RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BALLANCE AGRI-NUTRIENTS MILE (1600 metres)

SANLORENZO (R Bishop) - Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied. R Bishop was questioned into his ride and in particular his lack of vigour between the 400m and 300m. R Bishop advised stewards that the gelding had hung rounding the home turn and was momentarily held up when improving into a marginal gap near the 100 metres.

VIOLET BELLE (L Hemi) - Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied. When questioned into performance rider L Hemi advised the mare would improve with the run.

AMATHUSIA (R Elliot) - Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied.

CARAMEL POPCORN (D Bradley) - Raced wide in the early stages.

FIVE SCHILLINGS (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 2 DAX'X RESTAURANT & BAR/RURAL AIR WORK R65 MILE (1600 metres)

MILITARY STEP (C Burdan) – Removed from the barriers after becoming factitious to undergo a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start, Over-raced when the pace steadied going into the first turn near the 1400 metres then continued to over-race throughout.

A BOX OF TRICKS (S Collett) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

ROC LEGEND (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

I AM A CRAFTSMAN (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.

RESOLUTION (S McKay) - Over-raced when the pace steadied going into the first turn near the 1400 metres. When questioned into the disappointing run S McKay advised the gelding pulled up in a normal post-race condition and in his opinion was better suited to a firmer track.

GINGER JANE (E McCall) - Over-raced when the pace steadied going into the first turn near the 1400 metres.

CRUZ RAMIREZ (L Allpress) - Over-raced when the pace steadied going into the first turn near the 1400 metres.

Race 3 AWASSI/BAYLEYS 1200 (1200 metres)

HESACITIBOY (E McCall) - Began awkwardly and then hampered a short distance further.

BASAWRA (V Colgan) - Crowded then hampered at start.

LOCARNO (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

VELOCE SORELLA (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly then shifted out making contact with FEARLESS, placed in restricted room passing the 900 metres. When questioned regarding performance C Burdan advised the filly had hung throughout.

FEARLESS (S Macnab) - Contacted at start and became unbalanced.

S Macnab (FEARLESS) – Was issued with a warning under [Rule 638(1)(d)] after allowing her mount to shift inwards near the 900 metres placing VELOCE SORELLA in restricted room.

PABLO ESK (R Elliot) - Had to be angled outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.

SHOELLE (F Lazet) – A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery.

Race 4 CARRFIELD LIVESTOCK 1400 (1400 metres)

MISS MARMO (R Bishop) - Was kicked when parading and after undergoing a veterinary inspection was cleared fit to race, slow to begin.

AUDITION (J Bassett) – Slow away, hung in the early and middle stages placing the rider at a disadvantage. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the filly regarding its racing manners.

ORLOV (R Elliot) – Had to be steadied for some distance near the 800 when improving rapidly on to the heels of ZAKHAN and went back onto POLAR NIGHT which also had to steady.

POLAR NIGHT (T Newman) - Steadied near the 800 metres.

CABRELSEA (V Colgan) - Shifted out approaching the 100 metres and bumped with POLAR NIGHT becoming unbalanced for a distance near the finish.

Race 5 CR GRACE/CENTRAL LINES 1300 (1300 metres)

BLAKKALBERRY (D Hirini) - Slow to begin.

RENAULT (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

REAL SLIM TRADIE (R Bishop) - Slow to begin, raced keenly going into the first turn.

PASSIONE (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

BOLD IRIS (L Hemi) - Raced keenly going into the first turn and was angled off heels near the 800 metres.

R Bishop (REAL SLIM TRADIE) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 AFFCO CHB CUP (2100 metres)

NOWANAGEN (C Burdan) – Late scratched at barrier after being kicked and failing a veterinary examination.

MONGOLIAN PRINCESS (D Hirini) - Slow to begin

BOTTI (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly and steadied.

SURREY (S Collett) - Raced wide until working forward to lead near the 1100 metres.

S O'Malley (Botti) - Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Following the running of Race 6 the track was downgraded to a Slow 8 after rain.

Race 7 TE AKAU – BE PART OF NZ'S NO 1 STABLE 1200 (1200metres)

LILIKOI (R Elliot) - Slow to begin, hampered losing ground passing 1100 metres.

WILLPOWER (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

BLOOD WARRIOR (D Bradley) - Slow to begin.

AERO DE PARIS (S McKay) - Commenced to hang outwards soon after leaving the barrier, shifting out passing the 1100 metres crowding CASAQUINMAN onto LILIKOI which were both hampered, continued to hang out for the remainder of the race placing the rider at a disadvantage. Co Trainer A Scott was advised a warning will be placed on the gelding.

CASAQUINMAN (R Bishop) – Hampered losing ground passing the 1100 metres.

HAPPY TAV (L Allpress) - Bumped early in the home straight with BLOOD WARRIOR becoming momentarily unbalanced and a short distance further was in restricted room between BLOOD WARRIOR and MADAM HASS which shifted out.

Race 8 PGG WRIGHTSON WAIPUKURAU CUP (1600 metres)

NABIAC (B May) - Slow to begin

QUANTUM (C Burdan) - Slow to begin

AWESOME AL (R Bishop) - Slow to begin

MERCY HILL (L Hemi) - Made the first bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly, continued to over-race for some distance approaching the 800 metres.

ROLL THE GOLD (J Fawcett) - Made the first bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly.

IVAN KANE (L Allpress) – Commenced to race fiercely into the first turn and when being angled off heels clipped the heels of the runner ahead and blundered which resulted in SERENA being checked losing considerable ground, raced wide without cover throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed bleeding from both nostrils consistent with lacerations, also suffered right hind abrasions to the stifle and coronary band.

SERENA (S Collett) – Checked losing ground near the 1500 metres, had to shift outwards near the 250 metres to improve.

B MAY (NABIAC) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9 AON INSURANCE BROKERS 1400 (1400 metres)

UNCLE BRO (J Bassett) Raced keenly in the early stages.

L Hemi (VROOM) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use inside the final 100 metres.
