Race 3 FOSTER GROUP 2100	
MISTER MOSEY (M McNab) – Trainer D Greene advised Stewards, MISTER MOSEY came through the run well, however, has now been sent for a spell.	
Race 7 JAMES AND ANNIE SARTEN MEMORIAL STAKES (1400)	
NOT AN OPTION (L Innes) – Trainer T Pike reported bone chips were found in the near fore fetlock of NOT AN OPTION, with the colt now being sent for a spell.	

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MOUNT SHOP 2100
POKER QUEEN (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Crowded 2000 metres and then raced ungenerously.	
C Grylls (SPRING DELIGHT) – Issued with a warning after permitting SPRING DELIGHT to shift in approaching the 2000 metres when insufficiently clear of RED FOREST and POKER QUEEN which were both hampered, with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of the aforementioned horses.	
CABALLERO (D Danis) – Began awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight and shifting out making contact near the 300 metres.	
YATIMA (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider losing ground.	
RIP EM UP (T Thornton) – Restrained off heels approaching the 600 metres.	
VEE CECE (J Riddell) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Hung out in the final straight and could not be ridden to advantage from near the 300 metres. Co-trainer A Forsman was advised that VEE CECE would be required to barrier trial right-handed before racing right-handed again. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.	
RED FOREST (L Satherley) – Crowded approaching the 2000 metres and steadied. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Forced wide passing the 500 metres by STAR TSAR which was shifting out to obtain clear running. Crowded 300 metres.	
AMAZING AZ (T Harris) – Slow away. Crowded 300 metres.	
D Danis (CABALLERO) – Issued with a warning after permitting CABALLERO to shift out passing the 300 metres crowding AMAZING AZ on to RED FOREST which were both hampered.	
Race 2	PAST PRESIDENTS OF COUNTIES RACING CLUB 1200
TIVAAN WARRIOR (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly making contact with WHIMSICAL. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found a cut to the medial heel on the right hind.	
ROSE 'N' POWER (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.	
NO FILTER (A Calder) – Slow away. Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 350 metres.	
WHIMSICAL (A Goindasamy) – Hampered shortly after the start. Made brief contact with the running rail approaching the 700 metres going off stride. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.	
OPAESCENCE (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover.	
JASON BELLTREE (L Innes) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 150 metres. Lost the off fore plate during the running.	
Race 3	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 Metres)
ARRIVEDERCI (A Goindasamy) – Slow away. Sprung the off fore plate during the running.	
IMAREADY (C Burdan) – Slow away.	

LOOSE CANNON (D Danis) – Contacted leaving the barrier by SANTORI which lay in with LOOSE CANNON then making contact with the hindquarters of MAI TAI which then lay out forcing LOOSE CANNON across the heels of SANTORI with LOOSE CANNON clipping a heel and blundering with the bridle becoming detached, with the bit remaining in the mare's mouth and LOOSE CANNON being retired from the race.

MISS RICKY BOBBY (L Innes) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. L Innes advised he had had difficulty with visibility.

SHE'S A LADY (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover.

NUCLEAR FUSION (L Satherley) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

Race 4 | **ROGER GILL MITSUBISHI 1200**

SHEEZALLMINE (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly.

ROYAL PERFORMER (A Calder) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Hampered 950 metres.

WALKIN' BY (A Goindasamy) – Restrained from its wide barrier.

SHOWOROSSES (S Collett) – The right-hand barrier gate failed to properly attach after the start was effected and then swung back with SHOWOROSSES then striking the gate and being slow away. Hampered 950 metres. Following the race, a request for a ruling was lodged by the connections of the 5th placed SHOWOROSSES alleging that the mare had not received a fair start. After considering submissions SHOWOROSSES was declared a non-runner.

MONEY TRAIL (C Burdan) – Crowded 1000 metres by ITS DESTINYS CHILD (D Danis), then racing ungenerously for a distance passing the 950 metres when being restrained off the heels of ITS DESTINYS CHILD which had been steady to avoid the heels of WEAPONRY (O Bosson). As a result, SHOWOROSSES and ROYAL PERFORMER which were following were both hampered. Raced ungenerously for a distance approaching the 600 metres.

D Danis (ITS DESTINYS CHILD) – Issued with a warning after permitting ITS DESTINYS CHILD to shift in when insufficiently clear of MONEY TRAIL which was crowded near the 950 metres.

O Bosson (WEAPONRY) – Issued with a warning after permitting WEAPONRY to shift in near the 950 metres when insufficiently clear of ITS DESTINYS CHILD which was crowded and restrained.

