SUPPLEMENTARY:

<u>Waikato Racing Club – 7 November 2020</u> Race 6 – LEGACY LODGE SPRINT (1200 Metres) C Ormsby (ENDLESS DRAMA) – Was questioned in regard to his perceived lack of vigour shown in the final straight. C Ormsby explained that after beginning well it had been his intention to take a trail behind IHU, however ENDLESS DRAMA had commenced to over-race and failed to settle. Adding that he believed that after failing to settle in the early stages the entire was beaten early in the straight, and when he urged him briefly he had failed to respond. Trainer T Pike confirmed that the riding instructions had been to obtain cover early and that the entire was best saved for one run. C Ormsby agreed with Stewards that he had appeared to show a lack of vigour, however he further explained that the entire had come to the end of its run and applying further pressure could have been detrimental. C Ormsby was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that he must not ride in a manner that leaves himself open to query.

Race 1	SHACKELL ELECTRICAL 2200
<p>BORDER LEICESTER (J Riddell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>EL ZITA (T Yanagida) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.</p> <p>CLEESE (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>RELIABULL (O Bosson) – Raced wide without cover until improving forward near the 1400 metres. Found to be lame in the right foreleg on pulling up. Rider dismounted and led RELIABULL back to the weigh-in area. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a hoof injury on its off side foreleg.</p> <p>KING OF THE ROAD (J Fawcett) – Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres and was not persevered with from the 600 metres. When questioned rider advised the gelding felt indifferent in its action and also felt it was unsuited after having its first start on a heavy track. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>SPARKLING LADY (A Goindasamy) – Was not persevered with in the final straight. Rider advised the mare was unsuited to today's heavy track conditions.</p> <p>DE SILVER LINING (D Danis) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any explanation for the gelding's performance.</p> <p>J Riddell (BORDER LEICESTER) – Issued with a warning over his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>L Satherley (ZION HILL) – Issued with a warning over her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 2	GEOFF BRINDLEY MEMORIAL 1400
<p>SOUTHERN CROWN (S McKay) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early stages having to be restrained off heels approaching the 1300 metres. Rider dropped his whip passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>AFITUSI (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>HETTY (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p>COVENANT (S Weatherley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 3	CAPISTRANO LODGE 3YO (1400 Metres)
<p>HIGHLAND WHISPER (S McKay) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been unsuited by today's track conditions.</p> <p>DUNTAYAR (O Bosson) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>T Newman (SWEY MY WAY) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 4	MAKE-A-WISH NEW ZEALAND 1200
<p>PRECISION SHOOTER (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>HAPPY REMARK (M Kareem) – Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>THE VILLAIN (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly. Stumbled when being restrained near the 1100 metres. Firmly restrained passing the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside heels. When questioned regarding</p>	

performance rider advised that the gelding got its tongue over the bit and laid out throughout the final straight proving difficult to ride.

SUPER DALE (L Satherley) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight making contact with LOCK UP on at least four occasions, then lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

LOCK UP (S Collett) – Contacted final straight. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

INTO THE DEEP (J Fawcett) – Slow away.

CHEEKY BEE (S McKay) – Held up early in the final straight having to shift out to obtain clear running.

JUSTASTATE (D Danis) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres inconveniencing FLEURGUNDY.

FLEURGUNDY (T Newman) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.

CHEERS (A Goindasamy) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare was unsuited by the holding track conditions.

CABALLERO (J Fawcett) – Briefly held up early in the final straight shifting out to obtain clear running.

DOUBLE ACT (T Thornton) – Knuckled on jumping away.

TICKLE ME ALMO (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SON OF SASANOF (J Riddell) – Slow to begin.

VIVA L'RIPPA (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

D Danis (GERI) – Advised to exercise care when steadying the pace near the 1400 metres.

THE GREEN GREMLIN (M Hashizume) – Had to be restrained off heels when over-racing passing the 1400 metres.

DAWON (T Yanagida) – Made contact with THE GREEN GREMLIN on several occasions in the final straight when both runners shifted ground.

UNDER THE PUMP (S McKay) – Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 450 metres having to shift out abruptly, then was held up having to shift out near the 350 metres to obtain clear running.

LOUIS LE GRAND (M Kareem) – Rider dropped his whip passing the 300 metres.
