<b>Race 1</b>	<b>SPEIGHT'S MAIDEN 2030m</b>
<b>TAPPY'S LAD</b> (C Johnson) – Slow away.  <b>LAST LETTER</b> (A Balloo) – Jumped away awkwardly.  <b>BORN TO BE BAD</b> (T Comignaghi) – Left side winker became detached near the 250 metres.  <b>DEEBEEWITHTHESTARS</b> (T Moseley) – When asked to comment on the performance, rider advised that in his opinion the mare did not back up from its race on the first day.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>LEITH LIQUOR 1400m</b>

**REDFORD** (K Asano) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with QUINTUPLE TWINS.

**QUINTUPLE TWINS** (C Johnson) – Contacted at the start. Rider advised that the mare was under pressure passing the 600 metres and had been very disappointing. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>DREAM DOORS MAIDEN 1400m</b>

**NYMPADORA TONKS** (K Asano) – Was declared a late scratching at 1.19 pm after dislodging its rider during the preliminary and taking some time to be recaptured. As a result the race ran two minutes late.

**HOMBRE** (C Johnson) – Raced without the declared tongue tie which unable to be applied. Commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres then having to be firmly restrained passing the 1050 metres.

**R Cuneen** (TRADITION) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear of HOMBRE which had to be firmly restrained passing the 1050 metres.

**ANJARDEN** (S Toolooa) – Jumped away awkwardly.

**TUMEKE** (T Comignaghi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**PARAWANUI LAD** (A Balloo) – Briefly steadied away from the heels passing the 200 metres. Reported by its rider to have hung inwards throughout the run home.

**B Murray** (GOODANYA) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount GOODANYA to shift outwards with PARAWANUI LAD having to be steadied away from that runners heels passing the 200 metres.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>RADIO CENTRAL 1400m</b>

The start was delayed due to members of the public entering the course proper in the back straight.

**NOPELE** (G Jogoo) – Very slow to begin losing several lengths.

**GELIBOLU** (T Moseley) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Hampered having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of I AM A ROCK near the 900 metres.

**FINAL SAVINGS** (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover.

**I AM A ROCK** (D Bothamley) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 900 metres going back onto GELIBOLU which was hampered.

**NEVER QUITZ** (S Toolooa) – When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance co-trainer K Taplin advised the mare had had two races in stronger company in Cup Week and had gone a reasonable race only beaten five lengths on the second occasion and had been able to obtain a soft lead today.

**CABERNET** (C Barnes) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CHIEF BUILD 1220m</b>

**FASTELLIE** (C Campbell) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Slow away. Held up rounding the final turn and again passing the 150 metres for a short distance.

**RIVERFALLS** (M Gestain) – Jumped away awkwardly.

**GLORY CHANCE** (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly. Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 200 metres having to steady and shift ground outwards.

**M Gestain** (RIVERFALLS) – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift out passing the 200 metres when not fully clear of GLORY CHANCE who has to be steadied and be angled wider on the track.

**THE LIKELY LAD** (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>LOVERACING.NZ CROMWELL CUP 2030m</b>
<p><b>ROSIE GLOW</b> (R Mudhoo) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>JEWEL OF PATCH</b> (T Moseley) – Steadied having to be shifted outwards across the heels of KILOWATT to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>MCGOWAN</b> (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly shifting out at the start.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>FRESH CHOICE CROMWELL 2030m</b>
<p><b>AULYN STAR</b> (G Jogoo) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>RUMOUR HAS IT</b> (K Asano) – Rider dropped whip rounding the first bend.</p> <p><b>RUBY MARIE</b> (R Mudhoo) – Steadied away from heels of a tiring runner near the 350 metres, then was briefly held up passing the 175 metres having to change ground to find clear racing room.</p> <p><b>LETSBRINGITON</b> (T Moseley) – Lay in for the majority of the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p> <p><b>SUPERSTITION</b> (K Kwo) – When asked to comment on the performance of a favoured runner the rider advised the mare had had a nice run throughout but when placed under pressure had failed to respond and had been disappointing.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>ETRUSCO AT THE SAVOY DUNEDIN 1400m</b>
<p><b>MILANO</b> (G Jogoo) – Was a late scratching at 4.21 pm by order of the Stewards after escaping through the front of its barrier stall, dislodging its rider and travelling a circuit of the track before being recaptured. Trainer J Dalton was advised the gelding would be required to barrier trial prior to racing next. As a result the race ran approximately three minutes late.</p> <p><b>HENLEY</b> (S Toolooa) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>GRANITE RIDGE</b> (M Gestain) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>LOVE TO DREAM</b> (T Comignaghi) – Slow away. Briefly placed in restricted room passing the 75 metres when HENLEY who had shifted in, was straightened by its rider.</p> <p><b>BELINDABELLA</b> (K Mudhoo) – Clipped a heel and blundered shortly after the start. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running inside the final 175 metres.</p> <p><b>SERIOUSLY</b> (R Cuneen) – Over raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>RINGADINGDING</b> (R Mudhoo) – Had trouble obtaining clear running for the majority of the run home and went to the line untested by its rider.</p>
