GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1MOUNT SHOP 2100LADY SHABEEL (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

FELAAR (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly.

LE SABLIER (S Weatherley) - Slow away.

COUTURIERE (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced when being restrained shortly after the start.

SPRING DELIGHT (D Danis) - Lay out under pressure in the straight.

STAR TSAR (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after getting back the gelding had not been suited by the moderate tempo of the race.

Race 2 HR FISKEN & SONS LTD 1600

NABIAC (B May) - Crowded start having to be steadied losing ground.

SAGUNTO (S Collett) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Contacted near the 200 metres.

AROMATIC (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly. Shifted outwards abruptly near the 1500 metres when crossing the junction onto the course proper forcing BAD 'N' BOUJ and PATSYS LASS wider on the track. When being corrected, shifted back inwards when not fully clear of MAKE TIME which was steadied. O Bosson was advised to exercise care. Contacted near the 200 metres.

MAKE TIME (M McNab) - Had to be steadied near the 1500 metres. Held up rounding the final turn until near the 250 metres and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running hampered PATSYS LASS.

BAD 'N' BOUJ (S McKay) - Hampered near the 1500 metres. Lost left hind plate during the running.

PATSYS LASS (T Thornton) - Hampered near the 1500 metres. Held up passing the 300 metres making contact with JIP JIP ROCK when attempting to obtain clear running then being further hampered and was inclined to shift away from MAKE TIME when that runner shifted outwards near the 200 metres.

CHA SIU BAO (M Hashizume) - Slow away.

JIP JIP ROCK (D Johnson) - Held up early in the final straight.

RHAEGAR (T Harris) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

M McNab (MAKE TIME) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards near the 250 metres hampering PATSYS LASS.

SUSPENSE (S Weatherley) - Lay out making contact with AROMATIC near the 200 metres with SAGUNTO also being bumped wider as a result.

CREATIVE GENIUS (J Riddell) - Lost left front plate during the running.

Race 3 FASTTRACK INSURANCE 2YO STAKES (1100m)

DULCE NINA (T Newman) - Began awkwardly making contact with the side of the starting gates. Came together and bumped with CHEROKEE WARRIOR near the 250 metres.

SONGGONG SUCCESS (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHEROKEE WARRIOR (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Came together and bumped with DULCE NINA near the 250 metres. Lost the right front plate during the running.

BELDARRA (L Innes) - Was inclined to lay out shifting ground over the final 100 metres with the rider advising that the filly raced greenly.

BRIX (S Collett) - Held up until passing the 200 metres then laying out away from QUATTRO QUINTA inconveniencing MISS IPENEMA near the 150 metres.

MISS IPENEMA (C Grylls) - Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

LADY PRISTINA (D Johnson) - Steadied for a distance when held up approaching the 200 metres.

Race 4 VERNON AND VAZEY 1400

SCAGLIONI (M Hashizume) - Dislodged rider on the way to the start. After being recaptured was declared a late scratching at 2.17 pm as it was found that the saddle had broken. M Hashizume was uninjured.

VIRTUOSO LAD (T Yanagida) - Slow away.

OUR ALLEY CAT (S Collett) - Jumped away awkwardly making solid contact with PACKING ROCKSTAR which was forced onto SHENANIGANS resulting in all three runners losing ground.

PACKING ROCKSTAR (O Bosson) - Contacted start losing ground.

SHENANIGANS (V Colgan) - Contacted start losing ground. Was not persevered with from the 300 metres dropping out to finish a distant last. V Colgan reported that the gelding had felt to go off stride early in the straight once placed under pressure. A post race veterinary inspection found SHENANIGANS to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance now required prior to racing again.

WILD WEST (L Innes) - Hampered leaving the barriers when TEARS OF JUPITER jumped inwards.

LUMINOUS (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped away awkwardly.

INCA WARRIOR (J Riddell) - Jumped away awkwardly.

IRON EAGLE (S McKay) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Crowded when weakening near the 200 metres.

JAKKALBOMB (D Danis) - Briefly crowded near the 100 metres.

