RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BENTLEYS CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1400

BRAAVOS (J Fawcett) – Slow away, losing ground. Raced wide for the majority of the race.

MONEY TRAIL (M Cameron) — Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Further restrained when crowded approaching the 700 metres and hampered. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

T Yanagida (GO NICHOLAS) – Issued with a warning after permitting GO NICHOLAS to shift in near the 700 metres when insufficiently clear of MONEY TRAIL which was hampered.

SHE'S NOT BAD (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could offer no excuse.

Race 2 EAGLE CHARTERS 1100

AUBREE (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Hampered and forced wide 700 metres losing ground.

THE CHARGING (V Colgan) – Slow away losing ground. Became awkwardly placed near heels approaching the 700 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance. Continued to race greenly through the middle stages and restrained off heels near the 600 metres. Held up 300 metres.

BERGHEIM (S Weatherley) – Restrained from its wide barrier. Hampered 700 metres. Awkwardly placed 600 metres and steadied.

AGLIANICO (L Innes) – Raced ungenerously when being steadled hanging outwards shifting back onto ARDIJAH near the 700 metres which was hampered and ran wide.

M Cameron MILLEFIORI — Reminded of his obligation in that he must not steady the pace to a degree that places riders in difficulty behind him.

D Johnson SNEAKY SHARK – Reminded of her obligation in that she must not steady the pace to a degree that places riders in difficulty behind her.

DIVINE SAVA (A Goindasamy) – Commenced to race ungenerously approaching the 700 metres when the pace steadied becoming awkwardly placed, then clipping a heel and blundering and shifted out hampering BERGHEIM and AUBREE. Shifted out abruptly approaching the 300 metres when the rider was attempting to change whip hands crowding ARDIJAH which was steadied. Continued to race greenly under pressure.

ARDIJAH (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Hampered 700 metres. Crowded and steadied 300 metres.

LA GRANDE RUE (W Pinn) – Raced wide without cover and forced wide 700 metres. Inconvenienced 100 metres.

Race 3 DUNSTAN FEEDS STAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 2200

TUNGZAGUTZ (T Newman) – Hampered shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.

REMARX (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

SIR AGLOVALE (M McNab) – Slow away losing ground. Held up for clear running early in the final straight, shifting out passing the 300 metres. Shifted out approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running after improving near heels.

WHEAO (A Goindamsamy) – Steadied over the concluding stages when awkwardly placed near heels.

MOTUMAN (E McCall) – Slow away losing ground.

MIGHTY COLOMBO (J Kamaruddin) — Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

ISKANDER (T Yanagida) – Shifted in under pressure approaching the 100 metres hampering RISING ROAD which was forced inwards.

E McCall (MOTUMAN) – Admitted a breach in that she used the whip excessively before the 100 metres. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

T Yanagida (ISKANDER) - Issued with a warning concerning his whip use in the final straight.

T Yanagida (ISKANDER) – Admitted a breach in that he permitted his mount to shift in near the 150 metres when insufficiently clear of RISING ROAD which was crowded and hampered. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 02 December up to and including racing on Friday 11 December, 6 national riding days

Following the race, the connections of the 4th placed **RISING ROAD** protested against the 2nd placed horse **ISKANDER** alleging interference in the final straight. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

Race 4 DUNSTAN FEEDS STAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 2100

FLOMILINE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TWO MADISON (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly then hampered, losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages.

FELAAR (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly.

GONE WEST (C Grylls) – Slow away. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Grylls advised that the gelding had raced flat throughout. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

AUGUST EDITION (E McCall)— Restrained from its wide barrier. Raced wide without cover. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which showed haemorrhagic inflammation.

MISSTUMUT (M McNab) – Steadied near the 1800 metres when in restricted room.

BEAUDZ WELL (D Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

JAMES BARRIE (J Riddell) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SHOWBEEL (T Harris) – Was not persevered with in the final straight. Underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

Race 5 STELLA ARTOIS 1500 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 1200

QUICK PREVIEW (C Grylls) – Slow away losing ground. Improved into restricted room for a distance passing the 250 metres. Raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres.

MUMMS JEWEL (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to race keenly passing the 950 metres shifting out to avoid heels crowding SILENT TRUTH which was forced wide hampering BLOOD WARRIOR.

SILENT TRUTH (C Jones) – Crowded and forced wide 950 metres.

