RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RAT TAT ANNUAL PLATE 1200 (1200 Metres)
A BOX OF TRICKS (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly.	
LOVE FOR ALL (D Bradley) – Over-raced in the middle stages. D Bradley was reminded of his obligation to ride his	

mount fully to the finish when relaxing his ride over the final stages. Stewards were satisfied that the finishing position of LOVE FOR ALL was not compromised.

REAL SLIM TRADIE (R Bishop) - Lay outwards when negotiating the crossing on to the course proper. Shifted out over the final stages when not fully clear. R Bishop was reminded of his obligation to keep his mount straight when riding out a finish.

FLASH WARRIOR (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 2 | **BOOK YOUR WELLINGTON CUP PARTY TODAY MAIDEN 1200 (1200 Metres)**

GREAT COMMISSION (H Schofer) – Underwent and passed a veterinary examination prior to the start after making contact with the front of its gate. Over-raced middle stages, lay inwards near the 400 metres.

HE'S GARY (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

BRADMAN (C Burdan) – Shifted outwards on jumping crowding outside runners. Lay outwards near the 600 metres and continued to do so for some distance, placing the rider at a disadvantage.

THE LAST WORD (S Collett) – Crowded shortly after the start. Held up throughout the home straight.

HERMES (T Allan) - Forced wider near the 600 metres.

HE'S A DOOZY (S Wynne) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages and bumped with SIGNORA NERA near the finish.

SIGNORA NERA (C Grylls) – Bumped near the finish.

Race 3 | **TUI-BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 1200 (1200 Metres)**

MASCARPONE (R Elliot) - Slow to begin. Forced to race wider near the 700 metres.

R Elliot (MASCARPONE) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 636(1)(d) after noticeably relaxing his ride over the final stages, holding his position by a short margin (3rd).

CHOSEN PEAK (T Taiaroa) - Raced wide throughout

ROCK 'N' AFFAIR (L Allpress) – Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages and checked off the heels of WHAT A SMASHER near the crossing and in doing so tightened MASCARPONE and bumping with CHOSEN PEAK which was forced over extra ground.

CHOSEN PEAK (T Taiaroa) – Forced over extra ground near the 500 metres.

T Allan (FIBONACCI) - Was spoken to regarding his whip use in the home straight.

Race 4 | **LIFE FLIGHT 1200 (1200 Metres)**

SANIBEL (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

FLY TO THE SKY (J Parkes) - Raced wide throughout.

MATT CAIN (S Collett) - Raced wide throughout.

DURHAM LAD (H Schofer) - Held up in the home straight until the 250 metres.

TRENDY BELT (T Taiaroa) – Lay inwards near the 250 metres.

IFNDOUBTGETOUT (C Burdan) - Over-raced and lay outwards near the 500 metres.

R Aukett (WORLD TOUR) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

Race 5 | **WYNDSPELLE @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD (1000 Metres)**

STUMPY (T Taiaroa) – Crowded at start. Over-raced middle stages.

DIVINE DIVE (J Parkes) - Crowded at start.

CASAQUINMAN (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room for a distance near the 200 metres, gaining clear running over the final stages.

EXUBERANT (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.

AWESOME AL (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin

BUCKY (R Bishop) - Raced wide throughout.

SCOTCH (L Hemi) – When questioned into the run of SCOTCH, L Hemi advised the gelding had raced in a fresh state and would benefit from the run.

Race 6 | **GRANT PLUMBING 2200 (2200 Metres)**

HAMILTONIAN (M Hudson) – Slow to begin.

SHADOW KING (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly.

LA MIA SIRENA (C Burdan) – Raced wide early stages.

NITRO TED (L Hemi) – Raced wide early.

WHATSUP (T Taiaroa) – Raced wide throughout.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (S Collett) - Raced wide from the 1200 metres.

SHAKESPEARE (D Johnson) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

PASSWORD (C Grylls) - Held up near the 400 metres having to shift ground inwards to gain clear running near the 200metres.

CALL ME JACK (B Ansell) - Raced in restricted room for some distance in the home straight gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

VITTACHI (R Elliot) –When questioned into the run of VITTACHI which presented near the straight entrance after receiving a good run but failed to run on, R Elliot was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 7 | **HIREMASTER 1400 (1400 Metres)**

MOHAKA (C Grylls) – Fractious prior to the start.

BEEFEATER (M Sanson) - Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after the start.

TORRE DEL GRECO (R Elliot) - Raced wide early.

JESSIEGEE (F Lazet) – When questioned into the run of JESSIEGEE, F Lazet was of the opinion the mare would improve with the run.

L Allpress (CROWNING STAR) – Spoken to regarding the use of her whip prior to the 100 metres.

ROSEWOOD (T Allan) - Crowded shortly after the start and got back.

LADIES FIRST (J Parkes) - Crowded shortly after the start and got back.

PEP TORQUE (C Burdan) - Bumped and became unbalanced near the end of the back straight when making contact with GUILLADA (D Bradley). After questioning riders it was established that PEP TORQUE over-reacted when both runners shifted ground.

MAUNA KEA (S Wynne) - Lay inwards near the 150 metres.

SKYPHYTA (M Hudson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

VENT (S Collett) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

LOIRE (C Grylls) - When questioned into the disappointing run C Grylls had no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

C Grylls (LOIRE) - Reminded of his obligations with regard to his use of his whip prior to the 100 metres.

STORMY HABIT (Mudhoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after contacting a fence leaving the enclosure. Slow to begin.

MAUNA LOA (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

WAY ABOVE (S Macnab) –Slow to begin. Had to switch ground at the 100 metres to improve.

NUDGE BAR (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover throughout and finished well back. When questioned J Parkes could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

JESSIE’S ROCK (H Schofer) - Raced wide early.

THOMAS AQUINAS (L Hemi) - Held up early in the home straight.
