GENERAL:

K Chowdhoory did not attend the meeting due to a track work injury on Thursday and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 GARRARDS HORSE & HOUND PREMIER (1600m)

Trainer P Harris - Fined \$50 after presenting ANJARDEN with incorrect gear.

WESTERN GIRL (C Johnson) - Blundered jumping away unbalancing its rider losing ground.

ANJARDEN (D Bothamley) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact. Was dismounted on pulling up when showing signs of lameness and led back to the enclosure. A post race veterinary inspection revealed lameness in the right hind leg, with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

BARRETT (J Lowry) - Slow to begin, was inclined to get its head up when being restrained off heels in the middle stages.

L Hemi (GOGO MR JOE) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when laying in shortly after the start crowding ZAKUNDA onto SHELOB.

GOGO MR JOE (L Hemi) - Was inclined to lay inwards in the early stages then raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained.

ZAKUNDA (K Asano) - Crowded shortly after the start, held up in the early stages of the run home having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres, then again having to shift ground near the 75 metres.

SHELOB (R Cuneen) - Crowded shortly after the start.

SWEET KARMA (T Moseley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

QIJI OLYMPIA (L Callaway) - Dropped out to finish a distant last with the rider advising that the mare had been making abnormal breathing noises. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 2 NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES PREMIER (1600m)

THE EMPORESS (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

JACK KNOWS BEST (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly, over raced in the middle stages.

SUPER TAP (L Callaway) - Dictated outwards shortly after the start crowding the running of SACRED CAGA, TREKOLURE and LAPHROAIG, briefly held up near the 350 metres.

GOODANYA (D Bothamley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

REPULSE (Z Bholah) - Race four wide without cover from the 800 metres.

IFITHAPPENSAGAIN (T Harris) - Held up in the early stages of the run home having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

EASY ON THE EYE (K Asano) - Rider dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) - Held up near the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

THE EMPORESS (M McNab) - Held up near the 200 metres having to angle outwards to obtain clear running.

SACRED CAGA (L Innes) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

MISS TAVI (C Johnson) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

J Parkes (VINEYARD MCPHEE) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO PREMIER (1200m)

HENLEY (S Toolooa) - Crowded at the start.

CLUBCARD (S Weatherley) - Blundered as the start was made losing ground.

MISS IF FORMAX (K Asano) - Began awkwardly.

MISS CHAPLIN (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

MOVIE STAR (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards making firm contact with CHAMONIX.

CHAMONIX (C Johnson) - Contacted start.

CEDDY SMITH (M McNab) - Over raced when being restrained in the early stages.

SUNNY LADY (R Cuneen) - Over raced when being restrained in the early stages.

M McNab (CEDDY SMITH) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$750.

S Toolooa (HENLEY) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

WANNABE 'N' PARIS (D Bothamley) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had hung throughout. A post race veterinary inspection found the mare to have a poor recovery with a veterinary clearance now required prior to racing next.

Race 4 DAKINS GROUP PREMIER (1200m)

HEARTOHEART (M Gestain) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home eventually finding clear running near the 200 metres.

STELLA DAZE (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly.

OPERATOR (S Weatherley) - Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when HEARTOHEART (M Gestain) shifted outwards. Apprentice M Gestain was advised to exercise greater care.

OUR ROSETTE (C Johnson) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear running inside the final 200 metres.

BENAUD (T Jonker) - Held up and unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

Race 5 ONE GOOD HORSE AT AVONHEAD TAVERN PREMIER (1100m)

EXUBERANT (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

POKURU'S GIFT (O Bosson) - Slow to begin.

JUST TICKETY BOO (K Kwo) - Slow to begin.

WALKTHISSWEY (C Johnson) - Blundered leaving the barriers, steadied when awkwardly placed crossing the junction onto the course proper near the 600 metres.

TEE CEE COUP (S Weatherley) - Had to be angled outwards passing the 250 metres to obtain clear racing room.

KHIMAR WAR (L Allpress) - Held up early in the run home having to shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

THE SWISS MAESTRO (M McNab) - Required post race veterinary treatment for a suspected suspensory injury to the right foreleg, with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

Race 6 BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES PEGASUS STAKES (1000m)

PUYSEGUR (K Asano) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

NELLIE BLY (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin then further hampered when crowded shortly after the start, held up throughout the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

WEKAFORCE (L Allpress) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied when contacted by MORWEKA which lay out, held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 200 metres.

DON CARLO (C Barnes) - Raced ungenerously through the middle stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

SENSEI (M McNab) - Held up throughout the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

Race 7 AWAY TO GO PREMIER (2000m)

CINTO BAY - Declared a late scratching at 12.38 pm on veterinary advice, with the connections advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

CITY SLICKER (L Allpress) - Proved reluctant to load delaying the start. A warning was placed on the mare's barrier record.

