RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	COMCAT MAIDEN 1800
DEAR DOUGLAS (R Bishop) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
MITCHELL (L Hemi) – Raced keenly and hung throughout placing the rider at a disadvantage. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the gelding's racing manners.	

SEÑORITAS GIRL (M Hudson) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Finished some distance last. The connections were advised that a warning is placed regarding the mare's competitiveness.

Race 2	POWERWORX MAIDEN 1800
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MOZZIE (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly, was tightened then clipped a heel and blundered when there was movement from runners either side.

REDGUM (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly.

IRISH FLARE (S Macnab) – Over raced in front early and middle stages.

SMOOTH COGNAC (C Dell) – Raced fiercely rounding the first turn and had to be steadied for some distance in to the back straight.

CANUCIA (H Schofer) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

J Parkes (FLYING HABIT) – Was questioned regarding his perceived lack of vigour from near the 150 metres until approaching the 50 metres. J Parkes advised that his mount had been a difficult ride throughout and that it had a tendency to lay in on several occasions during the running. Further advising that passing the 150 metres the mare had begun to lug in and he believed the best option was to attempt to straighten his mount so as not to cause interference to runners on his inside. Stewards noted J Parkes comments however he was advised that he is expected to ride his mounts in a manner that does not leave himself open to query.

Race 3	TARANAKI ASSOCIATED CLEANERS MAIDEN 1100
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REGAL RIPA (L Hemi) – Dislodged rider L Hemi during the preliminary and after undergoing a veterinary examination was cleared to run. L Hemi was cleared to ride by Paramedics.

JANE O' (A Mudhoo) – Bounded at the start. Steadied to avoid heels passing the 900 metres.

TENNESSEE ROSE (S Macnab) – Slow away.

SACRED PALACE (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PINTO (R Elliot) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4	OCEAN EMPEROR @ WEOWNA PARK 1100
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ROC CHA (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ALICE TINKER (D Danis) – Hung outwards near the 800 metres dictating CHEEKY BEE outwards into the line of BLUE RATA ELIGIUS which had to check off that runner's heels and in doing so shifted out dictating CAPELYN over extra ground.

CAPELYN (B Ansell) – Dictated over extra ground near the 800 metres.

SMARTY PANTS (C Burdan) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

AWARENESS (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

B Ansell (CAPELYN) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use in the final straight.

R Elliot (CHEEKY BEE) – Was advised that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.	
Race 5	GIRLS GO RACING MAIDEN 1200
<p>SUMI (S Macnab) – Slipped on jumping away then shifted in simultaneously as INTO ACTION shifted out resulting in RELISH being tightened.</p> <p>RELISH (R Elliot) – Tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>PUKE PARK (J Parkes) – Inconvenienced passing the 300 metres by PUNTURA which shifted out and away from SUMI (S Macnab) which had shifted out to obtain clear running. S Macnab was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>PUNTURA (S Collett) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>FOUR QUEENS (K Asano) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 100 metres before being corrected by its rider.</p>	
Race 6	DENIS WHEELER EARTHMOVING MAIDEN 1400
<p>SKORI (D Danis) – Underwent and passed a veterinary examination at the start after being kicked.</p> <p>SIZZLER (S Weatherley) – Was tightened at the start and got back. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in his opinion the mare would be better suited to improved track conditions.</p> <p>ZENKURO (R Elliot) – Held up until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>CHILLAX 'N' CHASE (B Ansell) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>ROSE OF DELGATIE (S Macnab) – Shifted outwards passing the 200 metres making contact with SAIGON HOT NIGHT.</p> <p>SAIGON HOT NIGHT (L Hemi) – Contacted passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections of the 2nd placed ROSE OF DELGATIE viewed footage of the home straight but elected not to proceed with an objection against the 1st placed SAIGON HOT NIGHT.</p>	
Race 7	LANDMARK HOMES 1400
<p>SCHIST (H Schofer) – Slow away.</p> <p>MILITARY STEP (K Asano) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 8	TARANAKI STEELFORMERS 1400
<p>JUSTASKME (J Parkes) – Slow away.</p> <p>MEILA REI (S Macnab) – Slow away.</p> <p>LONDON BOUND (S Collett) – Inconvenienced when runners either side shifted ground approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>S Weatherley (OCEAN BELLE) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>BRUNO MAGILE (T Thornton) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding would derive benefit from today's performance.</p>	
Race 9	ISABELLA SPIERS 1800

REGAL ROCK (M Hudson) – Began awkwardly and got back. Had to shift out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

RUN LIKE BOO (A Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SIDEBAR (F Lazet) – Ran off rounding the home bend. The connections were advised that the mare would now be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

Race 10

CROWDED HOUSE 2000

WHOLETTHEFOXOUT (R Bishop) – Slow to begin.

CURIOUS GEORGE (T Thornton) – began awkwardly and got back.

BEAUDZ WELL (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ZENA BELLE (C Dell) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

VAZZA’S GIFT (F Lazet) – Lost a left hind plate during the running.

CANNOLI (H Schofer) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

YOUNG SQUIRE (S Macnab) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

C Burdan (ZENNTARI) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift out passing the 200 metres when not sufficiently clear of CANNOLI which was placed in restricted room having to be steadied.
