SUPPLEMENTARY:

Southland Racing Club 12th December 2020 - Race 6 AWS Legal Southland Crystals Open 2200M /Race 8 Tim Yeo Contracting R74 1600M
Trainer J Gordon admitted a breach of Rule 616 (4) in that she presented and raced NOPELE and RIPNROLL with visor blinkers when only blinkers were declared. After hearing from all parties the JCA imposed a fine of \$150.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	FOREST LODGE / ADVANCE AGRICULTURE (2000m)
SUPER TAP (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly.	
LAST TRY (T Moseley) – Bounded at the start losing ground.	
SUTHERLAND (G Jogoo) – Had to be restrained passing the 1800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of POILU. Again had to be restrained passing the 700 metres when improving quickly onto the heels of POINT BREAK.	

POINT BREAK (T Jonker) – Had to be shifted wider on the track passing the 1500 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **SPEIGHTS**, then improved wide from this point. Gave ground over the final 400 metres with the rider reporting the gelding had been obliged to race wide for the majority of the race and this had taken its toll over the concluding stages.

BATTLINAWAY (D Bothamley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SPEIGHTS (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

ACCUSE (J Lowry) – Rider reported that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer R Dennis advised the Stewards it is his intention to now spell the gelding.

Race 2	BB SPRAYING / LUGGATE LODGE (2000m)

AULYN STAR (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.

ROSIE GLOW (M Gestain) – Slow to begin. Obligated to improve wide rounding the final bend.

KNUTQUACKER (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages with the rider reporting this had taken its toll on the mare over the concluding stages.

COLOUR ME RED (T Moseley) – Raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

A Bohorun (FLY WITHOUT WINGS) was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3	HARLIWICH CONTRACTING / HOKONUI HONDA (1335m)

REGAL GIRL (C Barnes) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after becoming fractious and rearing in the barriers with the mare being cleared to start. As a result this race was delayed approximately 2 minutes.

PEMBROKE (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

OCEAN'S SEVEN (C Johnson) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider reported the mare had got back in the running on a fast tempo and when placed under pressure had battled on without threatening the place getters.

IRISH HEART (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin. Rider reported the mare had only battled when placed under pressure and had proved disappointing.

KENTUCKY MAY (R Mudhoo) – Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

UPHOLD (R Beeharry) – Lay outwards for the majority of the event.

GALLANT FREDI (K Mudhoo) – Lay inwards passing the 150 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

ORAKA PLAYBOY (K Kwo) – Briefly steadied near the 100 metres when **REGAL GIRL** lay inwards under pressure before being straightened.

Race 4	SOOHS / WHITE ROBE LODGE (1335m)

ANJAMEME (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When asked to comment on the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation.

SHOW PARK (T Jonker) – Very slow to begin. The connections were advised the mare was on a barrier manners warning.

ANJARDEN (R Beeharry) – Crowded by an inside runner at the start losing ground. Reported to have lost both back racing plates during the running.

LOUIS LUCK (D Bothamley) – Over-raced when leading through the early to middle stages.

DREAMIN EASY (R Mudhoo) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

THE MOLE (T Moseley) – When asked to comment on the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation.

MISS MAXIPARK (A Bohorun) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ROCKIN ROBIN (S Toolooa) – Raced four-wide without cover from the 700 metres. Hung outwards under pressure rounding the final bend. Trainer advised the mare would now be retired as a racing proposition from his stable.

Race 5	HERIOT HOTEL / AB LIME (1200m)

LIGHTNING RIDGE (T Jonker) – Fractious on the way to the barriers and dislodged rider T Jonker who was examined by St John Ambulance Paramedics and cleared to ride. Raced keenly while leading in the early to middle stages.

CRYSTAL BELLINI (C Campbell) – Fractious in the barriers and bounded as the start was effected. Held up rounding the final bend and again over the concluding stages.

GALAXY PRINCESS (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

HATITIMATANGI (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

PROWLER (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BENNY LINCOLN (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

THE SELECTION (J Lowry) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event. Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 200 metres and was checked when LET ME TELL YA shifted ground outwards.

LET ME TELL YA (R Mudhoo) – Lay inwards passing the 200 metres and when being corrected by its rider shifted outwards.

R Mudhoo (LET ME TELL YA) admitted a breach of the Careless Riding Rule in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards passing 200 metres crowding and checking THE SELECTION. After viewing replays and hearing penalty submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of Mr Mudhoo's riding licence from the 27th December up to and including the 29th December (3 days) and a fine of \$250.

Race 6	MLT SPRINT (1200m)

There was a delay to the start of this event when GELIBOLU proved very difficult to load.

ACEKINGSUITED (R Mudhoo) – Trainer J Sheridan was issued with a warning when presenting this runner with Visor Blinkers instead of the notified Blinkers. Shifted inwards near the 225 metres having to be straightened.

GELIBOLU (J Lowry) – Proved very difficult to load with connections advised the gelding was on a final warning for its barrier manners.

JIM'S GIFT (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards contacting inside runner. Crowded and had to steady near the 225 metres when ACEKINGSUITED which was laying in, shifted in before being straightened by its rider.

KITTY POWER (M Gestain) – Buffeted shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.

KERANY (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

TENNESSEE ROCK (R Beeharry) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

FRIAR TUCK (K Kwo) – Raced four-wide without cover throughout.

Race 7	DYNES TRANSPORT TAPANUI CUP (1335m)

GALLANT BOY (R Beeharry) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after making firm contact with the birdcage fence and was cleared to start. Dictated up the track throughout the home straight.

SHAARA (G Jogoo) – Restrained to obtain cover at the start.

EASY HABIT (C Campbell) – Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (S Wynne) – Shifted up the track under pressure early in the run home and continued to lay outwards and shift up the track throughout the home straight despite the efforts of its rider, dictating GALLANT BOY wider on the track.

FLYING SARDINE (M Gestain) – When asked to comment on the performance rider reported the mare had only battled when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

Following the running of this event Stewards lodged a Protest pursuant to Rule 642(1) against 1st placing being awarded to MIDNIGHT RUNNER alleging the interference throughout the run home preventing GALLANT BOY from finishing in 1st placing. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from all parties the Judicial Committee dismissed the Protest.

Race 8	AON INSURANCE / ROAD TRANSPORT LOGISTICS (1800m)

MIRADELLO (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly and got back shortly after the start. Improved wide rounding the final bend.

PERFECTO (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Raced wide from 800 metres.

SPIDER LILY (R Beeharry) – Raced three-wide without cover in the early stages.

THE FLAGON (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

SENROR MOSS (G Jogoo) – Improved wide in the middle stages. Crowded near the 50 metres.

SUPERSTITION (K Kwo) – Had to shift ground near the 100 metres to find clear racing room and was then forced across the heels of SOUNDS PROMISING near the 50 metres having to be heavily restrained.

MUSTARD (C Barnes) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages and passing the 50 metres shifted out abruptly when RED MAJOR improved quickly on its inside resulting in crowding to SENROR MOSS, GARMENT and SUPERSTITION which was forced outwards onto the heels of SOUNDS PROMISING having to be steadied. Reported by its rider to have hung throughout.

GARMENT (M Gestain) – Crowded near the 50 metres.
