RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HYDE LANDSCAPING & TRENZ HOMES MDN 2200 (2200m)

KRISTOFFERSON (S Wynne) – Jumped away awkwardly. Had to be steadied near the 600 metres when held up by tiring runners.

RENOUNCE (D Bothamley) – Slow to begin.

GINGERIFFIC (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

GERRY JOYCE (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced in the early stages and shifted outwards when being restrained to avoid the heels of SHELBY DEVINE near the 1800 metres, hampering TAPPY'S LAD. Hampered and forced wider near the 1700

metres. Rider reported the tongue control bit had displaced through the gelding's mouth early in the race.

KLASSIC ZED (K Chowdhoory) – Made the first bend awkwardly, shifting outwards abruptly near 1800 metres hampering SHELBY DEVINE and GERRY JOYCE. Shifted out again when making the crossing near the 1650 metres awkwardly. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout. Connections were advised KLASSIC ZED was on a racing manners warning.

TAPPY'S LAD (L Callaway) – Hampered near the 1800 metres.

SHELBY DEVINE (R Cuneen) – Hampered and forced wider near the 1800 metres.

Race 2 WASHRITE & AB LIME & H.E.N BATT & SON MDN 1400 (1400m)

DRAGON GLASS (BB Hong) – Jumped away awkwardly.

TUMEKE (B Murray) – Jumped away awkwardly, losing ground. Commenced to race fiercely shortly after the start, getting its head up and racing ungenerously for some distance.

SPECIAL KAY (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

BORN TO BE BAD (R Cuneen) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

SABOTEUR (T Jonker) – Raced three-wide without cover.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) – Crowded and had to steady near the 300 metres when AGAINST ALL ODDS lay out at this point and SPECIAL KAY shifted in marginally.

SHE'S GOT THE LOOK (C Barnes) – Briefly held up passing the 300 metres.

WONDERING (G Jogoo) – Held up rounding the final bend and in the home straight only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

AGAINST ALL ODDS (T Moseley) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend then lay inwards throughout the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400m)

SHOW PARK (R Cuneen) - Slow to begin.

ROSIE MAE (R Mudhoo) – Lay on the side of the barrier stall and began awkwardly losing ground, then restrained to obtain a position closer to the running rail after jumping from the outside barrier.

QUALITY REVAILS (L Callaway) – Steadied away from heels near the 1200 metres.

LOVE TO DREAM (T Comignaghi) – Raced three-wide without cover.

Race 4 RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT & COMMERCIAL HOTEL WINTON 74 1400 (1400m)

WAIMATE BILL (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin.

RIPNROLL (R Mudhoo) – Raced three-wide without cover.

EASY HABIT (C Campbell) – Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

SOUNDS PROMISING (S Wynne) – Held up over the final 150 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider could offer no tangible explanation. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5 SINCLAIR TRANSPORT & NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING MDN 1200 (1200m)

CHEYENNE DREAMS (C Campbell) – Proved very difficult to load. Connections were advised the filly was on a barrier manners warning.

HENLEY (T Comignaghi) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runner. Raced three-wide without cover.

CAROLINE MARGARET (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin and then further hampered when crowded.

BURNVUE (T Moseley) – Hampered leaving the barriers. Raced wide without cover throughout.

IT'S GUCCI (K Chowdhoory) – Placed in restricted room, clipping a heel and blundering when crowded between SOVIET WONDER which shifted out when bring restrained off heels and KENTUCKY MAY which shifted in slightly when being taken inwards by HENLEY, which was laying in passing the 800 metres.

SOVIET WONDER (R Cuneen) – Got its head up when being steadied to avoid heels passing the 800 metres. Crowded and steadied near the 400 metres when KENTUCKY MAY lay in rounding the final bend.

Race 6 O'MEARA CRUTCHING & TRAVELLERS REST TAVERN 65 1200 (1200m)

MONTREUX MISS (B Murray) – Jumped in the air at the start and shifted outwards hampering KITTY POWER and RAZOR. Crowded having to steady near the 1100 metres.

RAZOR (D Bothamley) – Hampered at the start.

D Bothamley was issued a warning for allowing his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not sufficiently clear of KITTY POWER and MONTREUX MISS with both these runners being crowded, having to steady.

KITTY POWER (K Chowdhoory) – Hampered at the start. Crowded having to steady near the 1100 metres. Raced wide for the majority of the event.

KATE THE GREAT (T Moseley) – Over-raced for a distance passing the 900 metres and got its head up when being steadied away from the heels of RIVERFALLS, then continued to race ungenerously for a distance thereafter.

COTES DE BOURG (G Jogoo) – Steadied away from heels passing the 800 metres.

Race 7 CENTRAL SOUTHLAND FREIGHT & AON INSURANCE WINTON CUP (1600m)

PICTURE ME ROLLIN (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

NOPELE (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

FLYING SARDINE (Y Chew) – Crowded and had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of PICTURE ME ROLLIN which shifted in and away from NOPELE on the bend near the 800 metres.

Post-race Stewards became aware that K Chowdhoory had ridden his mount 1kg over weight which had not been notified or authorised by the Stewards. Stewards questioned K Chowdhoory and the Clerk of the Scales who both advised the trainer had been happy for the gelding to be ridden 1kg over weight. The Clerk of the Scales was severely reprimanded and reminded of his obligation to notify the Stewards whenever riders are over their carded weight. K Chowdhoory with the assistance of T Moseley admitted a resultant breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that he rode 1kg over his carded weight for this event. After hearing penalty submissions the JCA imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 8 BIOFEED & ADVANCE AGRICULTURE & COUNTRY JEWEL HANDICAP 65 2200 (2200m)

ESCAPOLOGIST (K Kwo) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

KNUTQUACKER (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced for a distance near the 1800 metres. Checked and had to steady near the 1100 metres when PERFECTO shifted outwards. Checked and had to steady near the 500 metres when ASATHOUGHT shifted outwards.

ASATHOUGHT (C Campbell) – Held up near the 500 metres having to change ground.

C Campbell in presence of Mr D Walsh admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift ground outwards near the 500 metres when insufficiently clear of KNUTQUACKER which was checked. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Campbell's licence to ride from the 27th October up to and including the 6th November (5 days.)

T Moseley admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift ground outwards near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of KNUTQUACKER which was checked. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the JCA imposed a suspension of Mr Moseley's licence to ride from the 29th October up to and including the 6th November (4 days)
