y Chew) – Raced wide from the 1300 metres, raced four wide without cover through the middle stages.

ST ANDRE (K Chowdhoory) – When asked to comment on the improved performance co-trainer Michael Pitman advised that the horse had been working well and was at a loss to explain the poor performance at the previous start.

Race 8 DAVE GRANT & NEIL KINGSTON MAIDEN 1600 (1600m)

TAPPY'S LAD (S Toolooa) – Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover at the start, lay out throughout the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage over the concluding stages.

GINGERRIFIC (G Jogoo) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

AJAY LINCOLN (C Barnes) - Raced wide in the early stages.

KRISTOFFERSON (D Prastiyou) – Made the first bend awkwardly and when briefly crowded for room by runners to the outside shifted out abruptly near the 1300 metres. After viewing films which were inconclusive and interviewing riders, blame could not be apportioned to any one rider, with D Prastiyou advising his horse had over-reacted when briefly placed in restricted room.

REPULSE (R Mudhoo) – Crowded and raced in restricted room when racing into the first bend near the 1300 metres. Rider dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.

SHELBY DEVINE (R Beeharry) – Had to be restrained passing the 1250 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KRISTOFFERSON.

NIFTY (A Balloo) – Raced wide throughout.

LAST HORRAH (B Murray) – Improved wide from the 700 metres.

NOT USUAL WINGS (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room early in the run home when AJAY LINCOLN shifted in momentarily under pressure before being straightened by its rider.

KLASSIC ZED (R Cuneen) – Placed in restricted room when tiring passing the 200 metres when QIJI OLYMPIA had to be steadied away from the heels of NOT USUAL WINGS which was shifted in slightly by AJAY LINCOLN (C Barnes) which shifted in under pressure. C Barnes was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 9 ALL ASPECTS PAINTING & DECORATING HDCP (1600m)

L Callaway (TAPONISME) admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$100.

TAPONISME (B Murray) underwent a veterinary inspection and was cleared to race after dislodging its rider during the preliminary and escaping riderless for a short distance before being quickly recaptured. B Murray was attended to by St John Paramedics and passed fit to continue with his riding engagements. Crowded shortly after the start losing ground,

ARE YOU CEREAL (T Jonker) – The outside portion of the gate made contact with the horse on jumping with the connections advising the gelding had suffered a superficial abrasion above the eye.

PICKUP (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

TAKEITLIKEAMAN (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

ALBUT ME (S Toolooa) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SUCCOSO SEGRETO (S Wynne) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

REMINGTON (R Mudhoo) – Blundered briefly passing the 450 metres.

STRAD (K Chowdhoory) – Rider lost his whip passing the 400 metres.

HOLY LOCH (C Barnes) – Briefly held up passing the 100 metres before shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running.

Race 10 TEMUKA SEED (1984) LTD & THE HANLEY FORMULA 2200 (2200m)

SLAMMER (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

HILLERSDEN (K Asano) – Made the first bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track.

QUEEN SWEEP (S Toolooa) – Raced wide in the early stages.

GREEN DISPATCH (D Bothamley) – Raced keenly shortly after the start and then wide in the early and middle stages before being taken forward to sit outside the rider and continued to race keenly through to the middle stages. When asked to

comment on performance, rider advised he had been trapped wide through the early and middle stages and in his opinion the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

DR VELOCIOUS (Y Chew) – Placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when QUEEN SWEEP (S Toolooa) shifted in when not fully clear. S Toolooa was advised to exercise greater care.

HUNUA HANK (K Williams) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

SULCIFERA (K Chowdhoory) – Held up early in the run home.

B Murray (ZAREEBA) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

OCEANS AWAY (S Macnab) – When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, trainer P Harris advised that the gelding had been working well and combined with a change of gear and positive ride the improvement was not unexpected.

Race 11 CSI OWNERS, TRAINERS & COUPLAND'S STOCKFEEDS MAIDEN (2200m)

WHERO (D Bothamley) – Fractious in the barriers.

MAN OH MAN (R Beeharry) – Raced wide in the early stages.

MAZZONI (k Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin, crowded and had to steady passing the 300 metres.

DAME DU JOUR (S Macnab) – Raced wide in the early stages.

BURT THE SQUIRT (Y Chew) – Gave ground from the 1300 metres and was not persevered with. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards to follow up in subsequent days.

MR FAHRENHEIT (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

MAGIE NOIRE (R Mudhoo) – Shifted ground inwards dictating WHERO inwards onto MAZZONI which was briefly crowded having to steady passing the 300 metres. R Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

BETATHEDEVILUNO (C Barnes) – When asked to comment on the improved performance, trainer P Harris advised that the mare had appreciated the step up in distance and change in gear. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils BETATHEDEVILUNO underwent a post-race veterinary examination including endoscopy which revealed the mare **not** to be a bleeder.