SEVEN SEAS (M McNab) - Held up over the final 100 metres.

Race 5

DUNSTAN FEEDS AUCKLAND THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS' STAKES (1400m)

FAMILIA (L Innes) - Reared as the start was effected, losing several lengths. Following the race a request for a ruling was filed with the Judicial Committee finding that FAMILIA had been denied a fair start due to a barrier attendant still having hold of a rein when the gates opened, accordingly FAMILIA was declared a non-starter with all bets on that runner to be refunded. Held up over the final 200 metres.

YEARN (S Weatherley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

JE SUIS TIGER (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly.

SHOWOROSES (V Colgan) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

SUPERA (C Grylls) - Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

Race 6 BROKERWEB 1200

LORD POLONIUS (W Pinn) - Slow away.

MANRICO (Y Coonee) - Steadied 800 metres, again steadied near the 600 metres, held up early in the final straight.

Y Coonee (MANRICO) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when steadying and not sufficiently clear of A PROPER LADY which was checked near the 800 metres and shifted outwards badly hampering LOOSE CANNON and SAINTLY WAY. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 21 November until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 29 November, 5 national riding days.

A PROPER LADY (L Innes) - Checked when crowded near the 800 metres. Held up in the straight until near the 250 metres.

LOOSE CANNON (M McNab) - Badly hampered near the 800 metres.

SAINTLY WAY (S Weatherley) - Badly hampered near the 800 metres. Became badly unbalanced when contacted near the 200 metres.

LAURANT (L Satherley) - Held up early in the straight and did not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

O Bosson (ROCH 'N' HORSE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear crowding HONG KONG'S FOLKS on to SAINTLY WAY with all those three runners becoming unbalanced for a distance. After viewing films and hearing submissions O Bosson was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing today Saturday 21 November until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 3 December, 7 national riding days.

HONG KONG'S FOLKS (C Dell) - Became badly unbalanced when crowded and checked near the 200 metres.

ALL PAID UP (A Goindasamy) - Unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

Race 7 FRANKLIN AUCTIONS COUNTIES CUP (2100m)

VOLER POUR MOI (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

JUSTAMAIZ (M McNab) - Slow away.

SAVY YONG BLONK (D Johnson) - Slow away. Held up near the 400 metres and did not obtain clear running until approaching the 250 metres.

BLUE BREEZE (C Dell) - Restrained early after jumping from a wide barrier.

MY GIFT (D Danis) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

O Bosson (IN A TWINKLING) - Admitted a charge in that he had used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$1,000.00

L Satherley (LIVIN' ON A PRAYER) - Fined \$450 after admitting a charge in that she used the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

M McNab (JUSTAMAIZ) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 HAUNUI FARM COUNTIES BOWL (1100m)

ONLY IN JAKARTA (D Johnson) - Became fractious breaking through the front of the starting gates but was quickly restrained and returned to the start being passed fit to run following a veterinary inspection.

DONNA ANNE BILLY (J Fawcett) - Jumped outwards abruptly from the outside barrier losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.

LEVANTE (S Collett) - Slow away.

PRETTY TO SEA (L Satherley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

MELT (M Cameron) - Raced fiercely in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained to avoid heels passing the 700 metres going back onto NEW YORK JAZZ which was hampered.

NEW YORK JAZZ (T Newman) - Hampered near the 700 metres. Held up early in the final straight before angling outwards to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

T Newman (NEW YORK JAZZ) - Issued with a warning after angling her mount outwards near the 300 metres crowding SHEEZALLMINE.

SHEEZALLMINE (W Pinn) - Crowded near the 300 metres. Apprentice W Pinn was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish.

Race 9FRANKLIN LONG ROOFING LTD 1600MIGHTY ASLAN (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

ROYAL CHARM (C Ormsby) - Held up rounding the final turn.

ALWAYS SACRED (M McNab) - Crowded between SUPER GEE and MARRONI just short of the finish. Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections viewed Stewards films with a view to a possible protest against the 2nd horse SUPER GEE, electing not to proceed.
