RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Bay Ford NZ Punter Of The Year 2100
YOSSARIAN (H Schofer) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after rearing over in the parade ring being cleared to start, slow away.	
VEDO ROSSO (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin, crowded near the 1700 metres.	

OVERSTAYER (D Johnson) - Crowded near the 1700 metres.

RIPCORD (O Bosson) - Crowded near the 1700 metres, had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight and was unable to be ridden out fully over the final 100 metres. Rider O Bosson reported that the gelding had not felt comfortable on today's slow conditions.

OUR BEESKEES (C Ormsby) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

C Ormsby (OUR BEESKEES) - Was issued with a warning after he allowed his mount to shift inwards crowding **OVERSTAYER** onto **RIPCORD** which was forced into the line of **VEDO ROSSO** near the 1700 metres.

ESTEFANIA (J Bassett) - Over-raced in the early stages.

RESOLUTION (J Riddell) - Over-raced in the early stages and when being restrained near the 1700 metres hampered **DELLE QUARTZA**.

DELLE QUARTZA (L Hemi) - Hampered near the 1700 metres, steadied when placed in restricted room near the 100 metres.

MARBUZET (T Thornton) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

LA CASA (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the gelding had come to the end of its current preparation with Trainer T Pike confirming that the gelding would now be spelled.

J Parkes (CAPELLANI) - Issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2	Stella Artois 2200

OBRIGADO (S O'Malley) - Slow away, raced wide without cover after improving forward from the 1200 metres, hampered near the 150 metres when **THE BUZZ** lay in under pressure.

MONDORANI (R Elliot) - Slow away.

ONE OF THE BEST (J Parkes) - Hung outwards rounding the final bend continuing to do so in the straight and as a result was unable to be ridden out fully. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

VITTACHI (T Thornton) - Contacted near the 150 metres and again passing the 100 metres when **KAMANDA LINCOLN** shifted out under pressure.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (S Collett) - Shifted out under pressure making contact near the 150 metres and again passing the 100 metres.

MISHKA (C Grylls) - Required veterinary treatment following the race and was found to have suffered a suspensory injury to the left foreleg. Co-Trainer D Brown was advised that a veterinary clearance will be required prior to next racing.

Race 3	Hastings - Heart Of Hawke's Bay 1400

Approximately fifteen minutes prior to the race it was brought to the attention of the Stewards by a club official that horses **MAZABEEL** and **RANGER** may have been allotted incorrect weights under the conditions of this set weight race. It was then verified that both these horses should have been allocated 59kg rather than the 58kg advertised. After the Stewards had determined that the weights should be corrected accordingly trainer T Pike requested a ruling from the Judicial Committee who ruled that the weights for the two runners should remain at 58kgs. As a result the race ran 15 minutes late.

KING FAROUK (H Schofer) - Slow to begin.	
NEDWIN (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly.	
MAKZABEEL (L Innes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
FIDDYAFORTNIGHT (C Grylls) - Held up early in the home straight.	
SASKATCHEWAN (D Hirini) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.	
Race 4	Tumu ITM 1400
This race was officially put back 5 minutes following the delay to Race 3.	
RUBY NEGRONI (D Hirini) - Crowded leaving the barriers.	
PARISIAN (S Collett) - Raced three wide without cover.	
BAD 'N' BOUJ (C Grylls) - Raced wide throughout.	
HYDROEXPRESS (S O'Malley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running over the final 250 metres.	
EMPIRE OF PATCH (L Hemi) - Hampered near the 150 metres when BAD 'N BOUJ lay in away from WILD WEST.	
KELLYS INSPIRATION (S Weatherley) - Held up near the 300 metres having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.	
MAGNESS (D Bradley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the straight.	
Race 5	NZB RTR Trainers Series 3YO 1300
WHITE LIGHTNING (T Thornton) - Restrained early from its wide barrier, had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.	
OPALESCENCE (D Bradley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
DE LA TERRE (R Elliot) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1000 metres.	
Race 6	Dan D'Esposito Memorial Mile
HUNTA PENCE (D Hirini) - Three wide without cover throughout.	
S Weatherley (TIMES TICKING) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
Race 7	Mardigras Events 1200
LINCOLN RAIDER (H Schofer) - Slow away (5 lengths). Connections were advised that there was a warning placed on the gelding's barrier manners.	
LANGKAWI (S Collett) - Raced wide throughout.	
RHAPSODY IN BLUE (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.	
Race 8	Livamol Classic (Group 1)

TIPTRONIC (C Ormsby) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after breaking through the front of its barrier stall and was cleared to start.

MELODY BELLE (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

BEYOND THE FORT (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

VADAVAR (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

GLORY DAYS (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

LIVIN' ON A PRAYER (S Collett) - Raced wide before improving forward to lead near the 1400 metres.

POLZEATH (T Yanagida) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event.

T Harris (MELODY BELLE) - Spoken to regarding his victory salute, issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

D Bradley (OCEAN BILLY) - Issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9	Red Badge Spring Sprint (Group 3)

LONDON EXPRESS (H Schofer) - Rider granted permission to ride 1kg overweight, raced ungenerously getting its head up when being steadied and continued to do so through the middle stages.

SHEEZALLMINE (S Weatherley) - Rider granted permission to ride 1kg overweight.

SPRING TIDE (L Hemi) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

GO NICHOLAS (T Yanagida) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with VIGOR WINNER.

VIGOR WINNER (C Grylls) - Contacted at the start.

ROCK ON WOOD (R Elliot) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

TRUE ENOUGH (J Riddell) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

INITIATIVE (L Innes) - Slow to begin

ORIGINAL GANGSTER (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

OUR FINE WINE (T Yanagida) - Commenced to buck shortly after the start for a distance before settling. Trainer D Sweeney was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare.

HARBOURSIDE (M McNab) - Raced wide throughout.

LUBAYA (C Grylls) - Held up near the 350 metres.

FACETIME (H Schofer) - Held up near the 350 metres.

MISS LABASA (S Weatherley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 300 metres.

IVAN KANE (L Hemi) - Steadied to avoid the heels of PENNY ROYAL which lay out near the 150 metres.

VERY APPEALING (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that she felt there may have been something amiss with the mare. A post race veterinary inspection revealed 1/5 lameness with abrasions to the left hind fetlock and stifle.