MELT (M Cameron) – Raced three wide without cover.

NEW YORK JAZZ (T Newman) – Improved on to heels over the concluding stages and was steadied.

Race 5 | **MALCOLM WRIGLEY INSURANCE 1300**

CAPISTRANO ROCS (T Newman) – Began awkwardly. Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres.

TE NGAERE FALLS (M Kareem) – Crowded shortly after the start. Hampered passing the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of ENCANTADOR which was restrained to avoid heels.

PARIS RUBY (A Calder) – Restrained from its wide barrier.

TARGHEE (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide in the early stages. Hampered 900 metres.

ENCANTADOR (V Colgan) – Restrained to avoid heels 900 metres.

CHOUXWEST (B May) – Hampered 900 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.

Race 6 | **DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 1400**

WILD WEST (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.

PULLYOURSOCKSUP (M Cameron) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

LOWPROFILE (L Satherley) – Dipped shortly after the start.

SUSPENSE (V Colgan) – Commenced to over-race approaching the 900 metres.

OHCEEDEE (T Harris) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

C Jones (DIOGENES) – Spoken to regarding whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 7 | **HAUNUI FARM KARAKA CLASSIC (1600 Metres)**

SWEET CLEMENTINE (A Calder) – Kicked out making contact with the running rail leaving the parade area. Rider A Calder was reprimanded after failing to report the occurrence to the starter. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

NASHA RIVA (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.

LE CASTILE (S Collett) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

DEMONETIZATION (L Innes) – Hampered shortly after the start.

TE AKAU CALIBURN (T Harris) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

PINMEDOWN (B May) – Crowded approaching the 1400 metres to the inside of ZA ZA GABOR which was forced in by IN A TWINKLING which lay in and away from RONCHI (L Satherley) which shifted in slightly. L Satherley was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance. Shifted into a marginal run near the 250 metres making contact with the hindquarters of LE CASTILE which became briefly unbalanced with PINMEDOWN then being held up. Rider B May was reprimanded and advised he must exercise greater care.

GO NICHOLAS (T Yanagida) – Briefly crowded passing the 1200 metres to the inside of RONCHI (L Satherley) which shifted in before being quickly corrected by its rider. L Satherley was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance. Raced keenly through the middle stages attempting to shift out near the 900 metres making contact with CRAFTY JESS which was then forced to race three wide without cover. T Yanagida was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must exercise greater care.

CRAFTY JESS (M Cameron) – Forced three wide near the 900 metres then remained wide without cover.

SIRACUSA (A Goindasamy) – Shifted in inside the final 100 metres making contact with DEMONETIZATION which had shifted out.

IN A TWINKLING (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding performance rider O Bosson advised the gelding had commenced to hang inwards in the early stages and had become disinterested. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

Race 8	FRANKLIN AUCTIONS 1600
<p>LIVVY LASS, IL AFFARE and PACIFIC MASTER all removed from the barrier after striking the front of the gates being cleared fit to race after undergoing veterinary examinations. Starter Mr T McGovern reported that the incident was due to an attempt to start the race when the reset switch had not been activated.</p> <p>RED HUSSAR (C Ormsby) – Slow away.</p> <p>LIVVY LASS (V Colgan) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider V Colgan could offer no tangible excuse.</p> <p>GALLARDO (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>IL AFFARE (A Goindasamy) – Contacted shortly after leaving the barriers on several occasions and became unbalanced.</p> <p>BULLYBROOK (C Jones) – Shifted in shortly after leaving the barrier making contact with IL AFFARE. Raced keenly in the middle stages, and was restrained away from heels near the 900 metres.</p> <p>FLUROBUS (A Calder) – Restrained in the early stages in an attempt to obtain cover. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>O Bosson (SUPER GEE) – Reminded of his obligation in that he must ride his mounts fully to the line when circumstances permit him to do so.</p>	
Race 9	ROGER GILL AGRICULTURE 1600
<p>ROCCO (A Calder) – Slow away.</p> <p>DOUBLE ACT (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up early in the final straight. Contacted 250 metres becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>JAYDEEAR (T Yanagida) – Travelled three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>EAGLE HUNTER (L Innes) – Travelled wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GERI (D Danis) – Shifted in to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres to the inside of JUDAH which was shifting under pressure, making contact with DOUBLE ACT which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>MAASIR (S Collett) – When questioned regarding performance rider S Collett advised that the gelding was not entirely comfortable in the existing track conditions.</p> <p>C Ormsby (THE GREEN DRAGON) – Issued with a warning regarding his whip use.</p>