KAMANDA LINCOLN (J Parkes) - Slow to begin, pulled up after going amiss near the 500 metres immediately being attended to by a course veterinarian having to be humanely euthanised after being found to have fractured the right front fetlock. The horse ambulance was deployed but a battery malfunction resulted in a considerable delay in clearing the track.

GREEN DISPATCH (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 8 AL BASTI EQUIWORLD DUBAI 48TH NEW ZEALAND 2000 GUINEAS (1600m)

The start was delayed approximately 13 minutes due to issues with the horse ambulance following Race 7.

WATCHMAKER (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

BOURBONAIRE (S Weatherley) - Inconvenienced leaving the barriers, contacted and unbalanced approaching the 400 metres. Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections viewed Stewards' film footage with a view to lodging a protest against the 1st placed AEGON but elected not to proceed.

EMBERS (K Asano) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained shortly after the start getting its head up, was inclined to over race in the middle stages again racing ungenerously when having to be restrained away from heels.

MARINE (M McNab) - Commenced to over race near the 1400 metres continuing to race fiercely through the middle stages before striking a heel of LORD ARDMORE and blundering badly passing the 1100 metres almost dislodging its rider.

J Parkes (LORD ARDMORE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding after allowing his mount to shift inwards when not clear of MARINE which clipped a heel and blundered near the 1100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 10 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 8 November up to and including Wednesday 25 November.

AEGON (L Innes) - Made contact with BOURBONAIRE when attempting to obtain clear running approaching the 400 metres with BOURBONAIRE contacting the hindquarters of ZOLTAN as a result which was badly unbalanced making further contact with BOURBONAIRE, then had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres. L Innes was advised to exercise care.

ZOLTAN (T Moseley) - Raced wide throughout, badly unbalanced when contacted approaching the 400 metres.

ROCKET SPADE (T Harris) - Held up entering the final straight continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the straight.

J Parkes (LORD ARDMORE) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 25 November up to and including Thursday 3 December.

NEED I SAY MORE (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had travelled well until coming under pressure near the 200 metres and in his view had failed to see out the distance of today's race.

UNITION (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse advising that the gelding had been disappointing.

Race 9 GOLD CLUB PREMIER (1400m)

The start was officially delayed 5 minutes by the TAB due to pool co-mingling issues.

RITANI (S Macnab) - Restrained to the rear after jumping from a wide barrier.

THE BUFFER (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly then further hampered when crowded.

AIR MAX (T Moseley) - Over raced in the middle stages, held up in the early stages of the run home having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.

HEE'S OUR SECRET (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

EQUINOX (R Mudhoo) - Held up rounding the turn from the 600 metres continuing to have difficulty finding clear running for the majority of the straight.

SUMMER MONSOON (O Bosson) - Held up in the early stages of the run home.

Race 10 NAUTICAL BOAT INSURANCE METROPOLITAN TROPHY HANDICAP (2500m)

ASATHOUGHT (C Johnson) - Blundered on jumping losing ground.

WILLIAM WALLACE (R Cuneen) - Restrained to the rear on jumping. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been inclined to race keenly in the early stages and in his opinion may not have seen out the distance of today's race.

NOMEN LUDI (T Moseley) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 2000 metres.

BEAUTY STAR (K Asano) - Raced wide in the early stages.

VAINGLORY (L Allpress) - Raced wide from the 1200 metres, had to be steadied away from the heels of FIVE PRINCES which was taken out by LINCOLN KING (D Bradley) near the 350 metres. D Bradley was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Was dismounted on pulling up requiring veterinary attention after having been galloped on during the running. VAINGLORY was loaded onto the horse ambulance and transported to a local veterinary clinic for further evaluation and treatment.

BABY MENAKA (T Comignaghi) - Over raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied, had some difficulty obtaining clear running from near the 250 metres.

KING OF THE DANCE (R Mudhoo) - Had to be steadled when improving onto the heels of VAINGLORY near the 450 metres having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear racing room.

J Lowry (WHO DARES WINS) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 11 BLUE STAR TAXIS PREMIER (1600m)

AQUATTACK (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

RIVALDO (S Macnab) - Began awkwardly.

MONASH (R Beeharry) - Raced wide throughout.

FLORENTIA (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FULL FURY (R Mudhoo) - Over raced in the middle stages when the pace steadied.

QUEEN JETSUN (C Campbell) - Held up near the 400 metres and had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the straight.

K Asano (TOO FERLAXED) - Admitted a charge of careless riding after permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 400 metres when not sufficiently clear of CLOONEY which was hampered and checked, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 November up to and including Thursday 26 November.

CLOONEY (R Cuneen) - Hampered and checked passing the 400 metres.

SURE IS (T Comignaghi) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

L Allpress (SOUTHERN OCEAN) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
