WHY WONDER (D Danis) – Stumbled shortly after jumping away with rider D Danis becoming briefly unbalanced.	
WIND CHIMES (O Bosson) – Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres dropping back on to FOURCHOUX which was hampered.	
T Thornton (VENI VICI) – Admitted a breach under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined the sum of \$500.	
IVERSON (M Cameron) – Lost the right front plate during the running.	
SWISS REGAL (C Grylls) – When questioned regarding performance rider C Grylls could offer no excuse.	
KNOCK ON WOOD (S Collett) – When questioned regarding performance rider S Collett advised that KNOCK ON WOOD failed to handle the existing track conditions.

LOVINGYOURWORK (M Cameron) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider M Cameron advised that the filly failed to handle the existing track conditions.	
MASTER OAKLEIGH (B May) – Briefly held up when attempting a marginal run early in the final straight.

LOVETTORLEAVEIT (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.	
BELLA BUTTON (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly.	
PRINCESS CATHARINA (L Satherley) – Commenced to over-race for a distance approaching the 1200 metres having to shift out abruptly off heels inconveniencing FIVE SCHILLINGS.	

<p>A Goindasamy (BELLA BUTTON) – Issued with a warning over his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>NAUTICAL MILE (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance rider S Weatherley advised the gelding was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p>

<p>SO MUCH MOUR (L Satherley) – Made contact with the front of the barrier as the start was being effected with the barriers opening marginally early as a result. Briefly held up passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>KOOLASCUZ (J Fillmore) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DRAKE BAY (J Riddell) – Slow to begin.</p>

<p>KYLO REN (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>MAENAD (T Thornton) – Over-raced when being steadied in the early to middle stages. Crowded and steadied passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>T Newman (GOOD SOUL) – Issued with a warning after permitting GOOD SOUL to shift in on to MAENAD and as a result EZDARA was crowded and steadied near the 75 metres.</p> <p>EZDARA (B May) – Crowded and steadied 75 metres.</p> <p>.</p>

<p>ON ICE (L Satherley) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>ALALTUN (E McCall) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barriers. Raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>TARIQ (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>HELSINKI (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised the filly was unsuited to today's track conditions, and also hung out in the final straight when placed under pressure.</p>

<p>FLYING SCOTSMAN (A Goindasamy) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and was steadied. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>ITS SO EASY (T Newman) – When questioned into the performance of the favourite the rider advised the mare failed to handle today's existing track conditions.</p> <p>CELEBRE (T Thornton) – When questioned regarding performance rider T Thornton advised the gelding failed to handle today's existing track conditions.</p> <p>SHIBUYA KOSATEN (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised the mare failed to handle today's existing track conditions.</p>

<p>KOOL CHOUXZ (J Fillmore) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and steadied. Raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	

SARDONIA (S Collett) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and steadied.	
Race 9	BETAVET 1200
<p>STYLISH SUGGESTION (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MY SUPERIOR GIRL (D Danis) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>KEKE STAR (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly making contact with the jockey becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>XPLOSION (C Burdan) – Knuckled leaving the barrier and then contacted with the jockey becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>NUCLEAR FUSION (L Satherley) – Lay out and away from RAZ near the 1000 metres which shifted out on to EXCITONIC which had to steady when placed in restricted room losing ground. Also hampered were XPLOSION and RISING RANSOM.</p> <p>RAZ (T Thornton) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to shift in to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.</p>

<p>YAMUNA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>PRIOR ENGAGEMENT (A Goindasamy) – Slow away.</p>	
Race 11	TWILIGHT CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES – 23RD DECEMBER (2000 Metres)
<p>RISING ROAD (A Calder) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>WHANGA WONDER (L Satherley) – Appeared to be struck accidentally with the rival rider’s whip near the 50 metres.</p> <p>The rider of the second placed horse WHANGA WONDER (L Satherley) lodged a protest against the first placed horse HUSK (M Kareem), but after further considering the matter and viewing the videos elected not to proceed with a protest.</p> <p>M Kareem (HUSK) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount HUSK to shift out over the concluding stages, with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of the gelding.</p>