BLOOD WARRIOR (J Riddell) – Crowded and forced wide 950 metres, then having to be restrained to obtain cover. Crowded 50 metres when improving into a tight run between WALKIN' BY and MUMMS JEWEL which both shifted ground slightly.

WILLPOWER (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Could not obtain clear running until passing the 150 metres.

VAMOS BEBE (D Johnson) - Slow away.

TIME TO FLY (T Newman) – Crowded 400 metres when improving to the inside of MUMMS JEWEL which stepped in when making the corner awkwardly.

TUSCAN WHISTLER (M McNab) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination confirmed the horse to have bled and is now subject to a 2 month stand down from training and a 3 month stand down from trialling or racing with a veterinary clearance also required before trialling or racing again.

Race 6 TREVOR EAGLE MEMORIAL 3YO (1500 m)

BONITA AURELIA (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly.

EMBER ATTACK (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly then restrained.

BARI (A Calder) – Began awkwardly.

SWEET HUNTER (W Pinn) – Crowded shortly after the start.

TELLALL (M McNab) – Crowded shortly after the start.

FLEETWOOD MACA (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

MONTRE MOI (J Riddell) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

GRIP (C Ormsby) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

ZENDORA (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.

IL AFFARE (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Could not obtain clear running until inside the final 50 metres.

HELSINKI (D Johnson) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

EDGE OF WONDER (R Elliot) – Could not obtain clear running early in the final straight.

Race 7 EAGLE TECHNOLOGY STAKES (1600 m)

REDCAYENNE (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied when awkwardly placed near heels approaching the 1200 metres.

ALIGNS WITH ME (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.

VADAVAR (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly then restrained from its wide barrier.

BEAUDEN (R Elliot) – Restrained to obtain cover 1300 metres then raced ungenerously when being restrained off heels for a distance. Over-raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Contacted and forced wider 600 metres.

TIPTRONIC (D Johnson) – Steadied 1300 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of BEAUDEN (R Elliot) which was steadying when shifting in. Raced keenly in the middle stages shifting out to avoid heels near the 600 metres making contact with BEAUDEN. When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuses other than the gelding over-racing in the early to middle stages.

R Elliot (BEAUDEN)— Issued with a warning after permitting BEAUDEN to shift in near the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of TIPTRONIC which had to be steadied.

GINO SEVERINI (M McNab) – Steadied for a distance from near the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of SULTAN OF SWING which shifted in when insufficiently clear. Shifted in under pressure from near the 150 metres briefly crowding DEMONETIZATION on to SULTAN OF SWING. M McNab was advised that he must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

T Yanagida (SULTAN OF SWING) – Issued with a warning after allowing SULTAN OF SWING to shift in near the 1300 metres when not sufficiently clear of GINO SEVERINI which had to be restrained.

DEMONETIZATION (L Innes) – Raced wide until near the 700 metres. Dictated in passing the 150 metres making contact with SULTAN OF SWING. Then briefly crowded passing the 50 metres.

SULTAN OF SWING (T Yanagida) – Contacted 150 metres, then having to briefly steady when awkwardly placed on heels. Shifted out to obtain clear running 50 metres briefly crowding DEMONETIZATION. Improved on to heels over the concluding stages.

L Innes (DEMONETIZATION) – Reminded of his obligation in that he must ride his horse out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Following the race, the connections of the 4th place horse **DEMONETIZATION** wished to view Stewards footage electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 8 STELLA ARTOIS 1500 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 1400

MANRICO (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.

SINGLE MOMENT (T Thornton) – Slow away losing ground.

ENRICHMENT (J Kamaruddin) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Briefly steadied 1100 metres when in restricted room. Had to change ground when improving onto heels approaching the 150 metres.

REIKO (M McNab) – Hampered then becoming crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Shifted in near the 350 metres to obtain clear running then improved into restricted room passing the 200 metres.

EVEN CHANCE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly then restrained from its wide barrier. Lay out under pressure in the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

KEKE STAR (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson was unable to offer any tangible excuse.

HIGHLAND DANCER (W Pinn) – Underwent post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be showing signs of muscular lameness in the left hind leg.

HONESTY (A Goindasamy) – Restrained from its wide barrier.

WILLY AWAY (T Yanagida) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MY WORLD (A Calder) – Steadied and changed ground approaching the 250 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of NITRO which shifted in.

EXCITONIC (C Grylls) – Had trouble finding clear running early in the final straight. Briefly crowded near the 150 metres.

N Alam (NITRO) – Issued with a warning for his whip use before the 100 metres.
